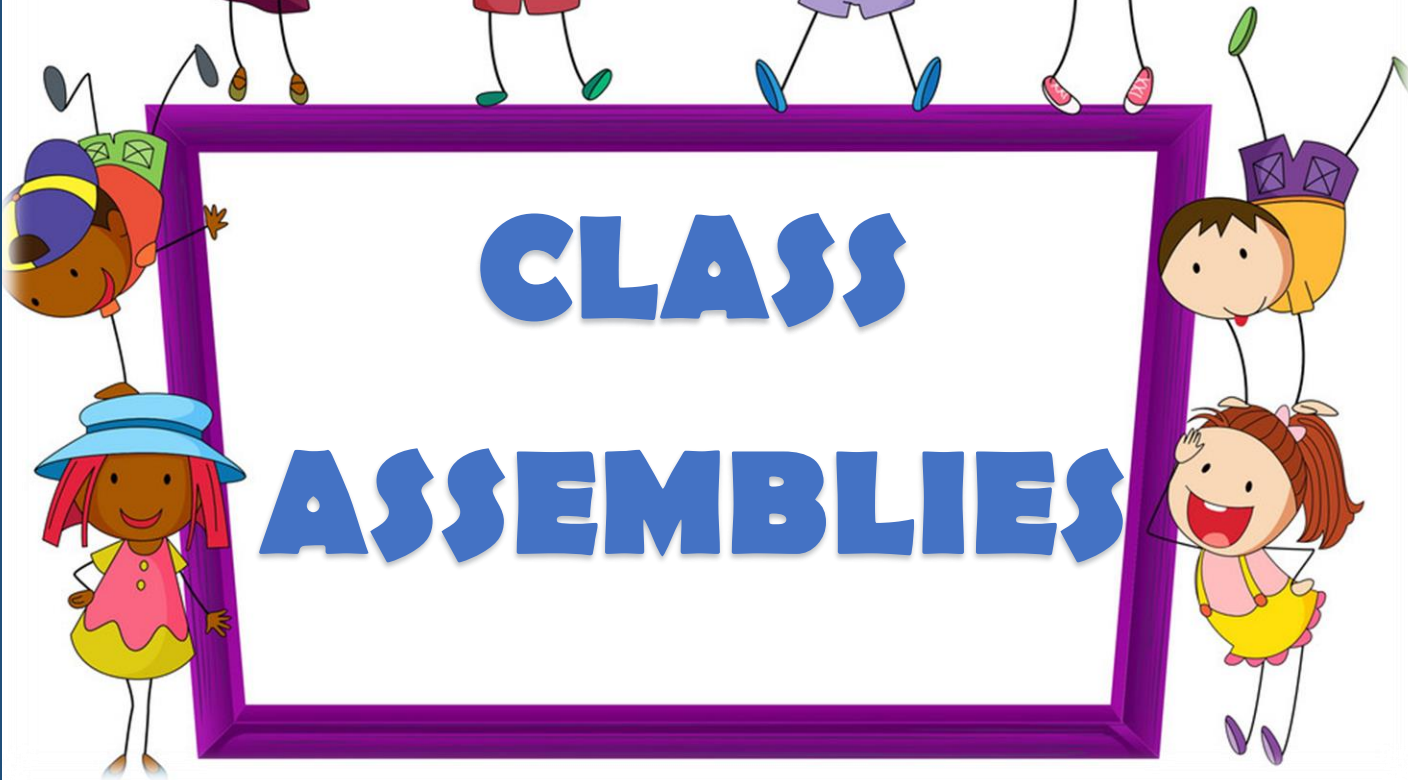

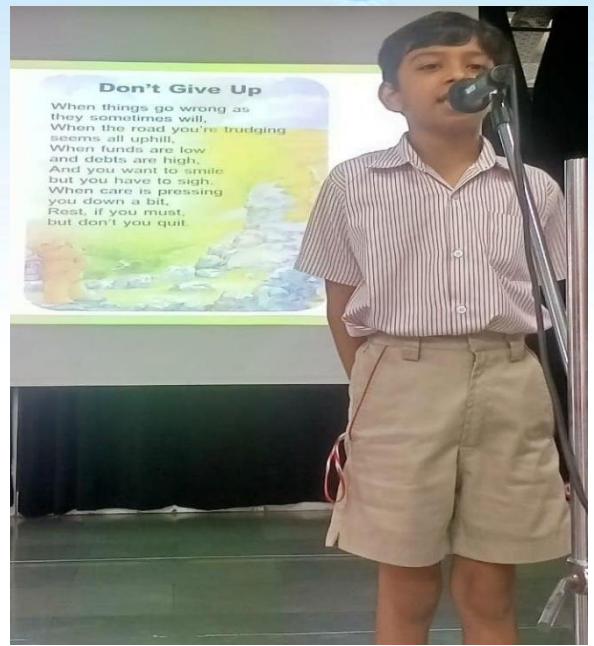
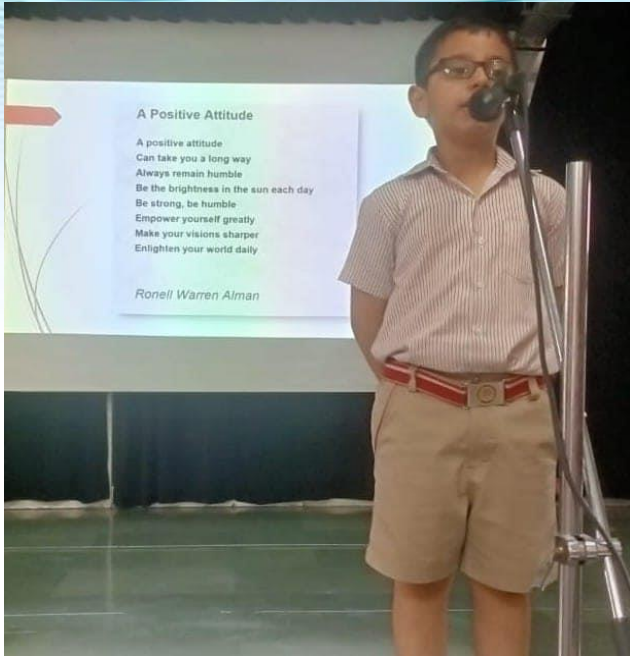
POSITIVE THINKING

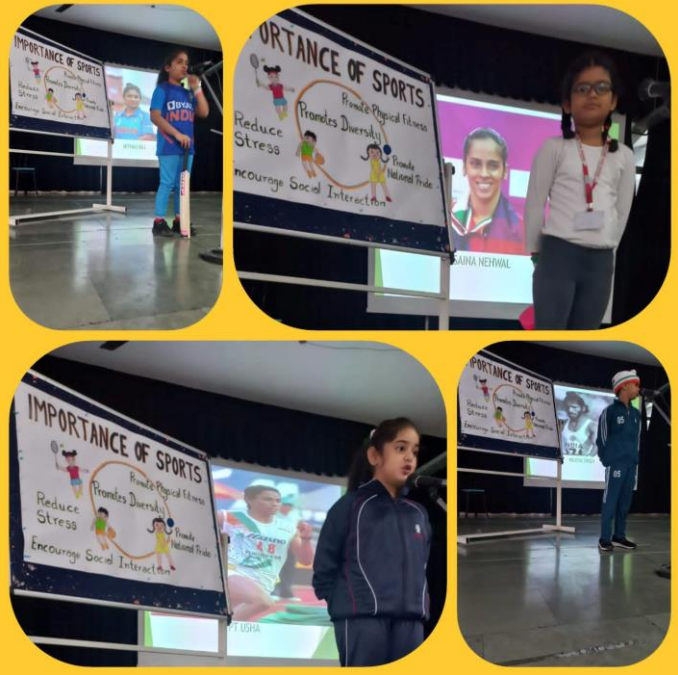
A special assembly on the topic ‘Importance of Sports’ was presented by the students of Grade IV Aster.
