It was truly heartwarming to see our students embracing mindfulness and discovering the joy of inner peace.








“Every child is an artist and every creation tells a story.”












CALLIGRAPHY COMPETITION






SPEECH IN A HAT


“Every time a child speaks, a new sparkle of confidence is born.”





CHILDREN'S DAY

- Played a variety of board games that encouraged teamwork and strategy.








SCIENCE QUEST

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
CONSERVING ENERGY SPEAK ON ACTIVITY






