Research says that parents who step in to provide instructions, help, corrections or suggestions too often can cause behavioral issues in the child. Too much direct engagement can come at a cost to kids.

As parents, your guidance and involvement is important when the child is not paying attention, violating rules or only half-heartedly engaging in an activity. These are the teachable moments but sometimes they need to be left alone and allowed to take charge of learning on their own.

Introduction of letter v

Activity based Learning of phonemes and letter recognition works as a great impetus for amplifying children's interest in learning. Phonic awareness however infinitesimal, is the foremost bit in learning the sounds of letters which helps in building strong foundation. Introduction of phonemes through activities generated interest among the kids and prepped them better for more advanced concepts. Our Nursery maestros indulged themselves to craft flowers with the help of v- vegetable impression in v-vase which was helpful to enhance their vocabulary and cognizance of phonic sound v that says व.



Speak on session -Story telling

Stories spark children's imagination and help them to learn the difference between Real and Make Believe. Moreover stories promote brain development and listening skills. It is rightly said, "If you want your children to be smart, tell them stories, if you want them to be brilliant, tell them more stories." Our young narrators effortlessly demonstrated their artistry in narrating funny and value based Stories. Furthermore, kids added a variety of props and spruced up themselves by cosplaying characters which embellished the session. The session helped demure the kids to come out of their shells and stimulated them to gear up for the upcoming speak on sessions. It was a great pleasure to visualize kids narrating stories confidently which contributed a great deal in developing their ingenuity and oratory skills.



Sound Nest of C and K

Taking live examples from the surroundings is the best way to understand things easily. To differentiate between the sounds of C and K, an activity C-“Cooking without Fire” was organised, which was conducted in the K -“kitchen”. Our Nursery Chefs made K-“KitKat Cup Cake” by adding C-“cream” to the top of the C -“crushed” KitKat chocolate, followed by garnishing the cupcake with C-“candies” and decorating them with C- “candle”. They enthralled their teachers and friends with their articulation. It also helped the children to learn how to make logical connections and use reasoning skills.

Phonics: The Most Important Skill for the Fledgling Readers

Reading develops the propensity for envisioning. Studying phonics provided our little learners with a head start for reading English letters along with their sounds. These little learners learnt the letter-sound relationship of the letter "L" by exploring the real life objects that begin with the sound "L". The kiddiewinks also enjoyed the "L"- leaf impression activity and displayed their masterpieces. The toddlers developed an excellent ability to hear, identify and employ the letter symbols along with their appropriate sounds.





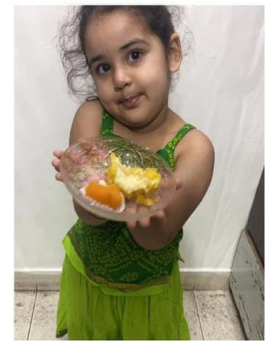


Celebrations

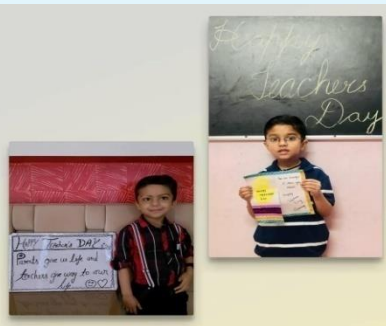


TEACHERS' DAY

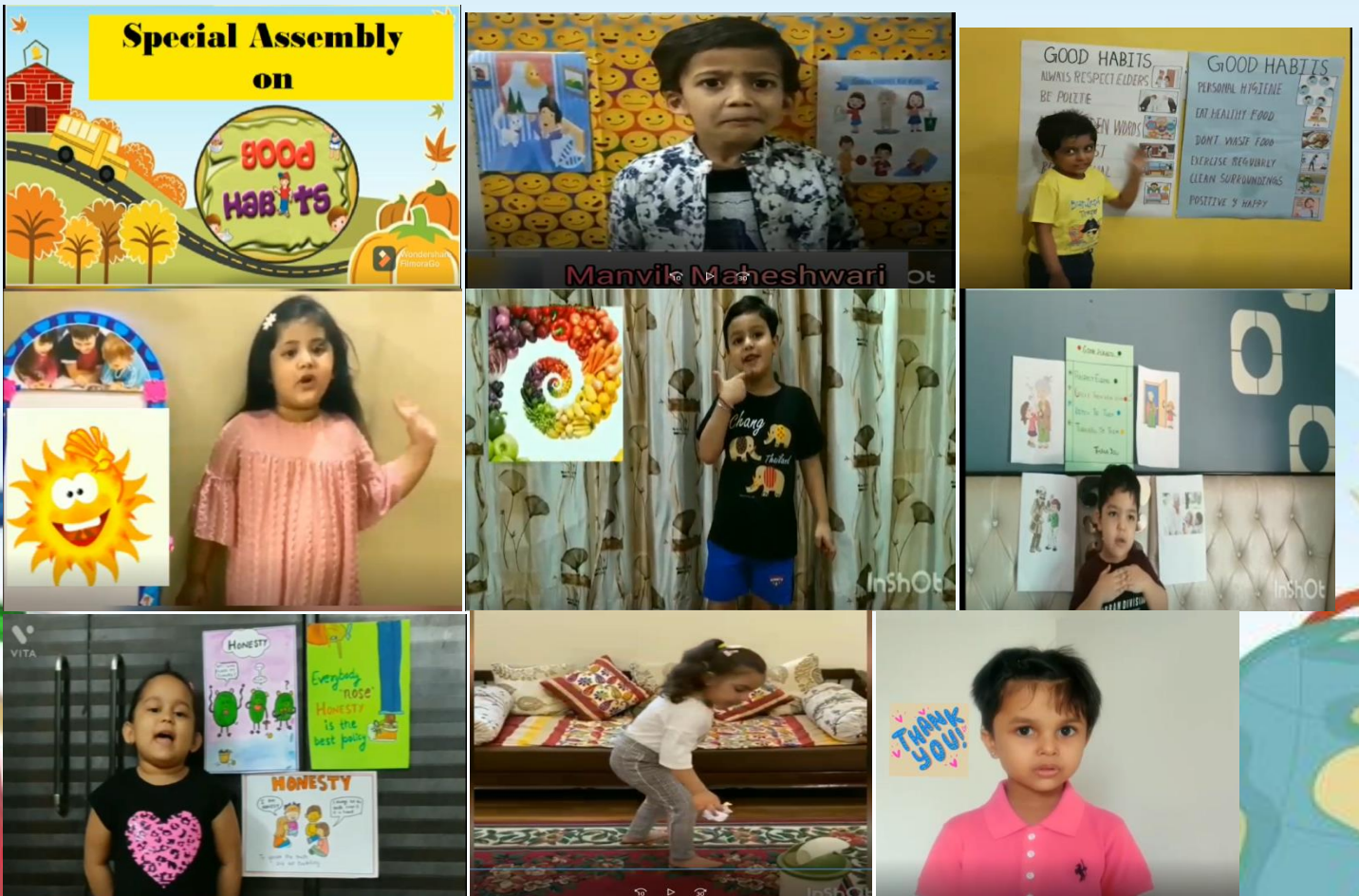


Assembly on Good Habits

"Carried with care, coated with pride, dipped in love, fly in glory, moments of freedom in shade of joy."

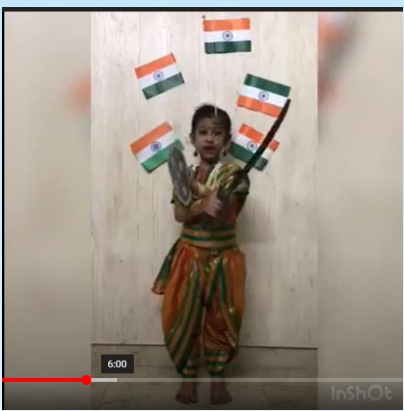
