Grade 2: Wall of Memories


Children made beautiful wall hangings using pictures with their parents – a touching keepsake filled with warmth, laughter, and cherished moments.

The budding poets of Grade 3 have recited poems on Hindi, expressing their creativity and love for the language.


- Grade 4 – मेरे शब्द मेरी कला


BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT
