REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATIONS






Schools and Universities from all over India participated in the 'Psycho-Social & Mental Health Program' and were judged on the parameters


The objective of the activity was achieved as the students developed a sense of love for the environment by getting the best out of the waste.










