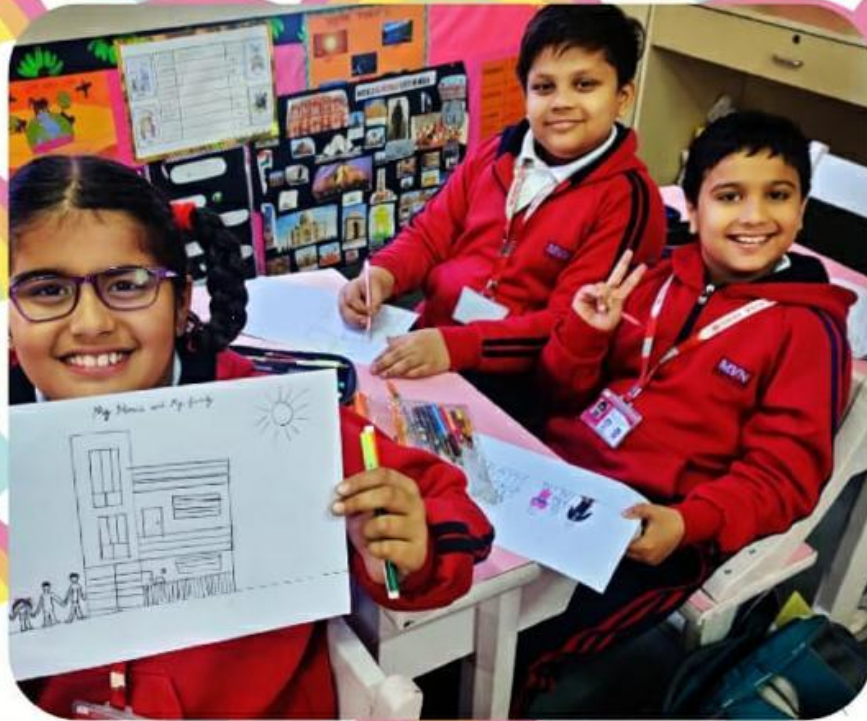


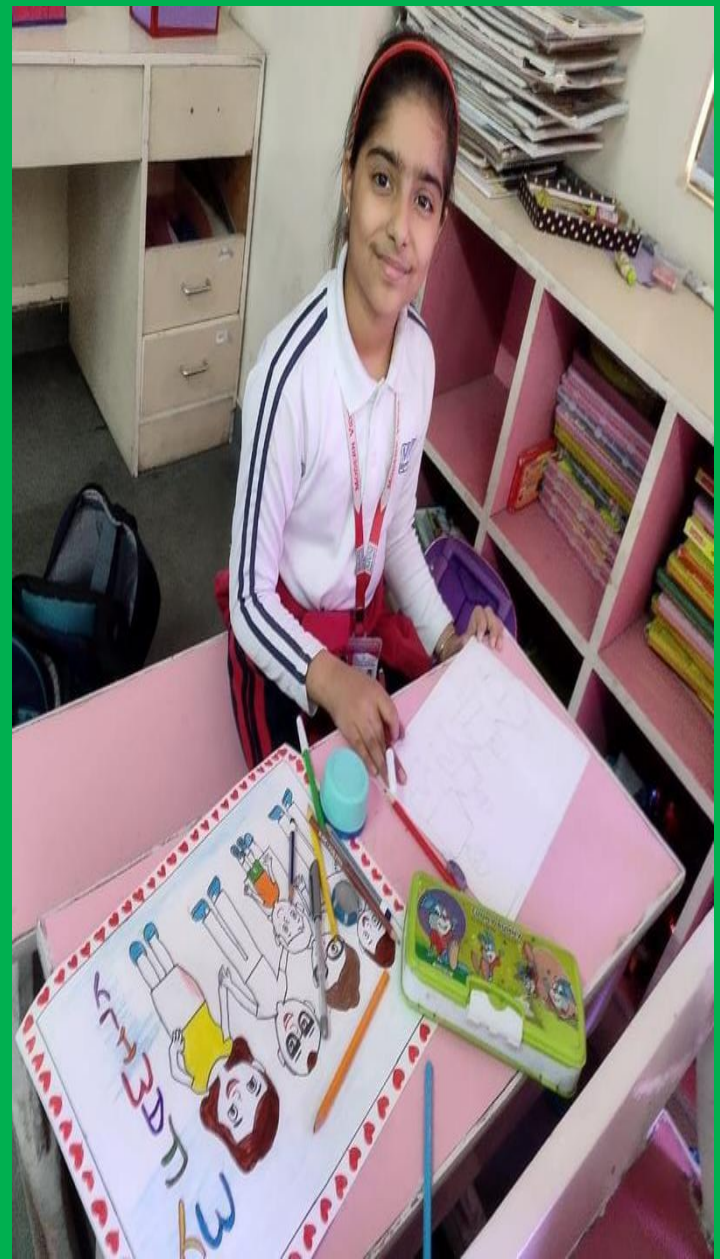
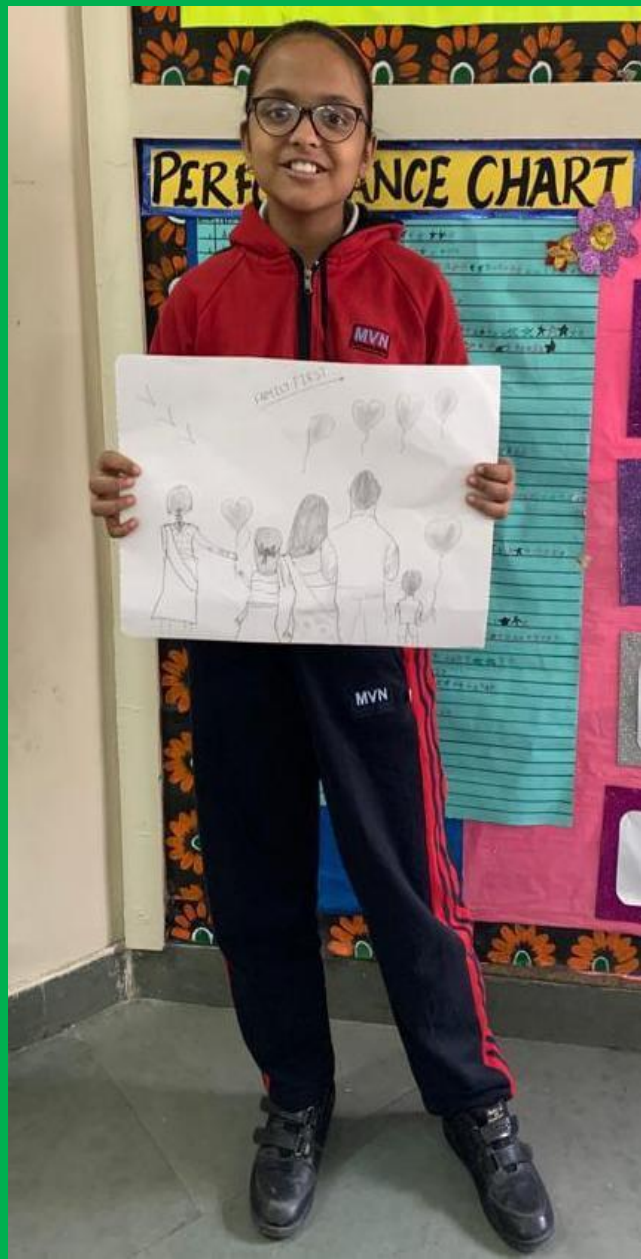
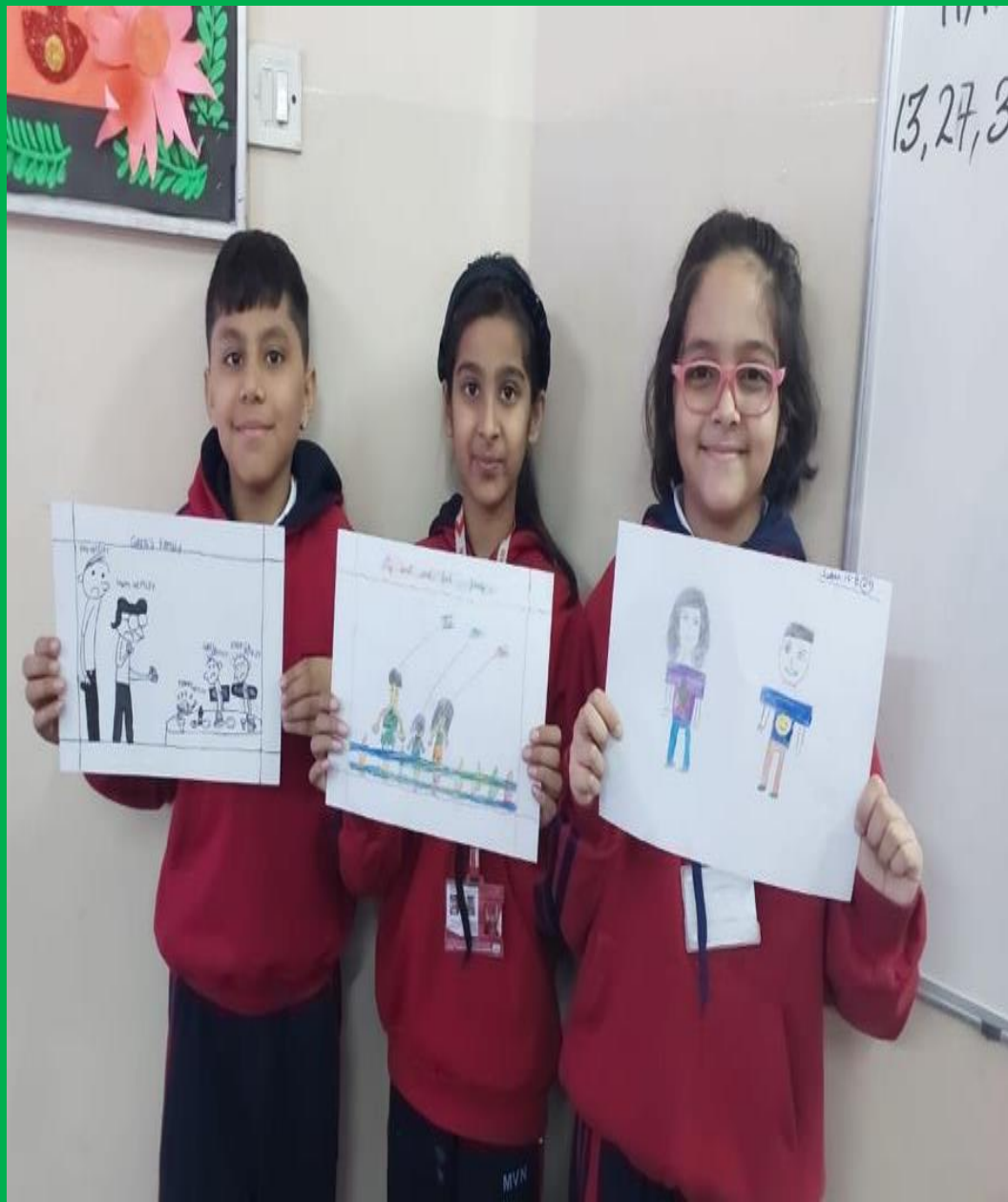
PAINTING MY FAMILY ACTIVITY

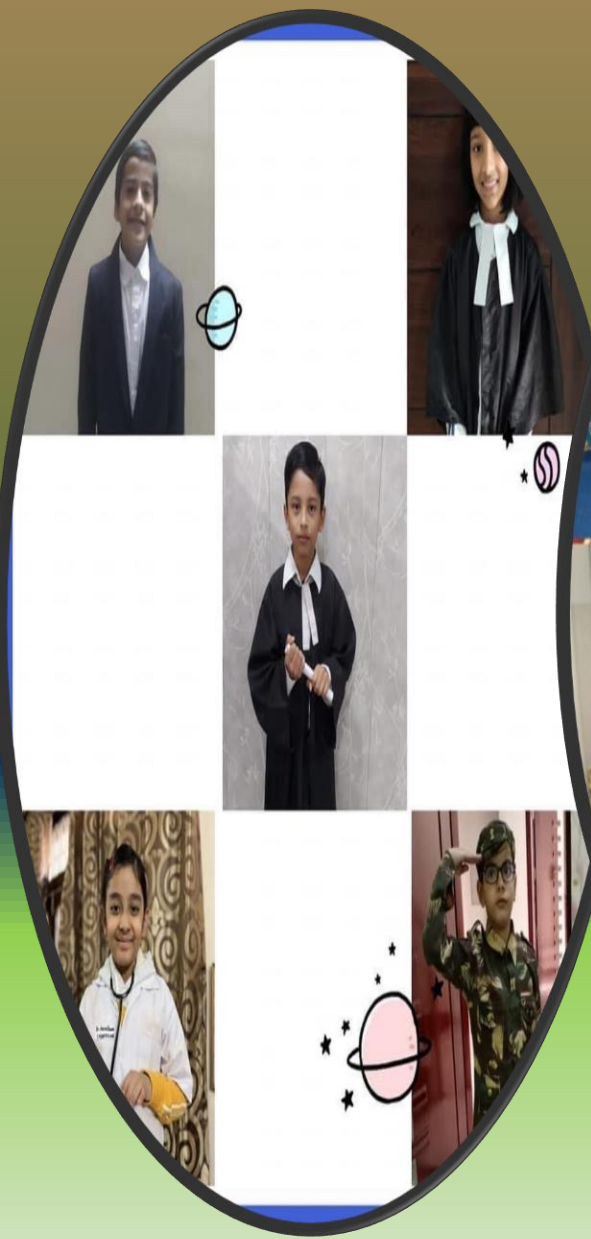
FANCY DRESS COMPETITION

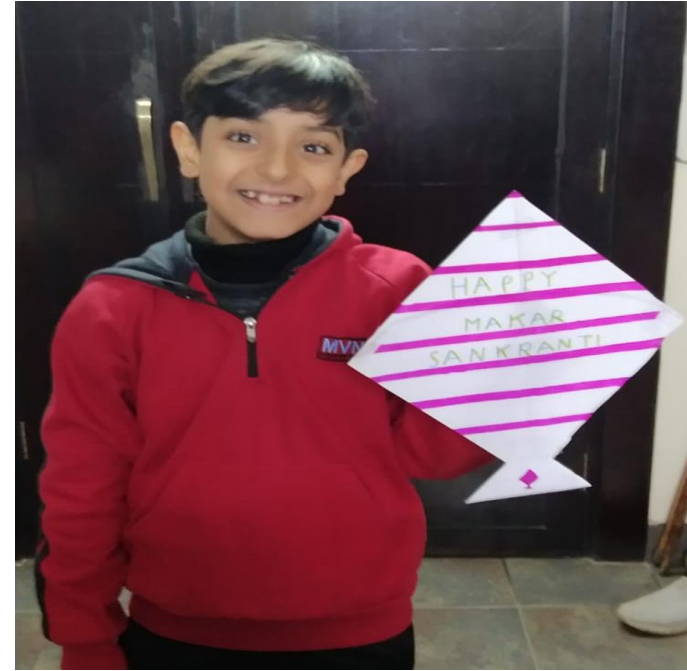
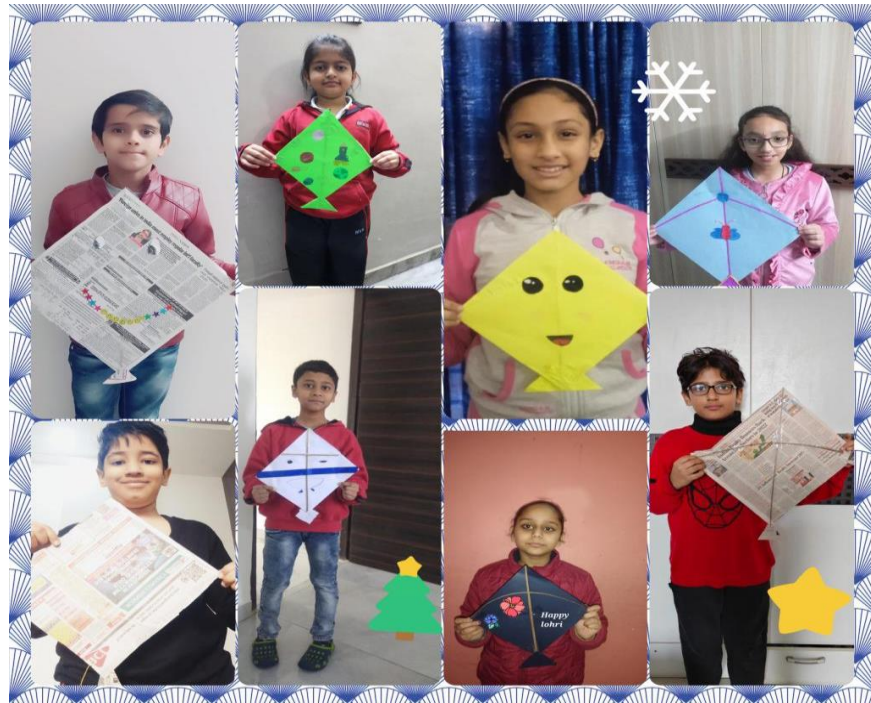


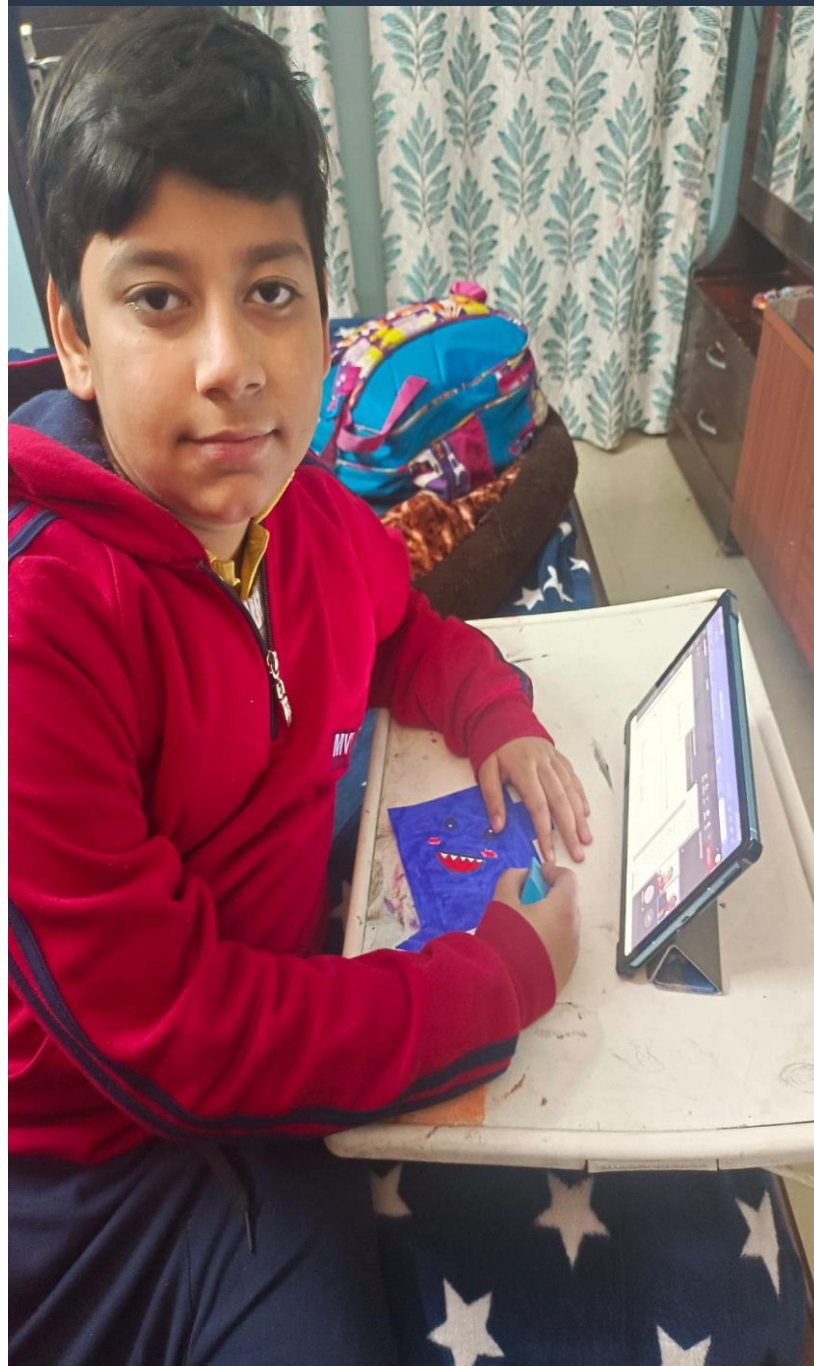
Thanks Giving Activity

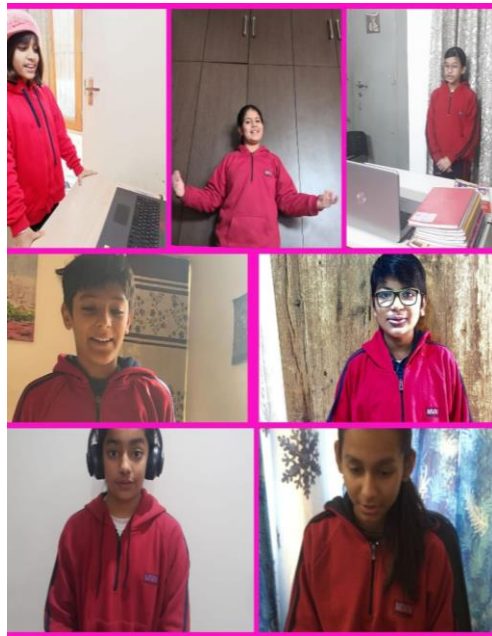


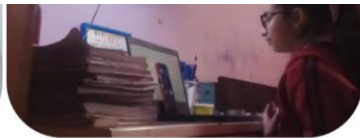
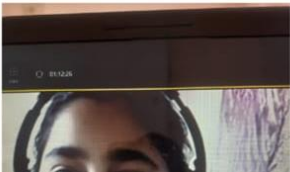
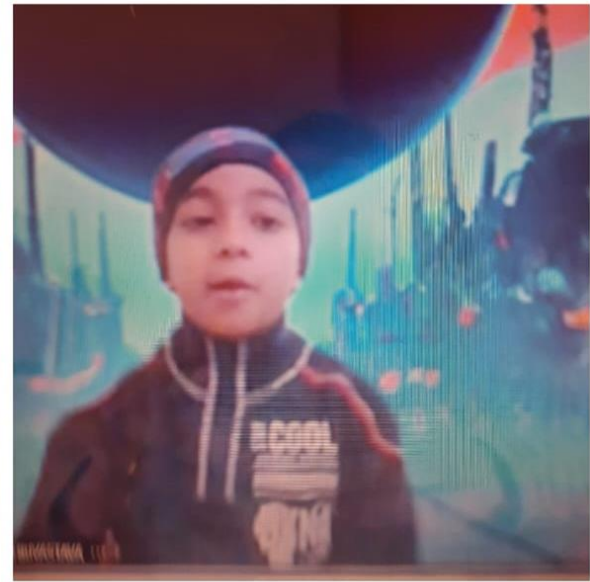
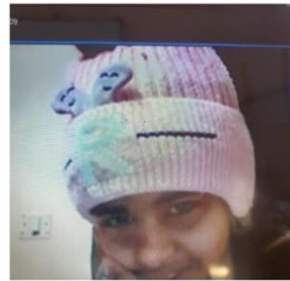
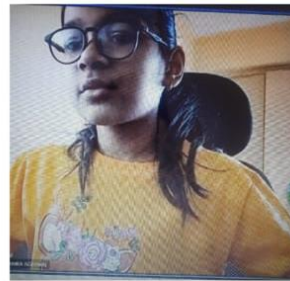
DECLAMATION COMPETITION

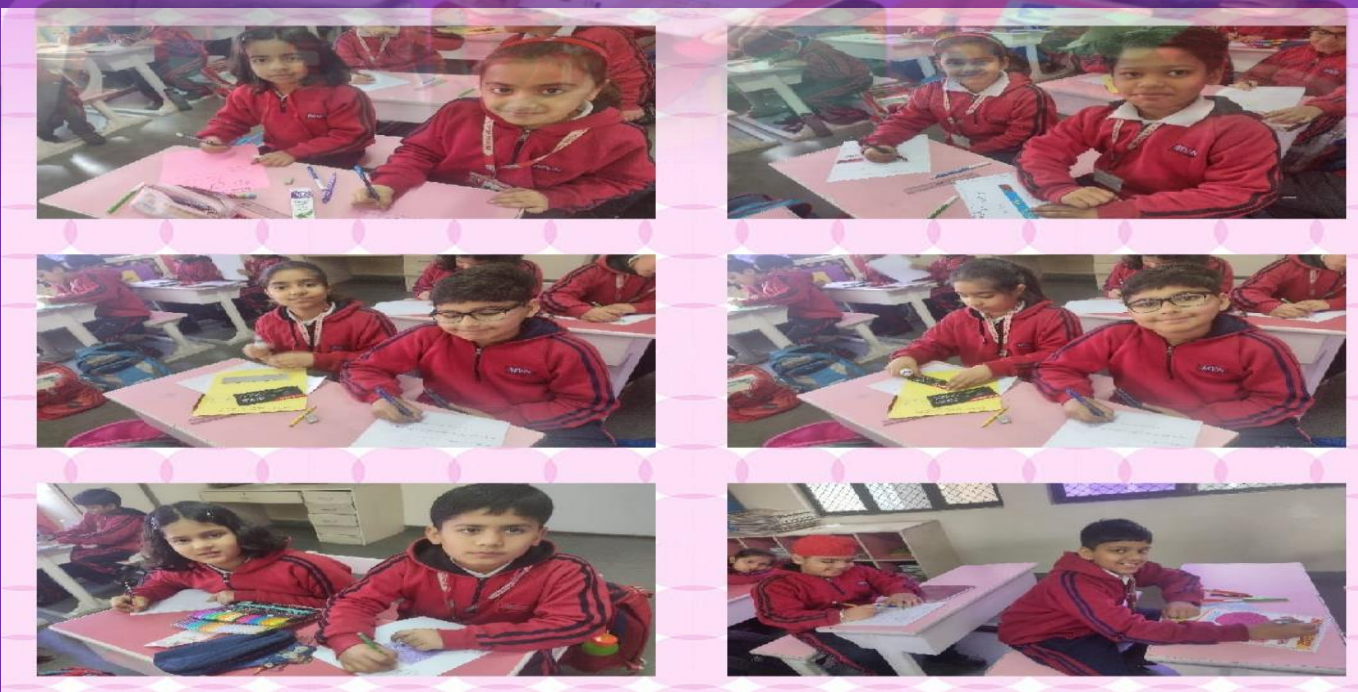


ADVERTISEMENT MAKING ACTIVITY

Also, our Coordinator Mrs. PRIYA Thukral appreciated the efforts of the students.

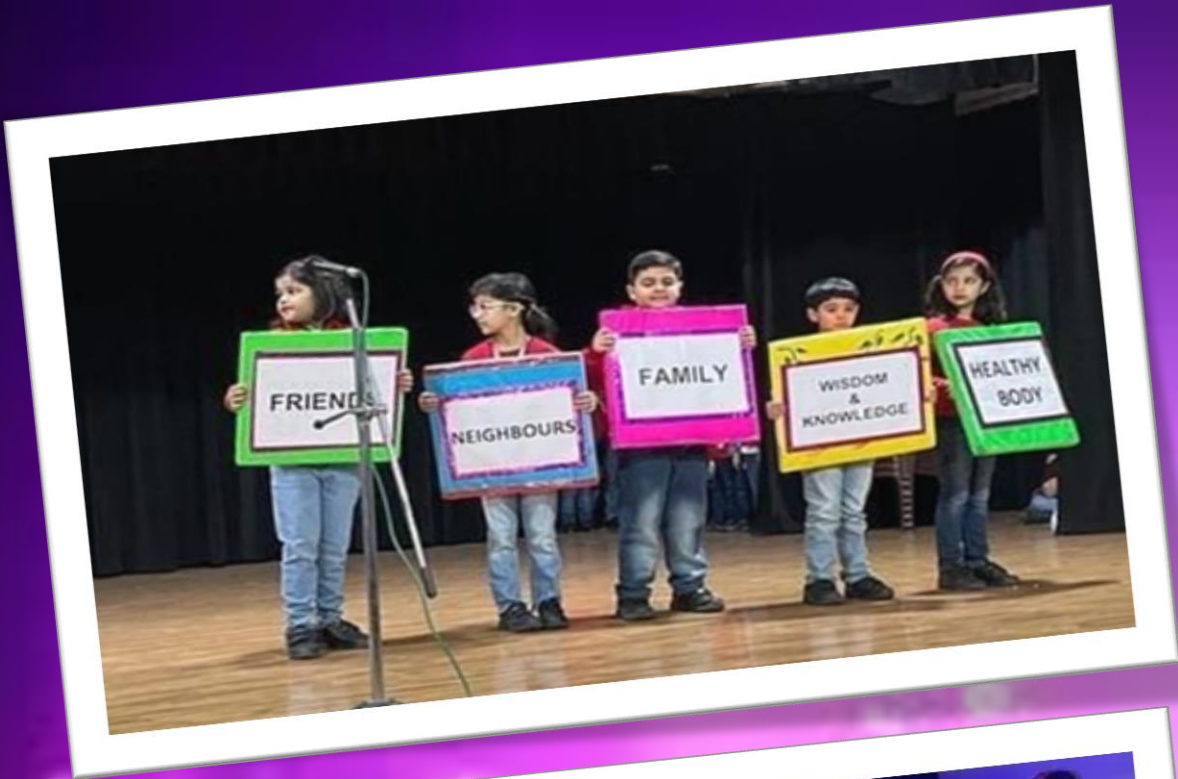






GRATITUDE IS THE BEST ATTITUDE

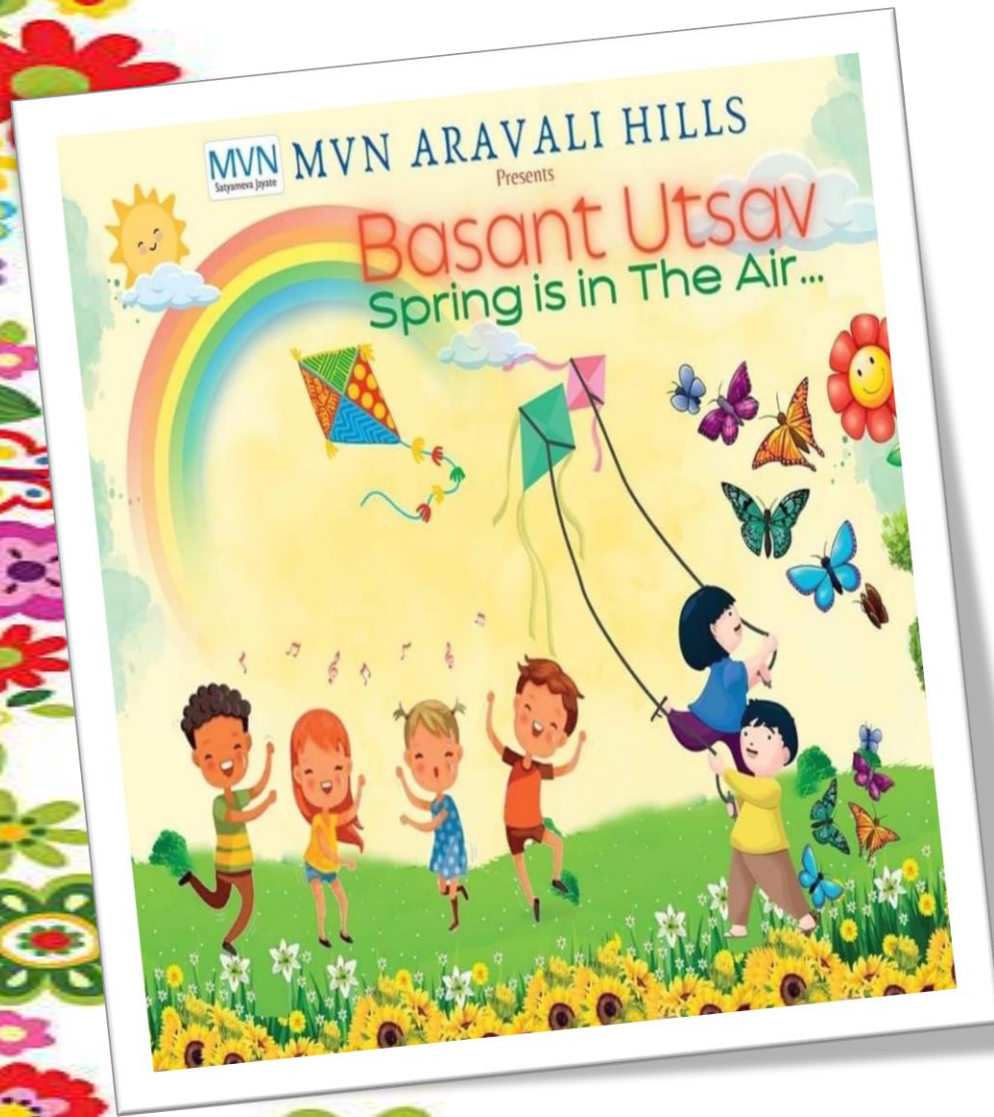

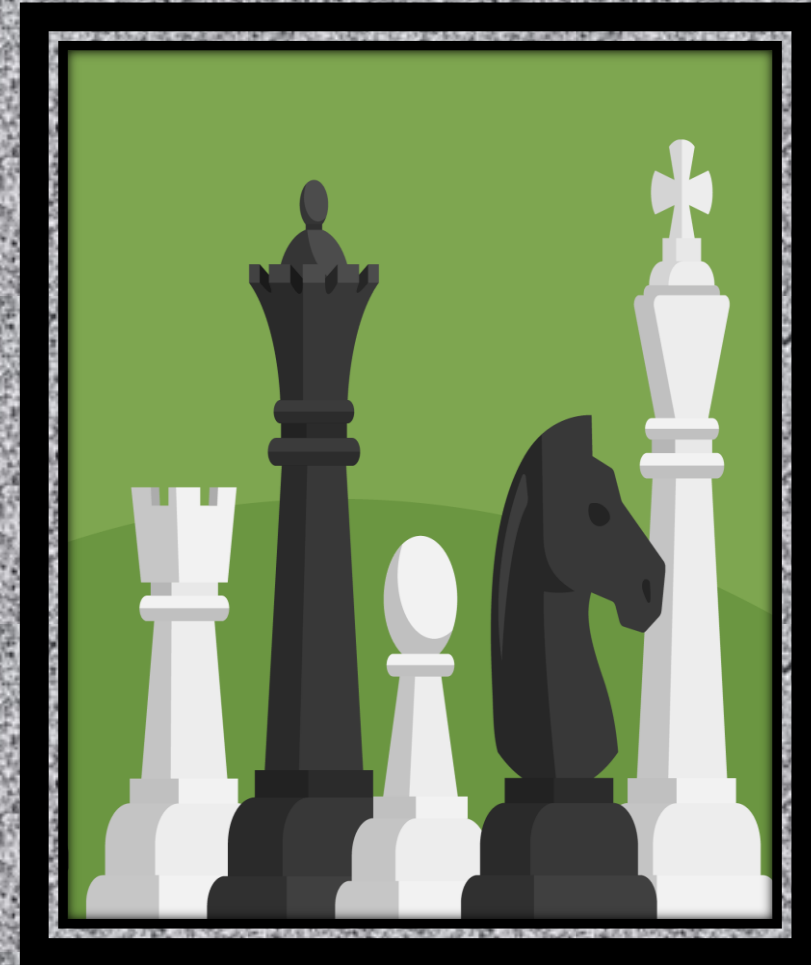
