






EMPOWERING YOUNG MINDS WITH PARIKSHA PE CHARCHA 2025!




FOUNDER'S DAY LANGAR – A TRIBUTE TO SHRI GOPAL SHARMA SIR

WORKSHOPS

BREATHE, RELAX, MANAGE: ANGER MANAGEMENT TECHNIQUES

An enlightening workshop was conducted on 27th Jan'24 for students of classes VI & VII by the school counselor Ms. Sreshti Chaturvedi. The workshop was delved into effective anger management techniques to help students understand and control their emotions better. The session was initiated by explaining the intricate cycle of anger, helping students to understand the triggers and responses that constitute this powerful emotion. Following this insightful introduction, several practical techniques were introduced to help students to control their anger. The first technique was deep breathing exercises, which taught the students how to use controlled breathing to calm their minds in stressful situations. Then, they were guided through progressive muscle relaxation, a technique designed to reduce physical tension by tensing and then slowly relaxing different muscle groups. The emphasis was also given to the importance of physical activity, as a means to clear their heads and regain composure. To gauge their current anger management skills, the workshop included an anger management questionnaire that allowed students to reflect on their responses to anger and identify areas for improvement.

By the end of the session, the students had not only learned valuable techniques to manage their anger but also gained a deeper understanding of their emotional responses, equipping them with the tools needed to navigate their emotions constructively.




