




Imagination in Action: A Children's Day Extravaganza






Assembly on Diwali


Diwali is a festival of lights, a reminder that darkness can be overcome by the light of knowledge and love.”


“Empathy is seeing with the eyes of another, listening with the ears of another, and feeling with the heart of another.” – Alfred Adler


