FROM COUNSELLOR'S DESK

When Motivation Fades: How to Keep Studying Even on Difficult Days

Every student has days when studying feels hard. The books are open, the homework is waiting, but the mind feels tired, distracted or simply uninterested. On such days, it may seem easier to postpone everything until tomorrow. This happens to everyone and it is a natural part of student life.

Many people believe that successful students are always motivated. The truth is quite different. Motivation comes and goes. Even high achievers face moments when they do not feel like studying. What makes the difference is not constant motivation, but the ability to continue with discipline and determination.

One of the biggest mistakes students make is waiting to “feel ready” before they begin. In reality, motivation often appears after starting, not before. Taking the first small step reading one page, solving one question or studying for ten minutes can create momentum and make the task feel easier.

Students can try these simple strategies when motivation is low:

- Begin with one small task instead of focusing on everything at once.*
- Use short study sessions such as 20 minutes of focus followed by a short break.*
- Keep distractions away by putting the phone aside and choosing a quiet place.*
- Set realistic goals for the day. Small progress is still progress.*
- Appreciate your effort and avoid being too hard on yourself.*

Parents also have an important role to play. Instead of only asking about marks or unfinished work, they can encourage healthy routines, proper sleep, balanced meals and regular breaks. A few supportive words often help more than pressure.

Teachers can support students by promoting balance, wellbeing and the value of effort. When students know that growth matters as much as grades, they feel more confident and motivated.

Students should always remember: you do not need to feel inspired every day to succeed. Some of the greatest progress is made on the days when you least feel like starting. Keep going, one step at a time and success will follow.

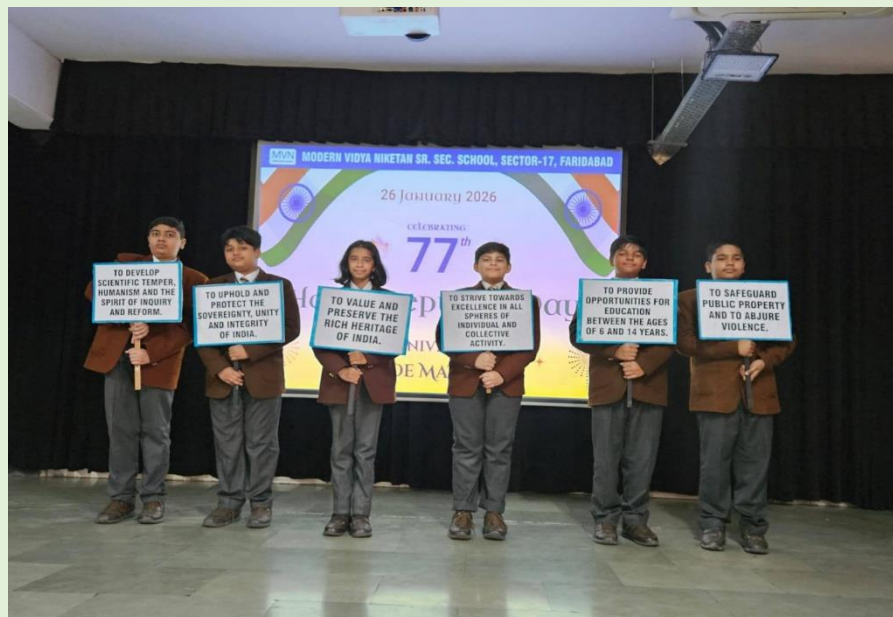

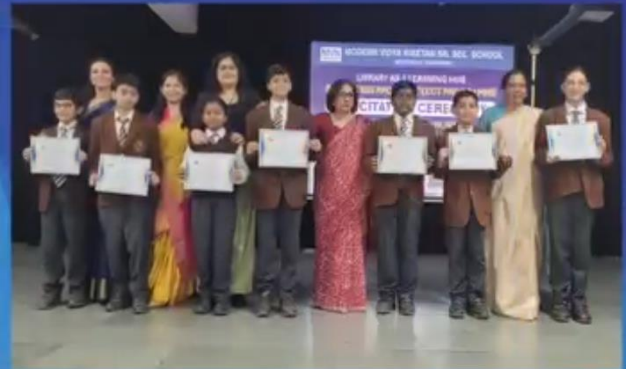
The ceremony stood as a powerful tribute to young minds who read with purpose, research with curiosity, and reflect with wisdom, leaders in the making, ready to excel.

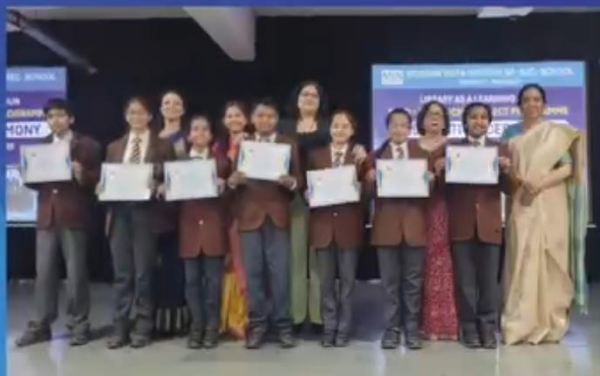

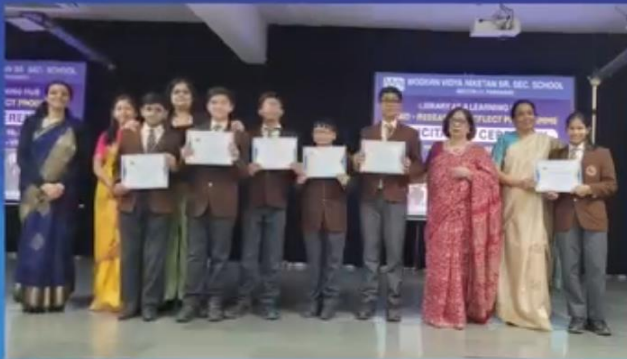

“Emotional strength is the key to lasting achievement.”

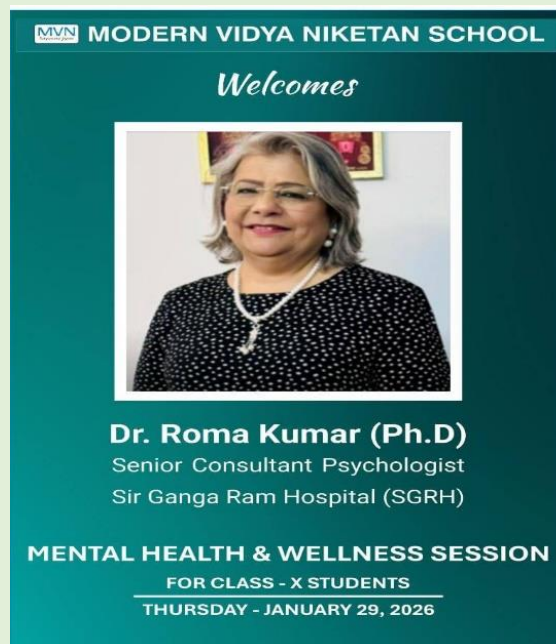

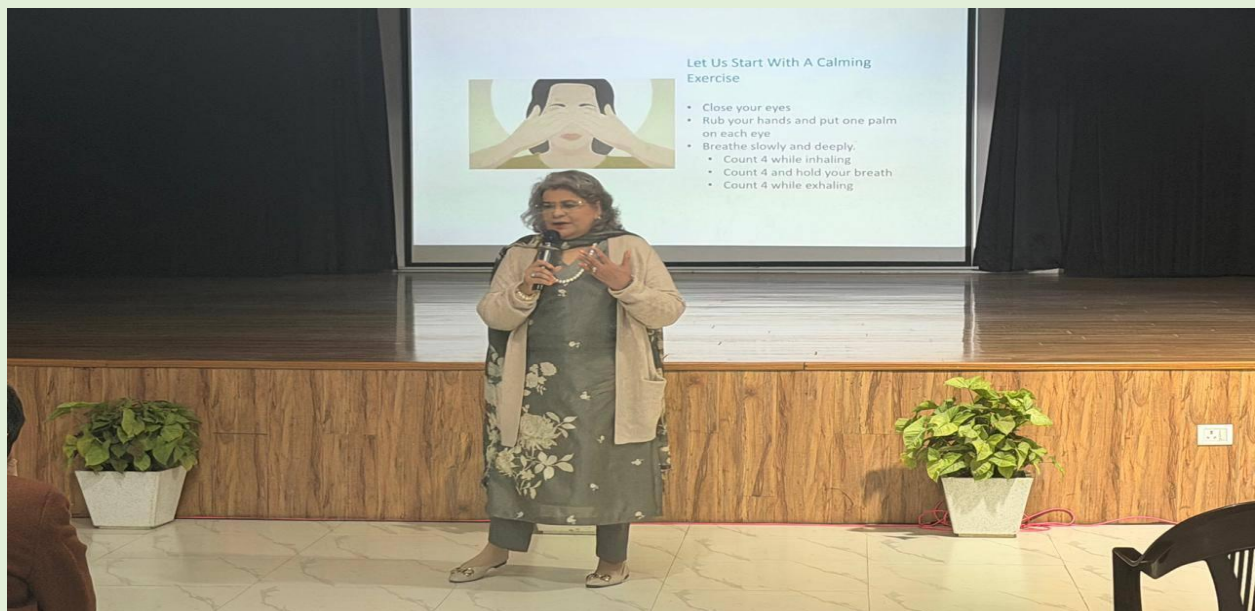
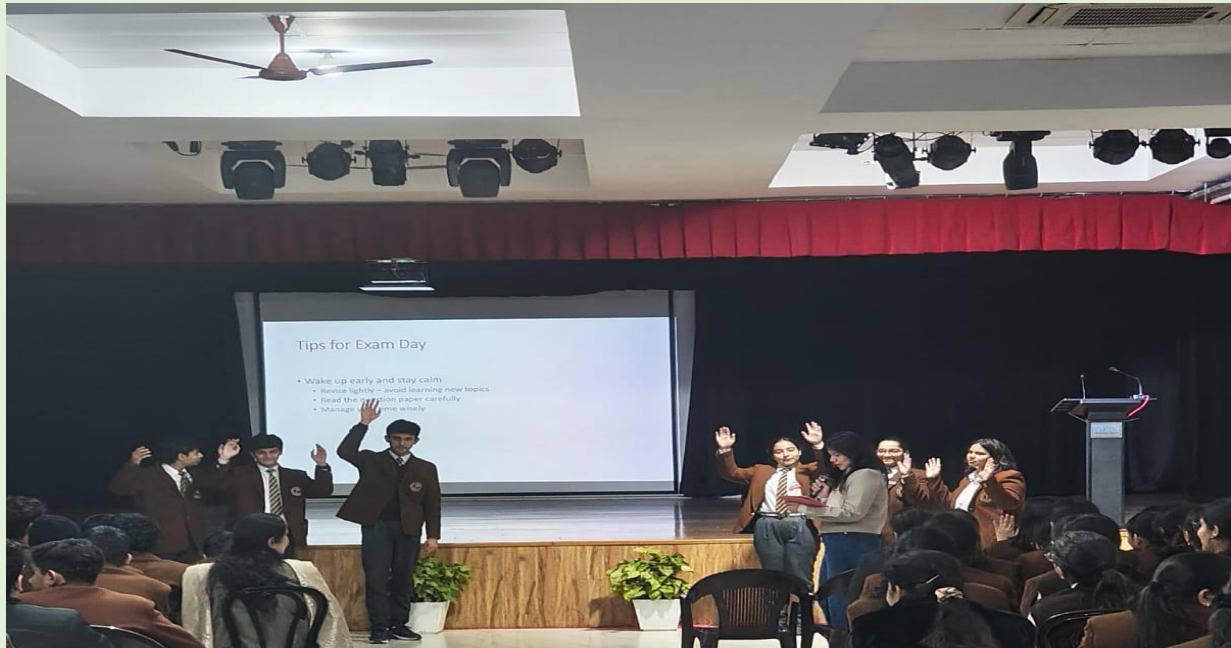
The session commenced with the address and introduction by Dr. Neeta Bali, Director Academics, MVN Schools, who emphasized upon the importance of mental wellness, emotional balance, and timely guidance during adolescence.

The session was led by Dr. Roma Kumar (Ph.D.), Senior Consultant Psychologist, Sir Ganga Ram Hospital (SGRH), who addressed crucial aspects of adolescent mental health. Through her insightful and empathetic interaction, students were guided on managing stress, exam pressure, emotions, and building emotional resilience during this pivotal stage of life. Dr. Roma also highlighted the role of proper nutrition, regular exercise, a healthy circadian clock and adequate sleep in maintaining mental well-being. Speaking positively about social media, she encouraged its responsible use, advising students to engage mindfully and ensure that the content they consume is age-appropriate and meaningful.

The session concluded with a vote of thanks by Ms. Tanu Khatter, who expressed gratitude to the resource person and dignitaries for their valuable presence and support.

Through such meaningful initiatives, MVN continues to foster awareness, resilience, and well-balanced growth, empowering students to face academic and personal challenges with confidence and clarity.





EXAM SKILLS FOR STUDENTS

“Exams are not a test of who you are, but a chance to show what you have learned.”

With this thoughtful message, the school counsellor, Ms. Sreshti Chaturvedi conducted an engaging workshop on Exam Skills for students of Classes VI–VIII on 9th February 2026. The session opened with an interactive Myths vs Facts on Exams discussion to build rapport with students. Common misconceptions were addressed in a supportive manner, encouraging students to share their thoughts and easing their exam-related apprehensions.

The counsellor then introduced three essential exam skills in a structured and student-friendly way. Preparatory skills focused on planning, goal setting and maintaining healthy study routines. Acquisition skills emphasized effective learning strategies such as mind mapping, chunking and self-questioning to enhance understanding and retention. Examination skills highlighted practical techniques for time management, careful reading of questions and maintaining composure during the examination.

To further strengthen learning, students were guided on memory recall hacks and active learning strategies, including the use of flowcharts, diagrams and visual organizers for structured revision. A short video demonstrated how Vedic practices can be integrated into modern lifestyles, with special emphasis on ‘Tratak Kriya’ as a powerful tool to improve concentration.

The workshop concluded with the introduction of the Box Breathing Technique, a simple yet effective method to reduce anxiety and enhance calmness. Students practiced the technique and were encouraged to use it before and during exams whenever they feel stressed. The session concluded on a positive and empowering note, equipping students with practical skills, confidence and a healthy perspective towards examinations.
