The event came to a ceremonial close with the singing of the National Anthem, ushering a vibrant tone for the year ahead.





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


A committed adherent of the dynamic STEAM pedagogy, the school fosters an educational environment that encourages pupils to think intensively and critically, realizing the true spirit of education.




ASSEMBLIES



CLASSES VIII - X






CLASSES XI-XII





Faces of Freedom: Artistic Homage to Our Heroes

A Vibrant Showcase of Language and Culture




Throughout the week, students participated in various activities including:





ACTIVITIES

The world rejoices in a heavenly trance.



This event served as a wonderful opportunity for students to express their creativity and broaden their perspective on divine knowledge."






Face the Future - Symposium





Informed and Empowered: A Journey to Wellness


Building Resilience: Empowering Young Minds for a Brighter Future


Session For Class-XI


VELS PROGRAMME




