### सम्पादकीय

इसी समस्या के समाधान खोजने के लिए विश्वस्तरीय अनेक प्रयास किए जा रहे हैं। 5 जून को 'पर्यावरण दिवस' मनाया जाता है। यह समस्या केवल राष्ट्र और अंतर्राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर चर्चाएँ करने से हल नहीं होगी। इसके लिए जन जागरूकता लाना आवश्यक है। इस कार्य को करने में 'मॉडर्न विद्या निकेतन विद्यालय' भी प्रयासरत है। स्वच्छता, जल सरंक्षण, पर्यावरण संरक्षण व धरती बचाओ आदि विषयों का पाठ छात्रों को पढ़ाया जाता है। इसके लिए अनेक गतिविधियाँ व कार्यक्रमों को अपनाया गया है, जैसे — वृक्षारोपण, सफ़ाई अभियान व नुक्कड़ नाटक आदि। किसी भी लक्ष्य को प्राप्त करने के लिए धेर्य और दृढ़ संकल्प की आवश्यकता है। अर्थववेद में लिखा है 'माता भूमिः — पुत्रोऽहं पृथिव्याः' अर्थात भूमि माता है। हम पृथ्वी के पुत्र हैं। अतः हम कोई भी ऐसा कार्य न करें जिससे भूमि को आघात पहुँचे। हम सभी को संकल्प करना होगा तभी धरती की रक्षा संभव है।

Discipline starts with self. As a parent, you are the role model by default. Have a close look of your priorities and preferences to set an example for your child.




