# ASSEMBLIES

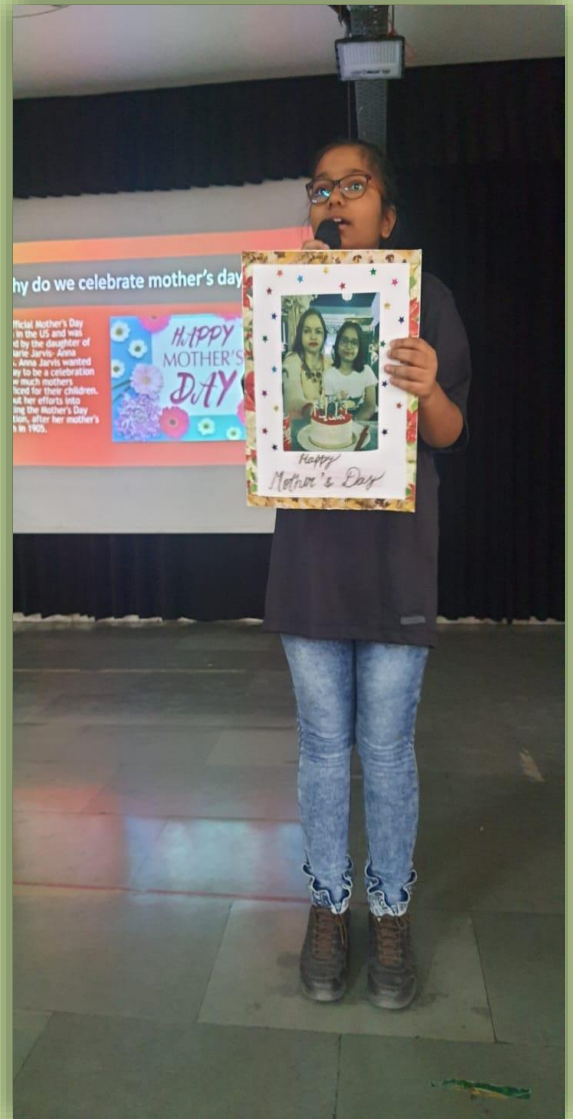
## MOTHER'S DAY

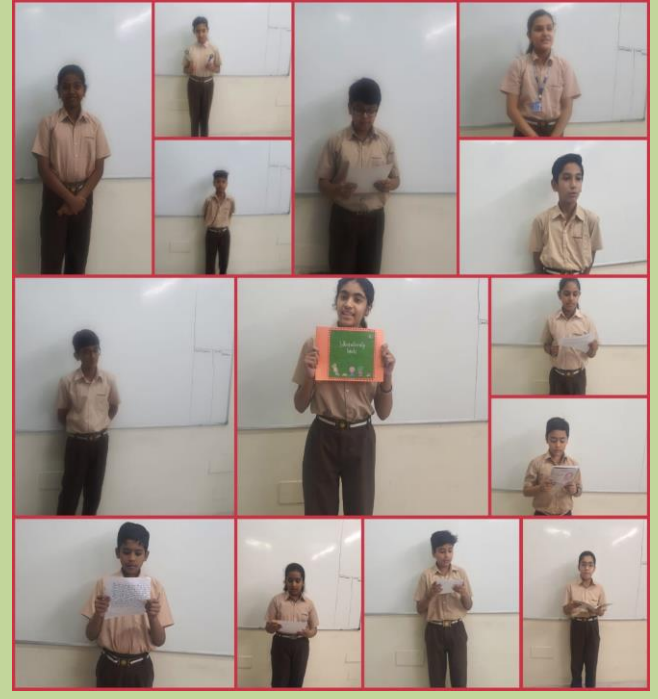
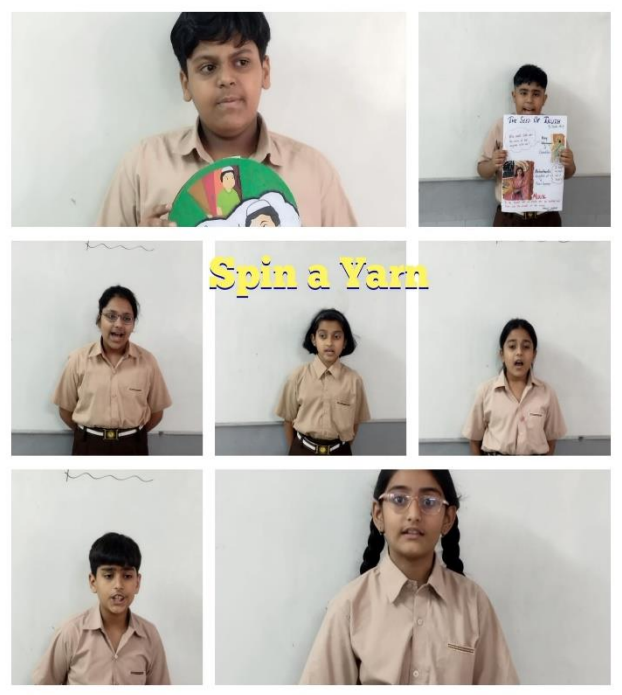
# ENGLISH FIESTA: BOOK WEEK

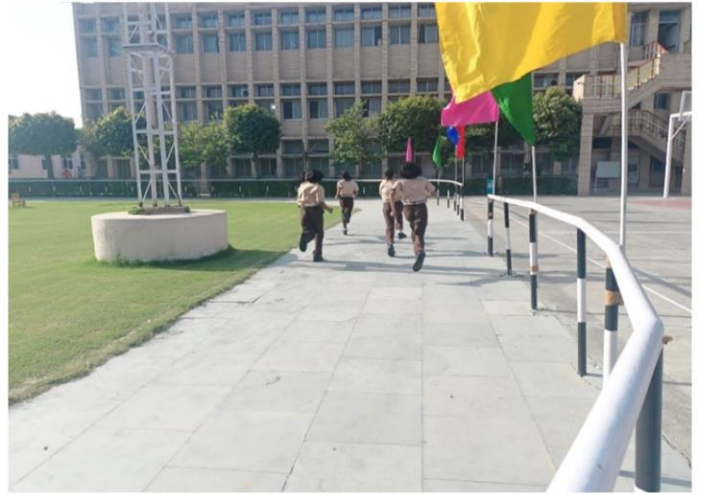


# ACTIVITIES

# BOOK FAIR

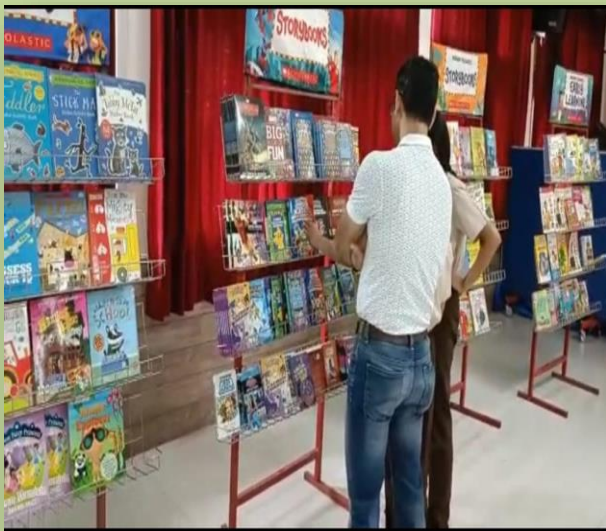

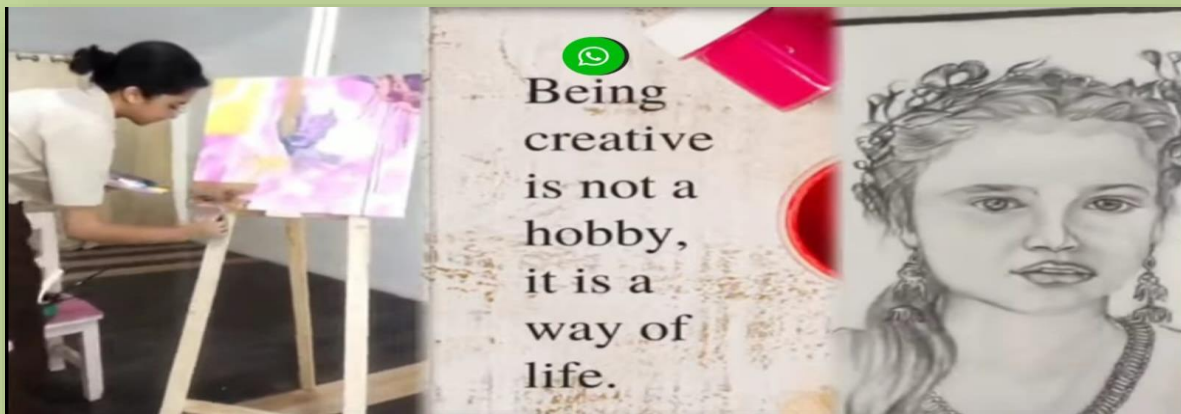


# SYMPHONY STROKES

Let's come together as facilitators and foster a growth mindset in students for future career success.

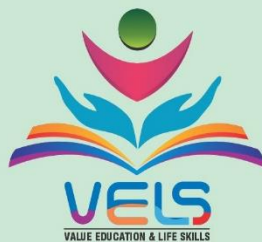
# CAREER COUNSELLING

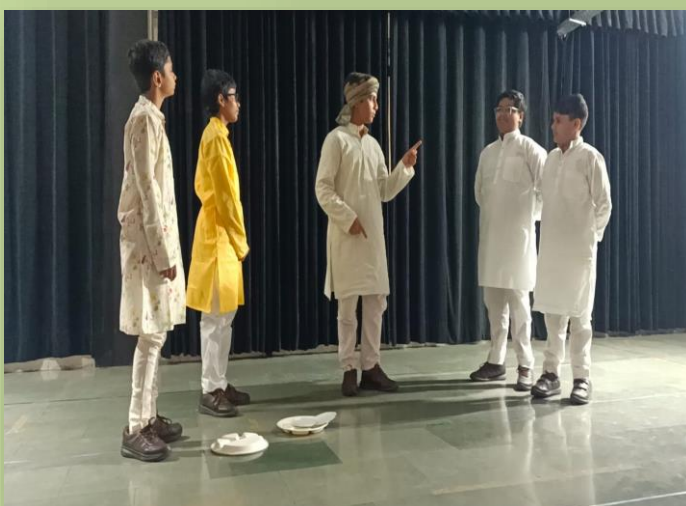

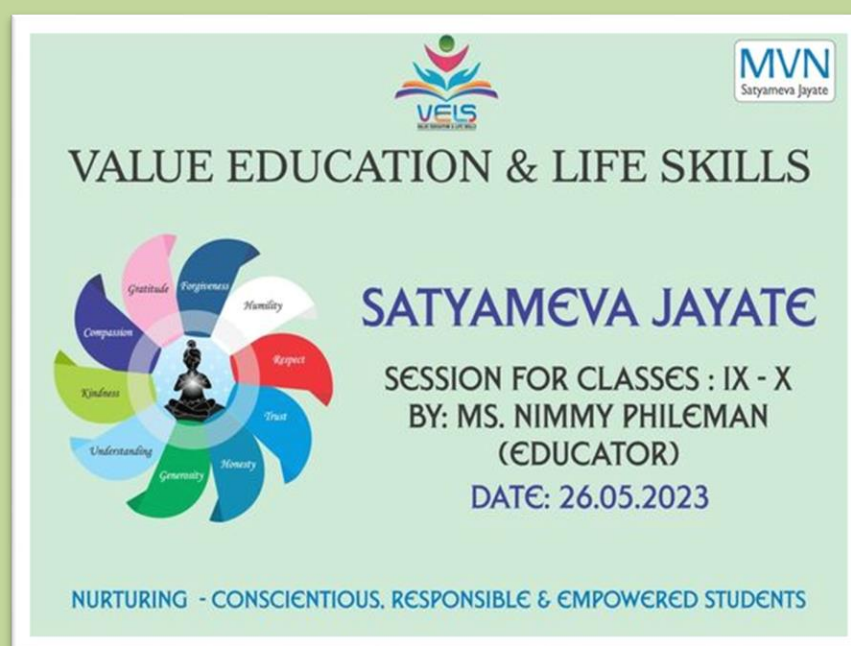

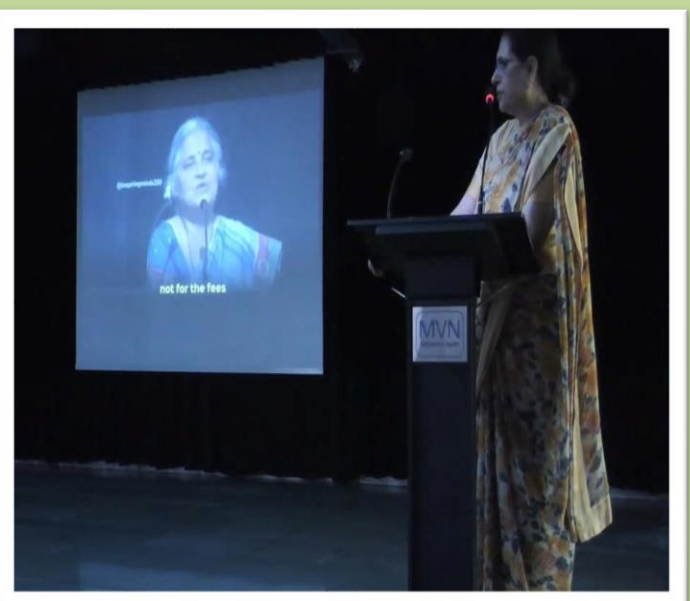
