
As we move forward, we are excited to see each child blossom—academically, socially, and emotionally—as we explore new concepts and experiences together.

MOTHER'S DAY



Grade III got creative in the kitchen, whipping up tasty and nutritious Power Bites that were as fun to make as they were to eat!


Grade IV danced their way to fitness with a high-energy Aerobics session that left everyone grinning and glowing.

UNDERSTANDING GROWTH & FEELINGS

The school counselor, Ms. Sreshti Chaturvedi conducted an engaging and thoughtful workshop for students of Classes I to III on the theme “Understanding Growth & Feelings.” on 4th April, 25. The session was designed to help young learners explore their emotions, understand personal growth, and develop self-awareness in a fun and age-appropriate manner.

The workshop began with a simple discussion where students were encouraged to share what they know about feelings such as happiness, sadness, anger, and excitement and how these emotions show up in everyday situations. The counselor guided them through recognizing their own emotions, understanding that all feelings are valid, and learning healthy ways to express them.

To make the session interactive, a creative activity was organized where each student was given a human body outline template. They were asked to colour it in a way that best represented themselves. Alongside the colouring activity, the students were encouraged to write a few lines (or with help, draw symbols or pictures) about the changes they have observed in themselves such as growing taller, learning new things, making new friends, or becoming more confident.

This activity allowed students to reflect on their personal growth and understand that change is a natural part of growing up. It also gave them a safe space to celebrate their achievements and express their feelings through art and words.

The workshop concluded with a short reflection circle where a few students shared what they had drawn and written.





EARTH DAY CELEBRATION

With this gentle reminder, the school counselor, Ms. Sreshti Chaturvedi conducted an age-appropriate and engaging workshop for students of Classes IV and V on the topic "Stepping Up Responsibly – Navigating Physical and Emotional Ups & Downs During Puberty".

Understanding that the transition into adolescence can be both exciting and confusing, the workshop aimed to prepare young students for the changes they may soon begin to experience physically, emotionally, and socially.

The session created a safe and respectful environment where students felt comfortable learning and asking questions. Through engaging visuals and relatable scenarios, the counselor introduced the basic concepts of puberty, such as physical changes, growing independence, emotional shifts, and the importance of personal hygiene.

She emphasized that these changes are a natural part of growing up and happen to everyone at their own pace.

A key part of the workshop focused on emotional well-being. Students were taught how to identify and express their emotions in healthy ways, through talking to a trusted adult, writing, or taking quiet time for themselves. They were reminded that it's okay to feel confused, upset, or unsure, and that support is always available.

The counselor also emphasized the importance of embracing one's body image, highlighting that everyone grows and changes at their own pace. Through group discussions and guided reflections, students learned that everybody is unique and deserves respect including their own. Positive self-talk, kindness to oneself and others and the celebration of differences were encouraged.

Overall, the workshop was a thoughtful and timely initiative that empowered young learners with awareness, confidence, and the reassurance that growing up is something to embrace responsibly.

Grade II students put their hearts into crafting beautiful handmade cards, each one a unique expression of love for their fathers.


Grade III focused on sustainability and innovation, crafting wonderful cards using recyclable materials, teaching us the value of thoughtful creation.



INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY
