- 3. The students are required to have the almanac with them as a part of their resources when they come to school and should keep it safe.
- 4. The home-work given by teachers should be noted down in it by the students, without fail.
- 5. Every communication from the teachers must be brought to the notice of the parents and vice-versa.

# **INTRODUCTION**

Modern Vidya Niketan School, run by an educational society registered with the State Govt. under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1960, has been functioning in Faridabad since 1983.

The teaching of various subjects from Grade 1 onwards is non-mechanical. The concepts of the subjects taught in the school are made clear to the children in a manner that they develop interest in these subjects.

The school has the right atmosphere to teach the children and enrich their growth. They learn through their personal experience, curiosity, capacity to do a work and their sensitive response to the environment, which the school endeavours to make secure and familiar. Besides stimulating them, encouraging them, generating self-confidence in them and above all, making them feel relaxed, the school also claims to take personal care of each and every child.

The enlightened sections of the population in Faridabad have witnessed the functioning of our school with considerable critical interest. It has been found that the school has made a concrete contribution to the educational opportunities available in Faridabad. It is reckoned to be a school with a difference, perhaps unique, in many ways. The approach of teaching children and the integrity of the administration of the school, have been found to be qualitatively superior to the existing schools in Faridabad.

A particular mention must be made of the fact that education is being used very imaginatively to suit the needs of the children of our school.

In short, Modern Vidya Niketan School represents an effort in taking initiative to impart education in an innovative and unconventional manner.

# **Rules for Students**

- 1. Students are required to bring their Almanac to the school everyday.
- 2. All the students are expected to arrive on time. Students who come to school on their own should arrive five minutes before the school starts. Students who arrive late habitually may be sent back home.
- 3. Students should come to school neatly dressed. The school uniform is to be worn everyday and for all events such as PTM, Picnics, Excursions, Day trips etc. Students who are sloppily dressed or not in complete uniform may be sent back home. **Wearing ID Cards on all days is mandatory**. Non Sikh boys should get their hair cut at regular intervals. Sikh boys must wear a patka.
- 4. Students are expected to respect the property of others. This includes respect for school property and no student should damage any school furniture, write or draw anything on the walls or in any way damage things belonging to others. Damage done should be immediately reported to school authorities. For any damage done, the student will have to bear the cost or compensate by suitable replacement as directed by the school authorities.
- 5. Students are advised to keep their classrooms, school building, buses and the campus very neat and clean and dispose off leftovers or waste only in the bins. The school is attached to The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI). The students are encouraged to collect dry waste from the school premises which is sent for recycling and making useful products like furniture, notebooks, bags etc. for the under privileged children.
- 6. Lending and borrowing of money and others articles is not permitted.
- 7. Students coming to school in the care of guardians should never leave before the guardian arrives. In case of delay, it should be reported at the reception.
- 8. Students are advised to deposit the articles found in the school premises with their Class Teacher or the incharge.
- 9. Students are not allowed to use the telephone without the permission of the Office Incharge.
- 10. Students should get their Report Card signed by their Parents/Guardian and return within two days of the receipt of the same.

- 11. Students should not miss any teaching, games or activity period.
- 12. No student shall indulge in any of the following practices:
  - a) Spitting in or near the school building.
  - b) Smoking
  - c) Any form of gambling
  - d) Consuming drugs or intoxicants except on prescription by a registered medical practitioner.
  - e) Casteism, communalism or practice untouchability.
  - f) Bursting of crackers or splashing of colours
  - g) Bullying other students
- 13. Using unfair means in the exams is the worst possible offence committed by any student. A student indulging in such unholy practice would be declared fail in the exam and rusticated from the school.
- 14. The students should always remember that the school is judged by their behaviour when they meet the outsiders. It is expected that they behave in a manner that brings good name to the school. The observance of rules and discipline of the school and good behaviour is an essential condition to a student's continuance in the school. In case any student violates the school rules or indulges in any form of indiscipline, strict action like expulsion / suspension / rustication shall be taken against the student.
- 15. The school may alter / modify / amend or add any of its existing rules at its sole discretion in a manner it deems fit. The school reserves the right to revise or modify the fee structure as and when deemed necessary.

# A SPECIAL NOTE TO PARENTS

The School, no doubt, has the responsibility of turning out well-groomed, disciplined and physically and mentally developed young men and women. Nevertheless, in time sequence, the home comes first and forms one of the most critical periods in the child's life. It constitutes virtually the whole of his environment. The influence of home, therefore, is very strong. The child's attitude to work and the inner drive to achieve success in what he undertakes may be a direct consequence of things seen, said or done at home. His assessment of himself as "good" or "bad", "clever" or "stupid" reflects in large part, the approval and encouragement, by his parents. Parental indifference or neglect shatters the child's self-confidence. If he is over indulged, he could acquire an undue sense of self importance. His experience of affection and discipline and his relations with others at home also affect his ability to adjust with other people, whether they be children of his own age, older children or adults.

We therefore, with all humility, suggest that parents be constantly in touch with the school regarding the performance of their wards for their good, and help the school play its role effectively.

The child should do his home-work independently. This will generate feelings of self -confidence, self-study and independent thinking in him . His work should be supervised and given general direction only. If during the course of this exercise, you notice any decline in your child's performance, do take remedial steps and do not hesitate in getting in touch with the school

Since you have chosen to send your child to an English Medium School, we expect you to encourage your child to converse in English as much as possible.

We seek your co-operation in matters of school uniform, discipline, work, punctuality, attendance and other matters concerning your ward at school.

# **GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS**

- 1. See that your ward carries books and exercise books according to the time table for that day. No extra books are allowed.
- 2. See that your ward is prepared for the class tests and brings required stationery to school. Also see his/her almanac/note books regularly.
- 3. Encourage your ward to take a balanced interest in studies, co-curricular activities and sports.
- 4. Restrict daily pocket money. Excessive spending should be discouraged.
- 5. Plan further education of your ward beyond the school in good times so that they may be eligible to compete for the maximum number of institutions for higher education.
- 6. No child will be allowed to leave the school before the school timings are over. Prior permission should be taken from the Principal and application for the same should be sent a day in advance to the Class Teacher.
- 7. If your ward is absent from school he/she must make up for all the work missed by him/her.
- 8. Your ward should be instructed to be careful about his/her belongings. There should be a name tag on all the belongings of the child. Expensive pens and articles like watches, iPods, cameras, laptops, calculators, mobile phones etc should not be brought to the school. Wearing expensive jewellery like gold chains, rings etc is also not allowed. In case of violation of the rule, the articles may be confiscated. The school bears no responsibility for articles lost in the school.
- Parents are instructed to pay the fees of their ward within the stipulated time mentioned in the fee notice, failing which may lead to late fee charges.
- 10. All parents are requested to impart Health Education to their children so that they:
- a) Maintain a good personal hygiene like trimming of nails and hair and being neat on a regular basis.
- b) Exercise regularly.
- c) Sleep for at least eight hours daily.

- d) Have a balanced diet, nutritionally rich in proteins and calcium.
- e) Drink water which is either boiled or filtered. All the students are advised to bring their own water bottles from home.
- f) Avoid consumption of ice-creams, other milk products and eatables from road side vendors.
- g) Deworming at least once every year must be done. Advice from family physician must be taken regularly.
- h) Get dental and ophthalmic check up done every year by a dental surgeon and ophthalmologist.
- I) Immunise your child as per schedule given below:
  - BCG
  - 2. DPT
  - Oral Polio
  - 4. MMR
  - 5. DT-at 5 years of age
  - 6. Tetanus-booster dose to be given between 7-16 years of age and also be given in case of injury.
  - 7. Typhoid
  - 8. Cholera
  - 9. Hepatitis
  - 10. Meningitis
- 11. Students suffering from diseases such as Chicken Pox, Cholera, Measles, Mumps, Whooping-Cough, Jaundice or infectious diseases like Conjunctivitis, Dermatitis, Scabies, etc. should not be sent to school till the doctor gives a fitness certificate.
- 12. Students suffering from chronic disease like Asthma, Epilepsy, Rheumatic Heart Disease, etc. are advised to be under continuous Medical Supervision of a specialist Doctor. School must be intimated in such cases.

# **CODE OF CONDUCT**

We would like to define a code of conduct for our students to help them know what they should not do, in their dealings with their class-mates, fellow-students, teachers, parents and public and in their attitude towards work, school or private property.

Conditions will be provided for exercising self-imposed discipline rather than getting things done through measures unbecoming of a good school.

- a) Pupil and Pupil: He should be full of good will, concern, warmth and affection for his classmates and other students of the school.
- b) Pupil and Teacher: A student of our school is expected to be respectful to his teachers. He should not be disobedient to them.
- c) Pupil and work: He is supposed to do his home-work with interest and utmost concentration. He should be regular in doing both his written assignments as well as learning work.
- d) Pupil and Property: The care of school property should be at top priority. Public property and property at home should also be taken care of by him.
- e) Pupil & School Authority: The authority of the school should be respected by the students by obeying its rules and regulations given from time to time.
- f) Pupil and Public: Our students are expected to win the hearts of those who come in contact with them. Their courtesy, sense of responsibility and initiative, use of decent language and general get-up should be the envy of one and all.

# **Home Work**

Teaching in the class room will lose its impact if it is not re-inforced through follow up assignments to be done at home. It is therefore, expected of parents to help their ward in their home work as well as to keep track of the same on regular basis. Also, feedback of your ward is being given by the teachers whenever required in the yellow pages of the almanac or through mails. Parents are requested to acknowledge them.

# **ABSENCE**

- 1. Leave of absence upto two days can be sanctioned by the Class Teacher. Leave for more than two days will be granted only by the Principal.
- 2. No student who has been absent on the previous day will be admitted to the class without a letter / mail from the parent, addressed to the class teacher, stating the reason of absence.
- 3. Students suffering from any ailments / fracture etc. should bring a medical certificate from their doctor on joining school.
- 4. A student returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease, should produce a doctor's certificate permitting him to do so.
- 5. Students, suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to class.

a. Chicken Pox - till complete falling of the scabs

b. Cholera - till the child is completely well

c. Measles - till the rashes disappear

d Mumps - until the swelling has completely subsided

- Absence without leave application or unexplained absence for more than six consecutive days renders the students liable to have his name struck off the school rolls. Re-admission may be granted only after payment of readmission fee.
- 7. All students are expected to attend school on the opening day after the vacations. Those absent without leave will be fined. Those absent because of sickness must present a Medical Certificate.
- 8. It is compulsory for the students to have the requisite attendance as mandated under the CBSE rules in a year to be eligible to appear for the final examination. For further information, Please refer to www.cbse.nic.in.
- 9. Please note that no child will be allowed to leave school after the assessments without prior permission.

# WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURE

- 1. A clear one month's notice of the school dues in lieu thereof, is to be given when a student is to be withdrawn.
- 2. In case of withdrawal Transfer Certificate will be issued on clearance of school dues.
- 3. Incase a student stops attending the school without informing the school authorities, all dues of the school will have to be paid by the Parents/ Guardians till the information is received. This may, in certain cases, amount to payment of fees for the full session.
- 4. Those who leave the school in May must in all cases pay the fees for the month of June.
- 5. A student may be expelled from the school on disciplinarian grounds or dissatisfactory progress in academics. A student may be detained in the class if the academic performance is dissatisfactory. Any student failing twice will not be permitted to continue his/her studies in the school.

# **VISITING TIME FOR PARENTS**

<u>PTM</u>: Prior information regarding the date and timings of the meeting will be given to parents for various classes. It is mandatory for the Parents/ Guardians to attend the PTM.

If required, Parents may contact the concerned Teacher /Coordinator or the Principal with prior appointment, on any working day.

# **PROMOTION RULES**

- 1. The academic session of the school shall be from April to March.
- 2. The promotion of a student to the next class depends on his achievement level assessed by the School.
- 3. The decision of the School Authorities regarding promotion shall be final.
- 4. Double promotion will not be granted to any student.

# **SCHOOL TRANSPORT**

Students of Modern Vidya Niketan can avail the School Transport subject to the availability of seats. The routes of the school buses are drawn up and the parents should consult the school office for necessary details.

#### **BUS RULES:**

- 1. All the students using the school bus are expected to be at bus stop at least five minutes before the arrival time of the bus.
- 2. The buses will not wait for late comers.
- 3. The Children should stay away from the main road until the bus arrives
- 4. No student should come near the entry door of the bus until it has made a complete stop.
- 5. All students must occupy vacant seats immediately after boarding the bus. No student should travel standing on the foot-boards.
- 6. The front door of the bus is the only authorised entrance and exit.
- 7. The drivers are authorised to stop buses at the designated stop only, unless otherwise directed by the teacher in the bus. The list of stops is prepared keeping in view the convenience and safety of all bus commuters and is always subject to change.
- 8. When the bus is in motion, students must not move around in the bus and no part of their body should be outside the bus.
- Objects of any kind must not be discarded inside or thrown outside the bus.
- 10. Students will be held responsible for any damage to buses caused by negligence or vandalism.
- 11. For discontinuing the use of the school bus, a clear notice of at least one month should be given in writing before the payment of the bus fee, otherwise the student will be made to pay for the full quarter.
- 12. Unruly behaviour like shrieking and shouting is strictly prohibited. Courteous behaviour is expected at all times.
- 13. In no case should the driver's attention be distracted unnecessarily.
- 14. The Teacher in the bus and the Student Bus Monitors are responsible for maintaining discipline in the buses. Any serious offence must be reported to the Principal immediately.

- 15. Students must travel only by the bus route nos. allotted to them by the School Authorities.
- 16. Parents are not allowed to enter the bus under any circumstances.
- 17. Request for temporary change in bus or stops will not be entertained.
- 18. In case a student avails transport facility, school will not be responsible for any mishap in the bus. He / She shall be availing the transport facility at his / her own risk.
