CIVIC SENSE AMONG STUDENTS : A LOOK AT THE ISSUE

Dear Parent / Student

Having good civic sense is important for students. It shows their character and helps the community. But lately, it seems like students are not as aware of their civic duties as they used to be. This lack of care for their community and environment is becoming a concern that we need to deal with.

There are a few reasons why students might not have strong civic sense. One main reason is that schools don't always focus enough on teaching civic education. Schools often prioritize academic success, so lessons about being a good citizen sometimes get less attention. This means students might not fully understand their roles and duties in their community.

Another big reason is the impact of social media. Sometimes, social media can show bad behaviors and attitudes. Students might see others littering, damaging public property, or doing other anti-social things without consequences. This can make such behaviors seem normal.

When students lack civic sense, it can have many effects. Students who litter, waste water, or harm the environment contribute to making their surroundings worse. Damaging public property or writing graffiti not only makes the individual look bad but also reflects poorly on the community. Students who don't have civic sense might also not respect their classmates, teachers, or other people in the community, which can weaken social bonds.

To help students develop better civic sense, several steps can be taken. Schools are already working on this through different programs. The event culminated with a grand Prize Distribution Ceremony, celebrating not just the winners but the spirit of learning, curiosity, and creativity that all participants brought to life.



MOTHER'S DAY ASSEMBLY A HEARTFELT TRIBUTE






Innovate to Adapt: Minds in Motion


As Science Week at MVN Sector 17 drew to a close, Days 4 and 5 were packed with creativity, critical thinking, and futuristic vision.






INTERNATIONAL DAY OF YOGA 2025

Each class expressed their love and appreciation in their own meaningful way:



Class VI students created charming showpieces titled 'Mom & Me' using decorated glass bottles and loving messages.

The day was a touching tribute to the women who shape our lives with unconditional love. Because truly, "God couldn't be everywhere and therefore he made Mothers."








EARTH DAY CELEBRATIONS

Student Internship at Fortis Escorts Hospital





MIND-BODY CONNECTION

The school counsellor, Ms. Sreshti Chaturvedi conducted an engaging and insightful workshop on the topic 'Mind-Body Connection' for students of Classes VI & VII on 2nd April'25. The session aimed to help students to understand how their emotions and mental well-being can directly impact their physical health.

The workshop began with an interactive discussion where students were introduced to the concept of the mind-body connection. The counsellor explained how emotions like stress, anxiety, happiness, and sadness can manifest physically in the body. Real-life examples were shared to help students relate to the topic, such as experiencing stomach aches due to nervousness or feeling fatigue when overwhelmed. To reinforce this understanding, an engaging activity using chart paper was conducted. They were asked to identify areas where they experience physical sensations in response to emotional pain. Using different colors, they marked specific areas where they felt stress, tension, or discomfort when experiencing emotions such as anger, sadness, fear, or excitement. This hands-on exercise helped students visually map their emotions onto their physical selves, promoting self-awareness and emotional intelligence. The counselor then guided a reflective discussion on healthy coping mechanisms, such as deep breathing, mindfulness, and physical activity, to manage emotional distress effectively. The session concluded with students sharing their learnings and personal insights. Many expressed that they had never realized how closely their emotions were linked to their physical health. The workshop provided them with valuable tools to recognize and address emotional challenges in a healthy manner. This initiative fosters a deeper understanding of mental well-being and encourages students to be more mindful of their emotional and physical health.



The school counsellor, Ms. Sreshti Chaturvedi conducted an insightful and interactive workshop for Class VIII students on the topic "Mind-Body Connection" on 7th April'25. The session aimed to help students understand how emotions influence physical sensations and overall well-being.

The counsellor introduced the concept through engaging discussions and visual aids, including an Emotional Pain Chart. This chart helped students to recognize how different emotions such as stress, anger, happiness, or fear can trigger physical reactions in specific parts of the body, such as tension in the shoulders, stomach discomfort, or a racing heartbeat. Students were encouraged to reflect on their experiences and identify how their bodies respond to both positive and negative emotions.

They were guided through a mindfulness exercise where they observed how their body felt during moments of calm versus stress. The counsellor then facilitated a group discussion where students shared different emotional reactions for example, tightness in the chest when anxious or lightness in the head when happy. This helped them better understand the signals their bodies give and how to respond in healthy ways. The session was not only informative but also empowering, equipping students with tools to better manage their emotions and maintain a balanced mind-body connection.




EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE

“You can't control the waves but you can learn to surf”

The school counsellor, Ms. Sreshti Chaturvedi conducted a highly interactive and insightful workshop on Emotional Intelligence for the students of class X. The session began by highlighting the difference between Intelligence Quotient (IQ) and Emotional Quotient (EQ), helping students to understand that while IQ might help them solve problems, it's EQ that helps them manage themselves and their relationships effectively. Students learned that emotional intelligence involves recognizing, understanding, and managing our emotions, as well as empathising with others.

To bring these concepts to life, a series of engaging activities were included throughout the workshop. Students played 'Emotion Charades,' where they expressed different emotions using only facial expressions, helping them to understand the subtleties of non-verbal communication. This was followed by role-playing scenarios that allowed them to step into others' shoes and practice empathy. During story time, students reflected on emotionally challenging situations and discussed healthy ways to respond. A powerful task called 'Flip the Thought' encouraged students to transform negative thoughts into positive ones, reinforcing the importance of perspective and self-talk. The session also covered anger management strategies, equipping students with simple techniques like deep breathing, journaling, and taking mindful pauses.

At the end of this workshop, students were invited to write down their worries, fears, or any lingering negative emotions on slips of paper and drop them into the 'Worry Box'. This symbolic act served as a reminder of the importance of releasing emotional baggage and not letting negativity occupy space in the mind.



ANTI - BULLYING

To foster a safe, respectful, and inclusive school environment, the school counsellor Ms. Sreshti Chaturvedi conducted an impactful Anti-Bullying Workshop for the students of Class VIII. The session aimed to raise awareness about the different forms of bullying, its harmful effects, and how students can take active steps to prevent it through empathy, respect, and kindness.

The workshop began with a meaningful discussion on what bullying looks like in verbal, physical, social, and cyberbullying and how it affects individuals emotionally and mentally. Through real-life scenarios and group reflections, students were encouraged to identify bullying behaviors and explore healthy ways to respond, support peers, and seek help when needed. A powerful message that echoed throughout the session was the importance of standing up, speaking out, and being upstanders, not bystanders in situations involving bullying. To reinforce this commitment, all students came together at the end of the workshop to take a Pledge to Stop Bullying, promising to treat everyone with respect, speak up against bullying, and spread kindness in their everyday actions.

As a creative and fun follow-up initiative, the counsellor also introduced the "Kindness Bingo", a chart filled with simple, meaningful acts of kindness. Each classroom section received a Kindness Bingo chart pinned to their class board, encouraging students to complete the listed kind acts collaboratively. The first section to complete their chart will be honoured as the "Kindness Champions", celebrating their efforts in creating a more caring and friendly school environment.

CBSE CLASS - X BOARD EXAM RESULT 2024-25

A Legacy Etched in Excellence

The school proudly celebrates the extraordinary performance of its students in the CBSE Class X Board Examinations for the academic session 2024–25.
