


INDIAN AIR FORCE DAY




In the assembly, children learnt about the life of Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam. They also presented the unique and motivational thoughts on the occasion.

The students of Primary Wing also decorated their houses with rangolis, diyas and candles with zeal and enthusiasm.






















COMPASSION


"Compassion is the language the heart speaks, transcending barriers and boundaries, and nurturing the world with the beauty of empathy and kindness."

The assembly aimed at educating our kids and spreading awareness against the excessive use of social media.






















TEAMWORK

It was a memorable event that showcased the diverse talents of the primary school students. It provided a platform for the students to excel, form lasting memories, and learn important life lessons through sports.



























PRERNA DIWAS ACTIVITIES


