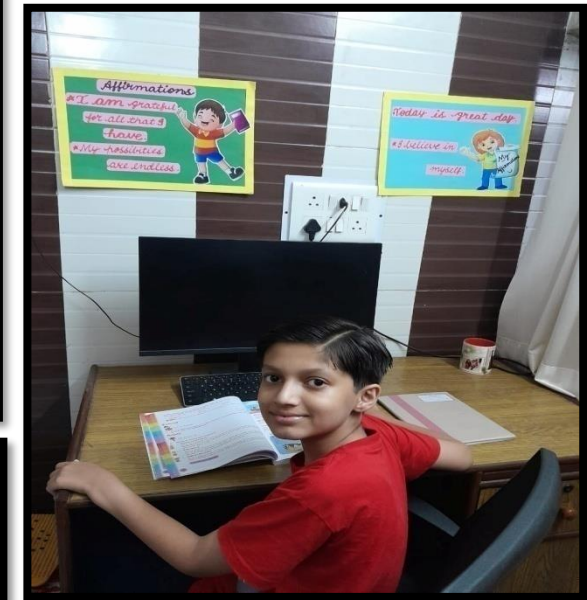
Day 1- The week commenced with an amazingly creative activity

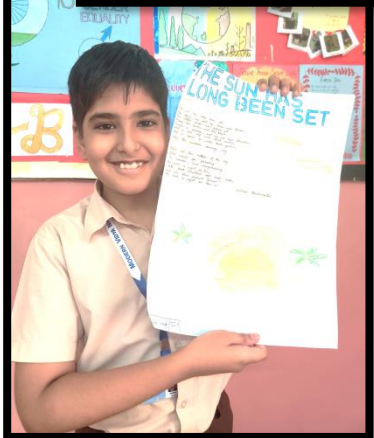
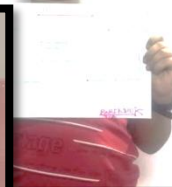
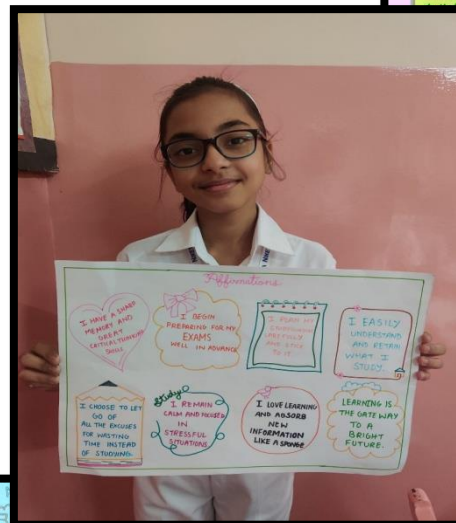
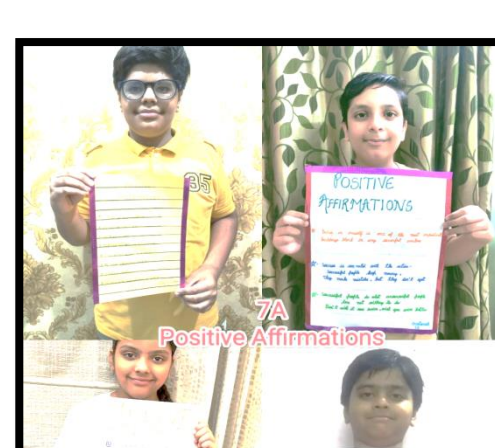
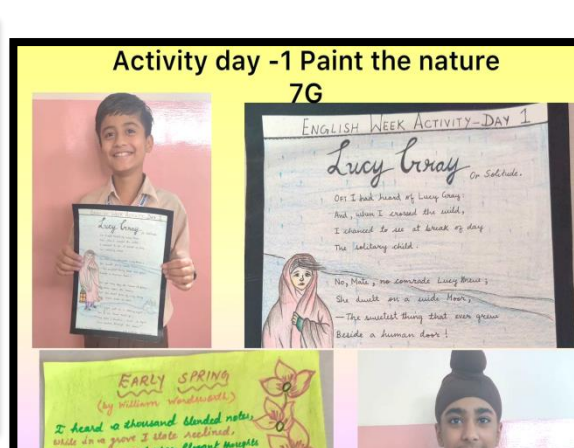
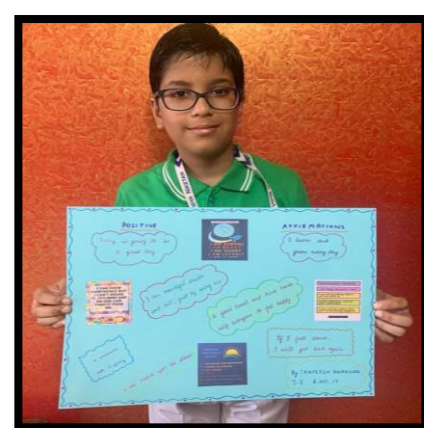
Day 2-saw the students immerse themselves into the biographies of their favourite authors.

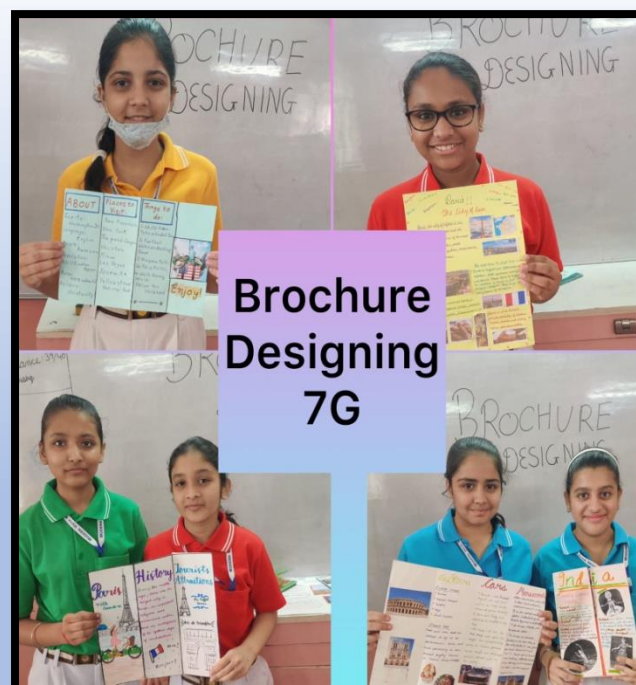
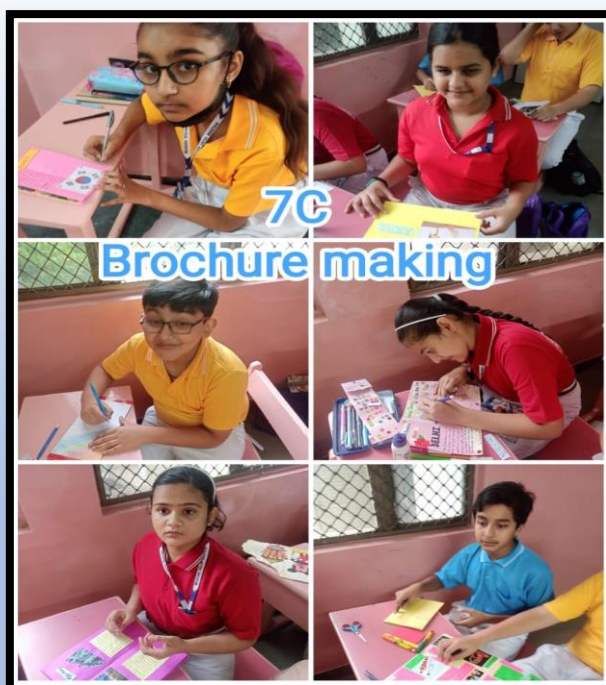
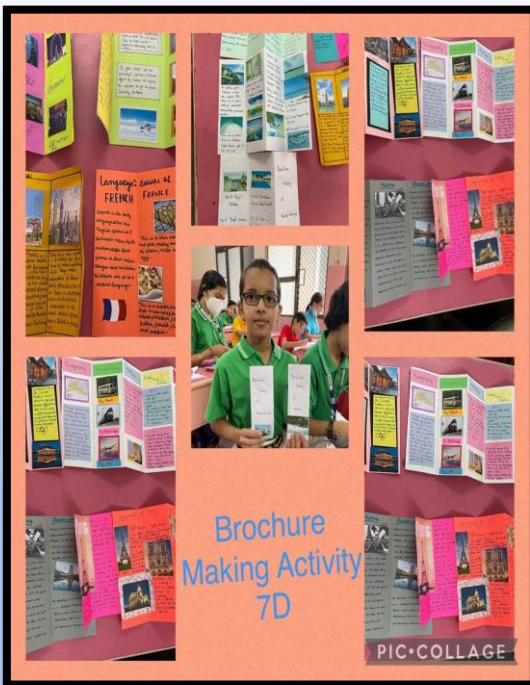




BROCHURE DESIGNING

A VISIT TO OLD AGE HOME

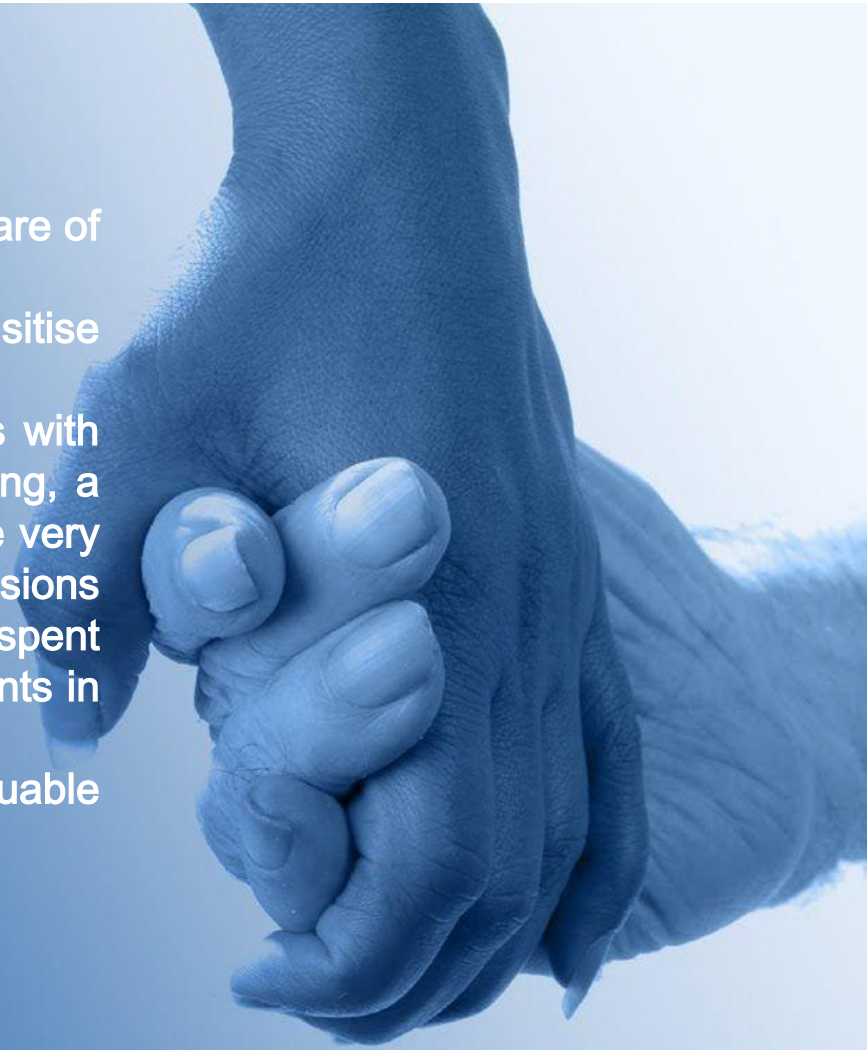
Old age is also called the second childhood, and is the time when one needs love and care of the near and dear ones the most .

The students came back not only with beautiful memories but also with some valuable essence that they will hold throughout their lives.

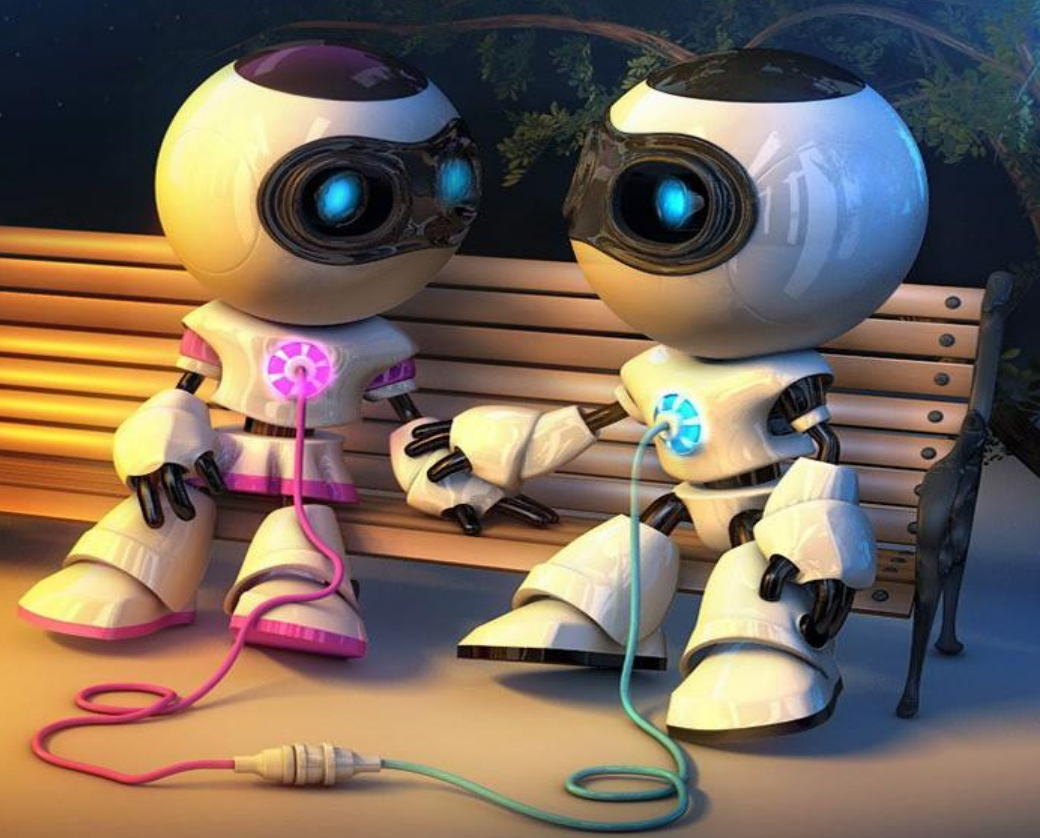
