FROM THE COUNSELLOR'S DESK

Dear Parent

Greetings! There is no one in the world who can influence the life and future of a child like a parent can. The fact has become even more prominent in these pandemic times when children are home bound. As a parent of a young child, sometimes we all become unsure and question ourselves if we are doing enough for our child.

The most important issue at this stage can be how to make the child take interest in formal classroom studies and put effort in learning, particularly writing. It is a big task for parents, particularly in virtual classes. The answer lies in subtly motivating the child by inculcating the love for learning. Here are some points to do so:

- 1. Enthusiasm rubs off, especially when it comes to learning new things. When your child observes that you are sincerely enthusiastic about the new learning, he/she will definitely catch your enthusiasm.
- 2. Let the learning not be restricted to formal classes. Make learning subtle. For example, after watching a cartoon, discuss the story line, characters, their understanding and opinions. This is an excellent way to stimulate learning subtly. The child will learn to observe, process a concept and form individual opinion and actually learn creative thinking!
- 3. If the child hates writing, instead of insisting on writing the formal course, go subtle. Get creative and play games with her in which she has to write something, may be on a whiteboard or a drawing sheet. Starting a family journal where each member writing about their day is a good way to start with. The goal is to make her hand move and let her develop patience and willingness to put effort.
- 4. If the child feels too much controlled, he/she will withdraw from learning. Create an open atmosphere where he feels comfortable expressing his likes, dislikes or concerns. When he shares his opinion, make sure to validate his feelings even if you disagree. Convey the disagreement. When children feel like their opinion doesn't matter, they are likely to disengage from the learning process. A good way to manage control and freedom together is to provide choices so the child is free to choose from options provided by you.
- 5. Learning is an individual process. Keep close watch on what is the best way of learning for your child and do it more. Recognize and celebrate achievements no matter how much small they may be. Please focus on learning at this age and not on performance. If children develop enthusiasm for learning at this stage of their lives, performance is bound to come in higher classes.


The little saviours painted their hands with blue and green colour and took the Pledge:

World Day for Safety and Health


It is rightly said, "Learnings in childhood never get fade away".






WORLD MUSIC DAY

Golden words


"Start each day with a grateful heart"






"Read -A -Thon" DAY 2
