All the performances left the audiences spell-bound and filled everyone’s heart with respect and gratitude for the purest bond of love i.e. Raksha Bandhan.



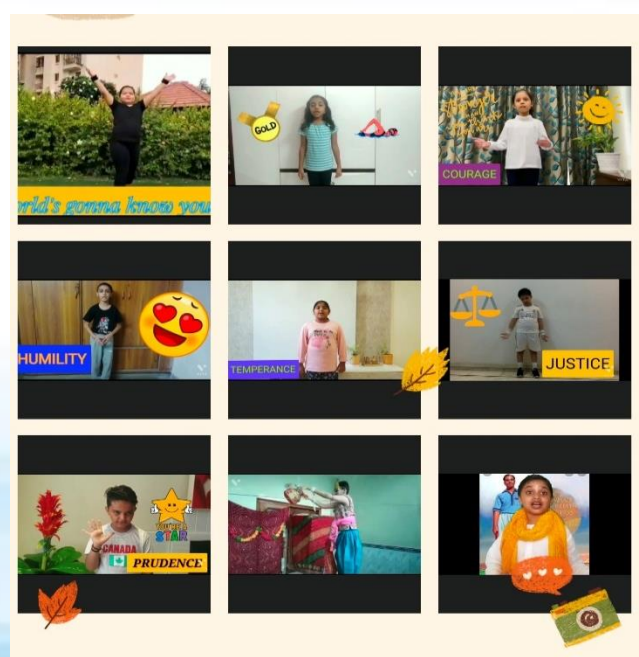
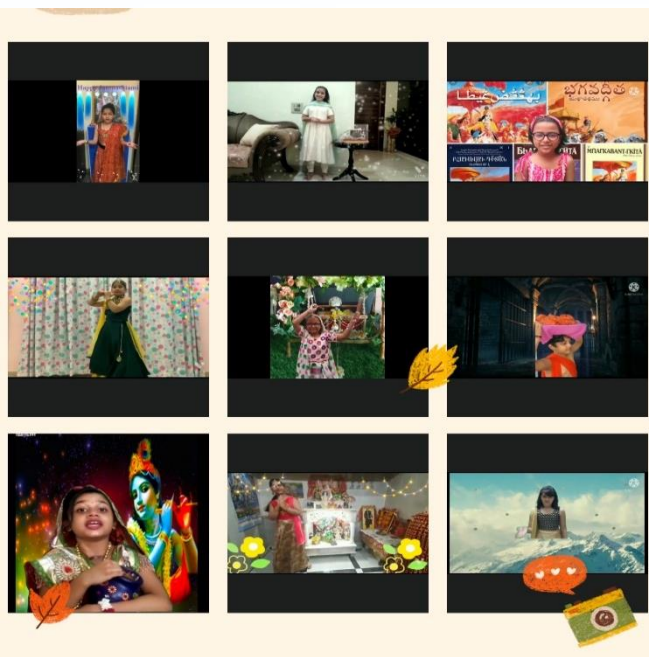
JANMASHTAMI & NATIONAL SPORTS DAY

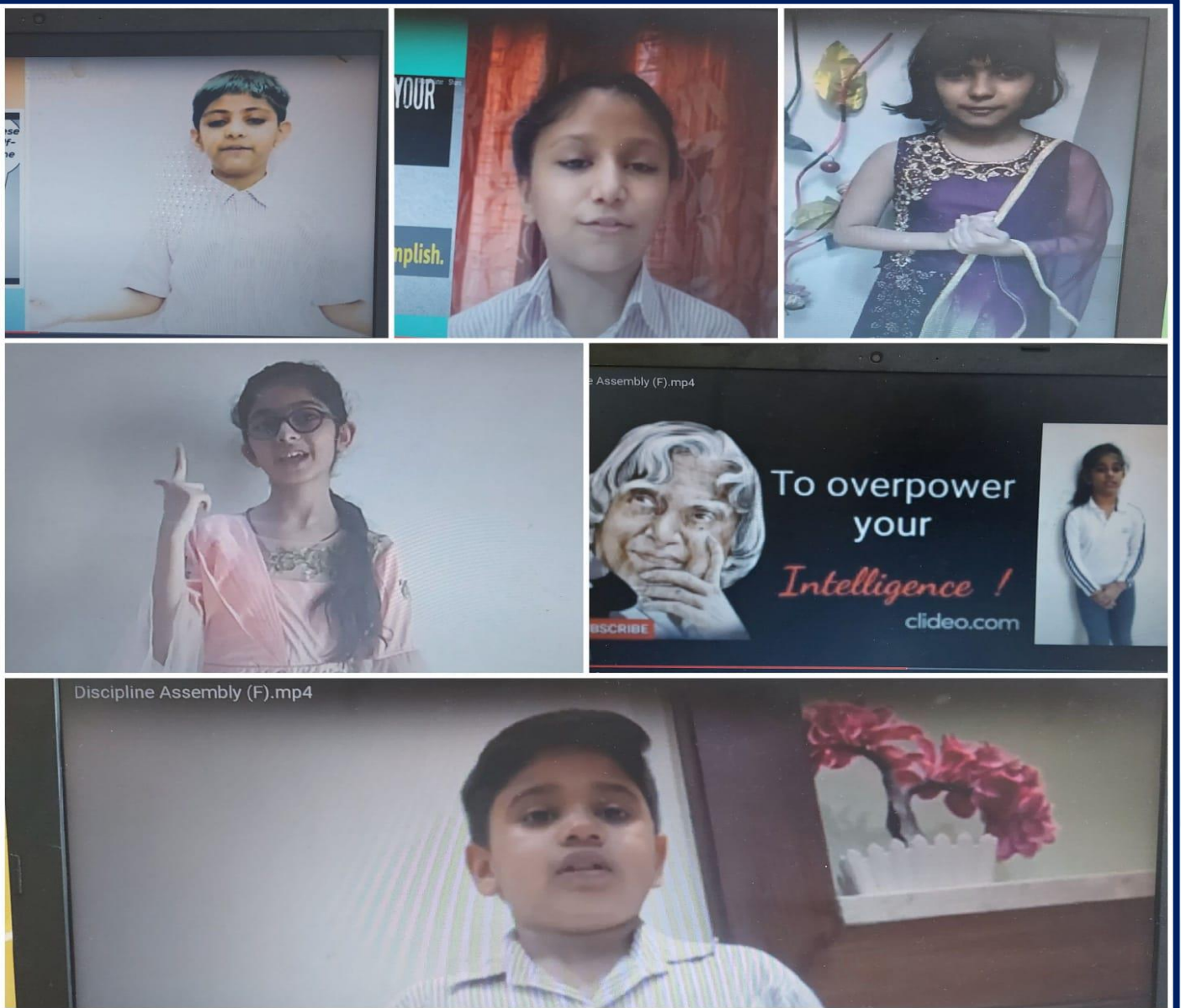
The assembly also aimed at spreading awareness about the importance of physical activities and sports in life. The students learnt that sports not only build character but also serve as motivators.

What better times than the present scenario to show our gratitude for the selfless work done by the doctors and healthcare workers throughout the world in saving people lives in these tough covid times.



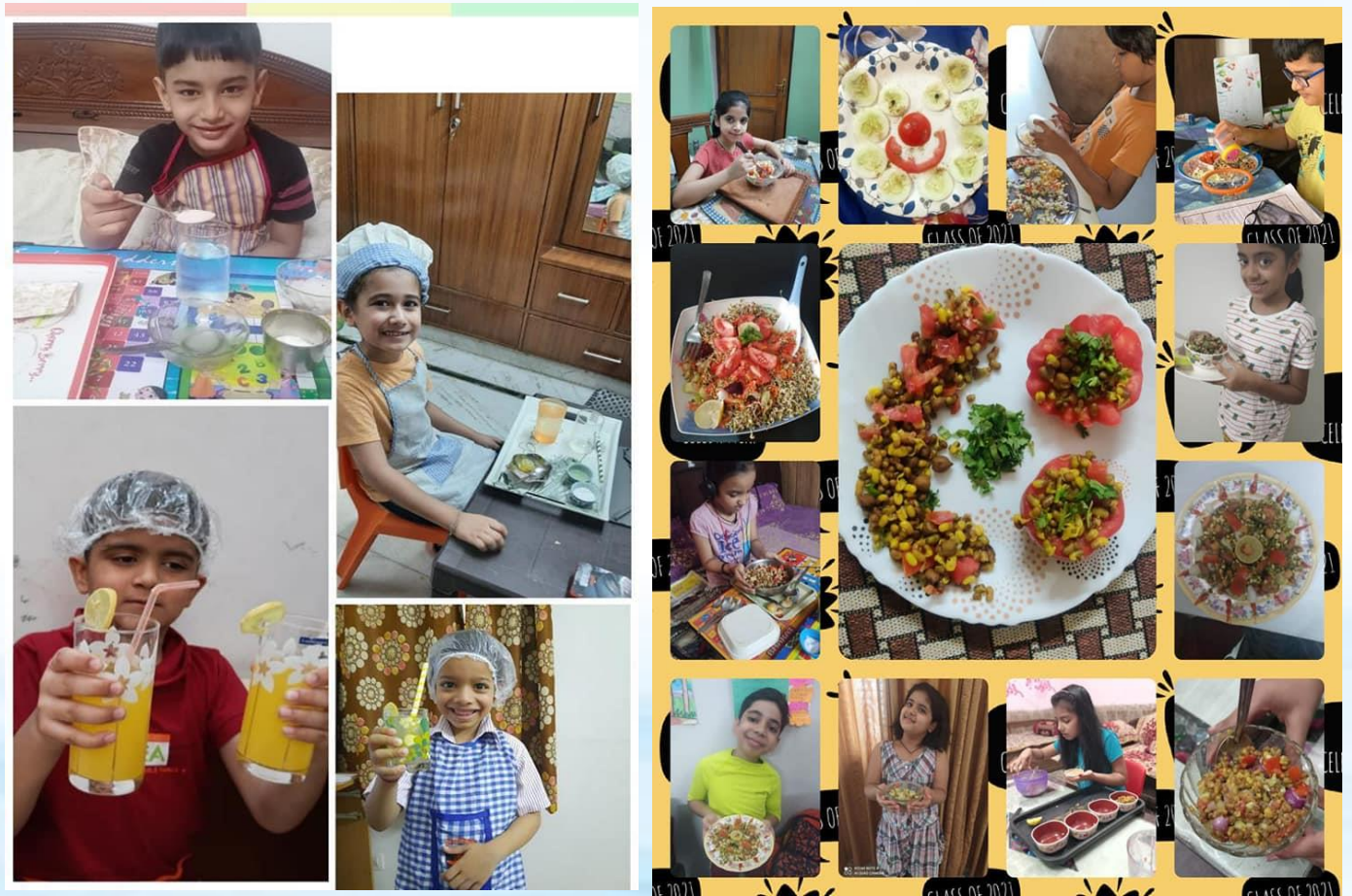
TREAT TO BEAT THE SUMMER HEAT

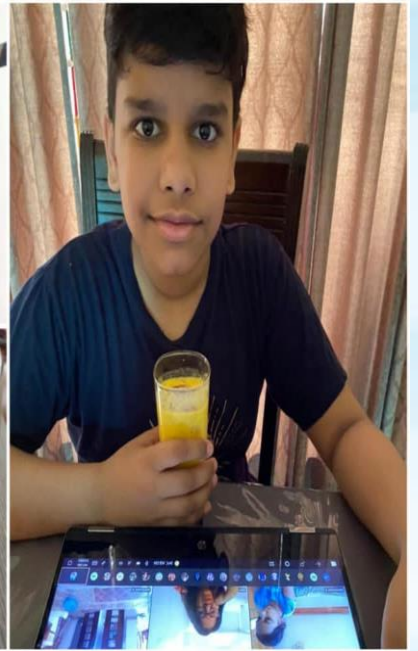

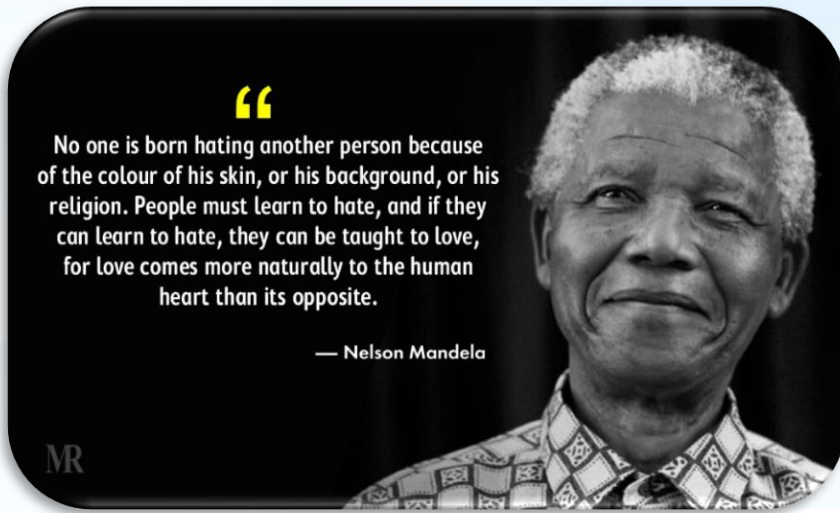
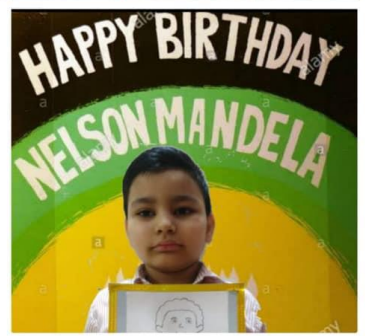
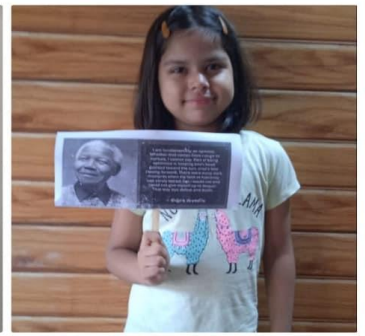
CELEBRATING DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION

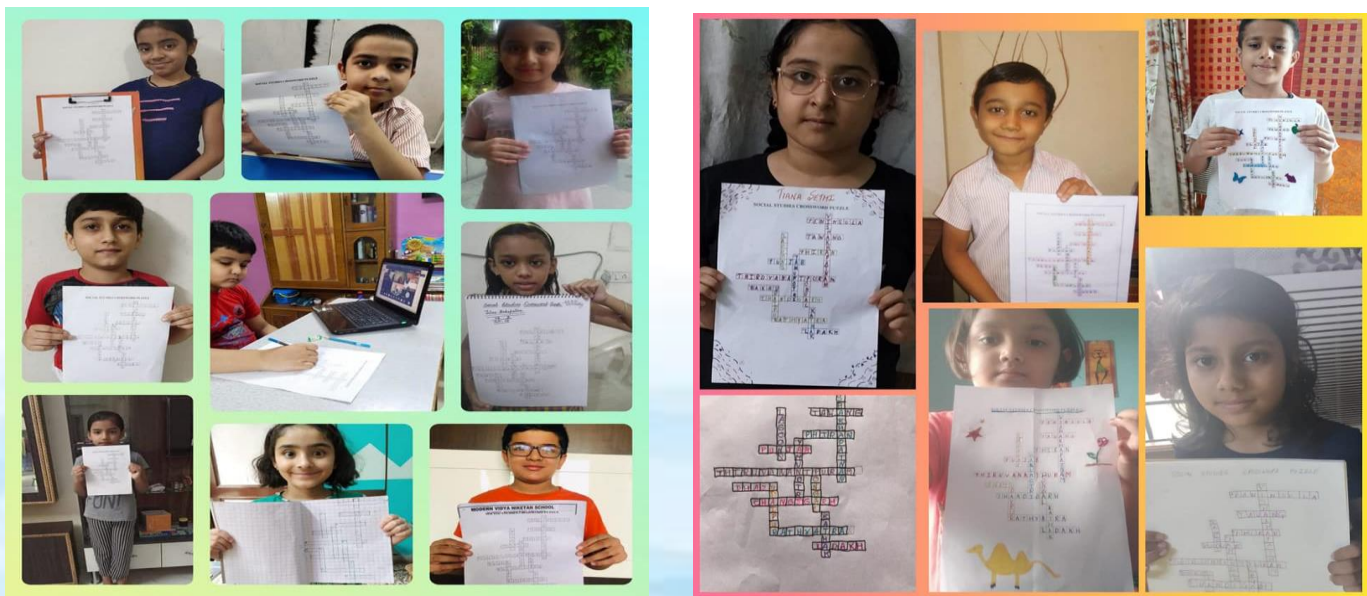


CROSSWORD PUZZLE

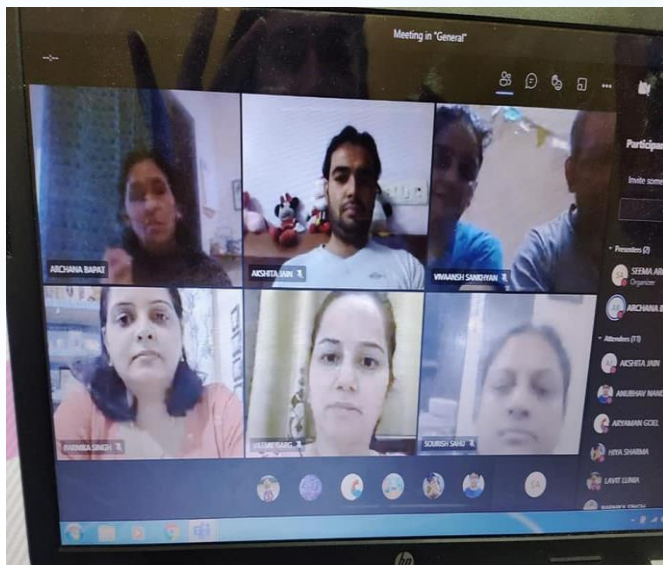




PARENTING SESSION BY SCHOOL COUNSELLOR

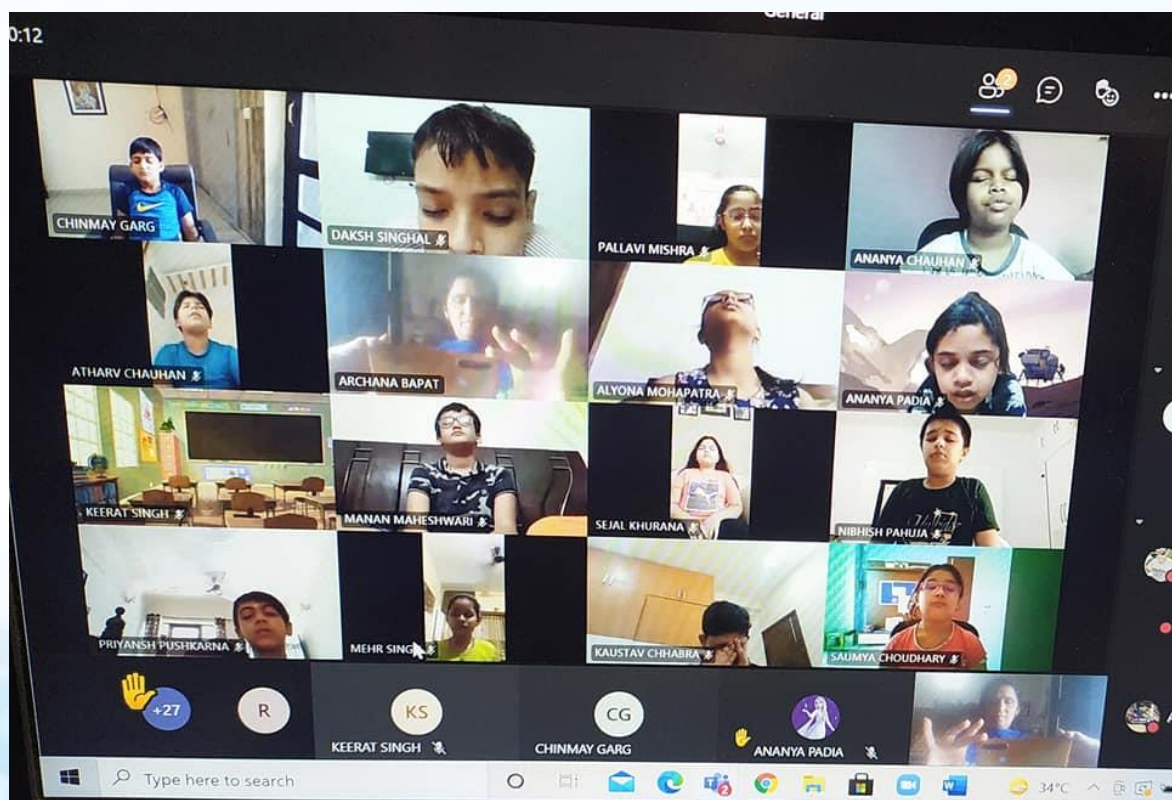
The parents appreciated the efforts wholeheartedly.

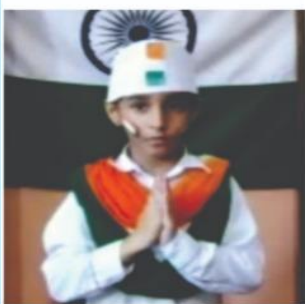
