## *Dear Parents*

*As educators, we have the privilege of witnessing the growth and development of your children on a daily basis. Our classrooms are not just spaces for academic learning but also fertile ground for emotional growth. Few things affect children more than the emotional awareness of adults around them. Today, I would like to draw upon my experiences as both a parent and a teacher to share some insights on anger management in the best interests of our kids.*

*The landscape of parenthood is fast paced and ever evolving. Perhaps the most formidably challenging terrain in that landscape is our anger zone. Stressors abound, and frustrations often surface. As parents, we are not immune to these challenges, but our reactions to them can make all the difference in our children's lives. As parents, we are not only the first role models for our children but also their emotional anchors. How we navigate our emotions, especially anger, profoundly impacts our children's emotional development.*

*The onus lies on us to create an environment where children can learn to understand and manage their emotions effectively. They are like sponges, soaking up the behaviors and emotions they witness in their parents. When we manage anger constructively, we teach our children invaluable life skills. When they see us managing anger calmly and assertively, they learn that it is a normal emotion which can be channeled positively.*

*Here are some methods proven effective for anger management:*

- *Practicing mindfulness increases awareness and identification of triggers. It may appear as physical sensations, thoughts, feelings, and behaviors.*
- *Yoga, meditation and white noise can be used to achieve a relaxed mental state and release tension.*
- *It is essential to practice active listening, assertiveness, and empathy, in expressing one's feelings and needs clearly and respectfully without blaming or attacking others.*
- *Involve your children in brainstorming, evaluating, or finding a compromise to arrive at constructive and mutually acceptable solutions to the issues that cause anger.*
- *Seek professional help from a counselor or therapist if your anger is overwhelming or interfering with your daily functioning and relationships.*

*Anger is a natural emotion, and learning how to manage it is a lifelong journey. It is a difficult task but worth every ounce of effort. As teachers and parents—we can provide our children with the tools and guidance they need to navigate their emotions and grow into emotionally resilient individuals. We must begin by modelling the behaviour we wish to see.*

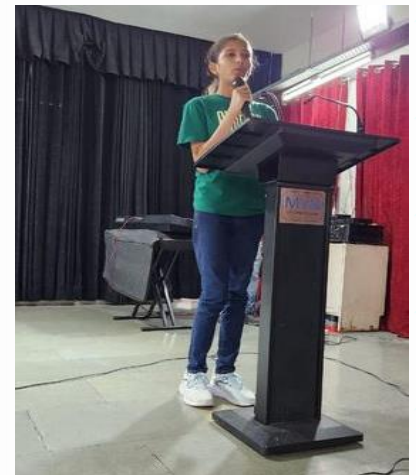


# WORLD NATURE CONSERVATION DAY

The students were able to successfully deliver the message that only if we all work together and conserve nature, can we live happily on the earth.

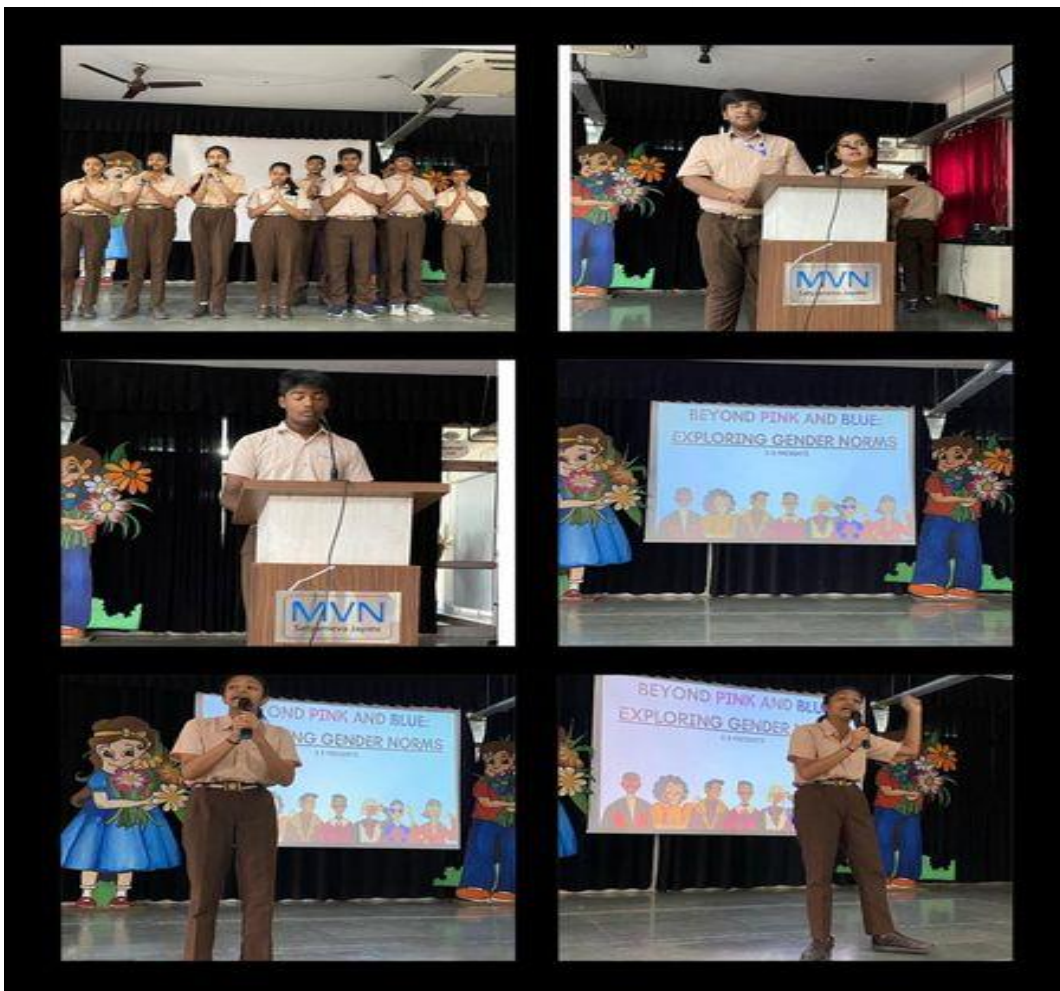


# PPTS AND SEMINARS

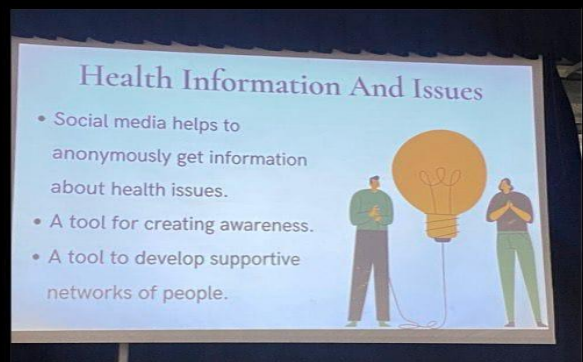






# POWER OF SOCIAL MEDIA

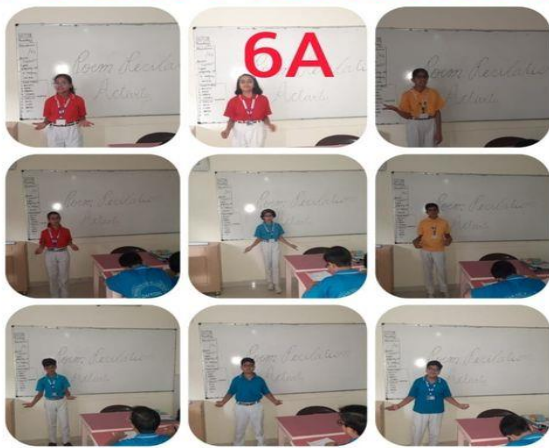
# POEM RECITATION ACTIVITY

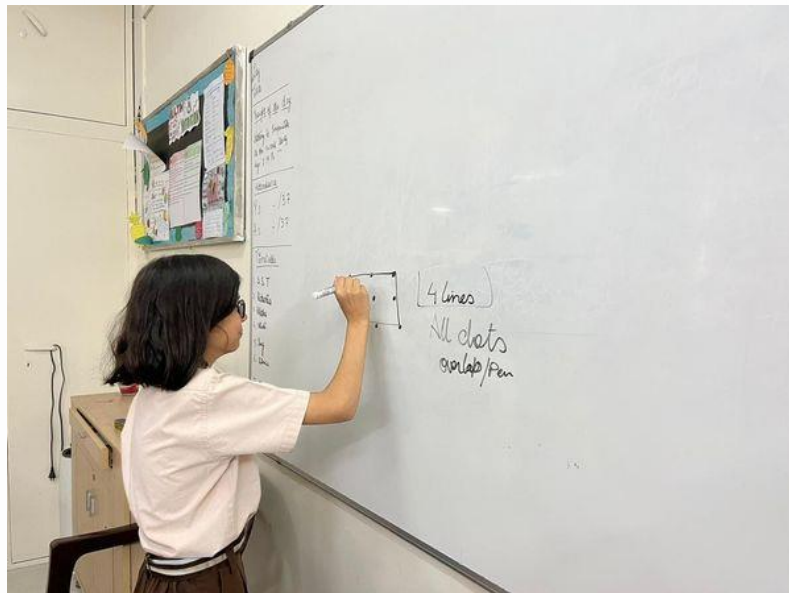
Instilling moral values in young hearts plants seeds of compassion, integrity, and kindness, shaping a brighter, more empathetic future for humanity.

### BIOLOGY BEYOND MEDICINE AND RECENT DEVELOPMENT

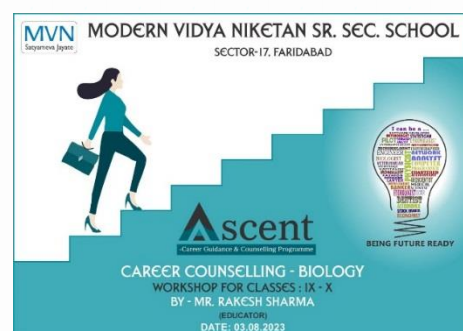
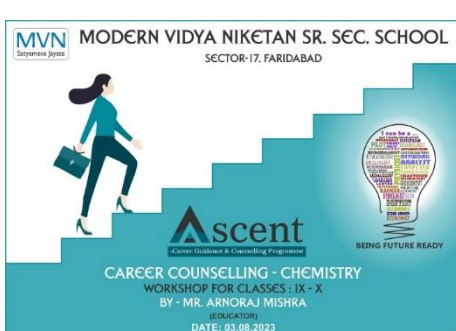
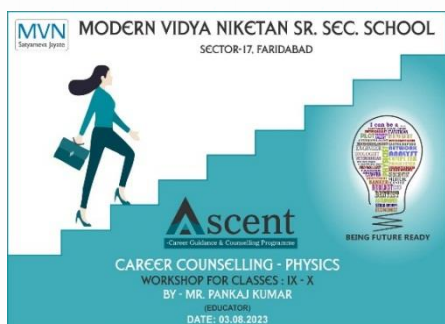
## CLASSES IX&X

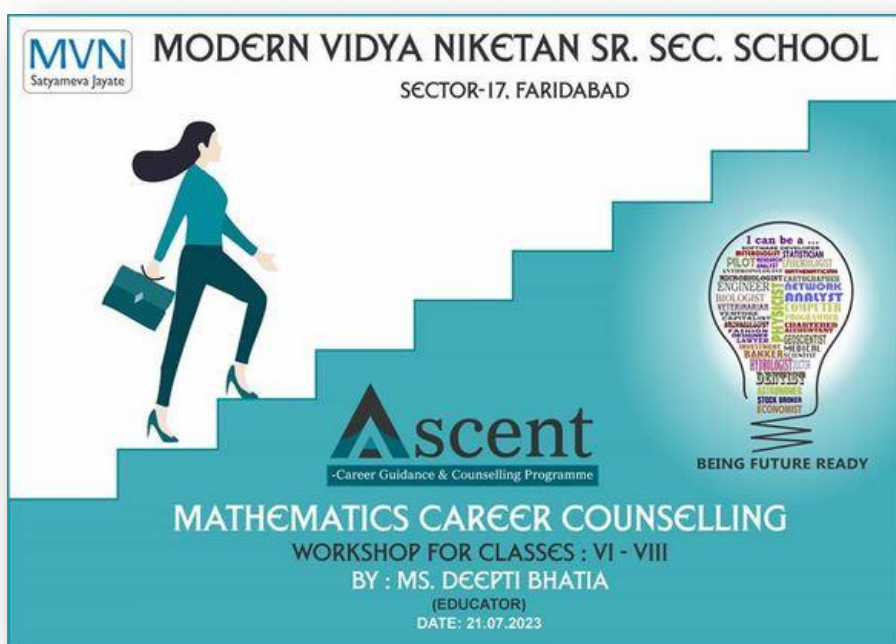
The session was open to all IX & X students who were planning to opt for science stream in their senior secondary classes.

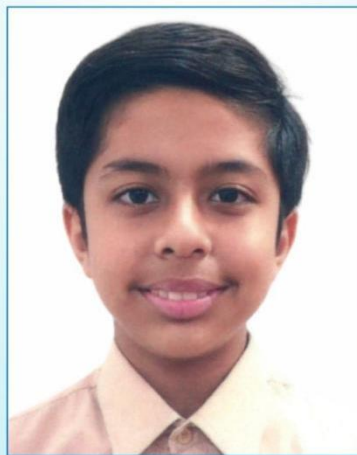


