The presentation, which included an engaging PowerPoint presentation and a captivating role-play, showcased the students' in-depth research, creativity and confidence.


The assembly highlighted a range of emerging career options, including:



Throughout the week, students participated in various activities including:




The students showcased their linguistic skills and creativity, impressing the audience with their talent & enthusiasm.

The Hindi Week celebrations were a resounding success, fostering a deeper appreciation and love for the Hindi language among students and staff alike.























MVN Sector-17 kicked off its Maths Week with great enthusiasm and curiosity!


The event, designed for Classes VI to VII, brought mathematical concepts to life through interactive and engaging activities.

The visit taught the values of empathy, kindness, and the power of giving back to the community. The experience served as a reminder that even small gestures can create a ripple effect of positivity and change.








TRIP TO JAIPUR

Through insightful discussions students learnt to continue to build their resilience through adversity and emerge stronger, more united, and more determined than ever before.





The workshop concluded with enthusiastic feedback from the students, who expressed their eagerness to apply these valuable strategies to enhance their productivity and reduce procrastination.




EXPLORING CULTURES, ENRICHING MINDS



