








The assembly was enjoyed and appreciated by all. 'Health is the greatest gift, contentment the greatest wealth, faithfulness the best relationship.'

















The competition aimed to promote the creativity & writing skills of our students which was achieved to a large extent.














French Clock Making






A brochure making competition was held for class VII students. The theme was My Dream Destination.


The students came back not only with beautiful memories but also with some valuable essence that they will hold throughout their lives.
