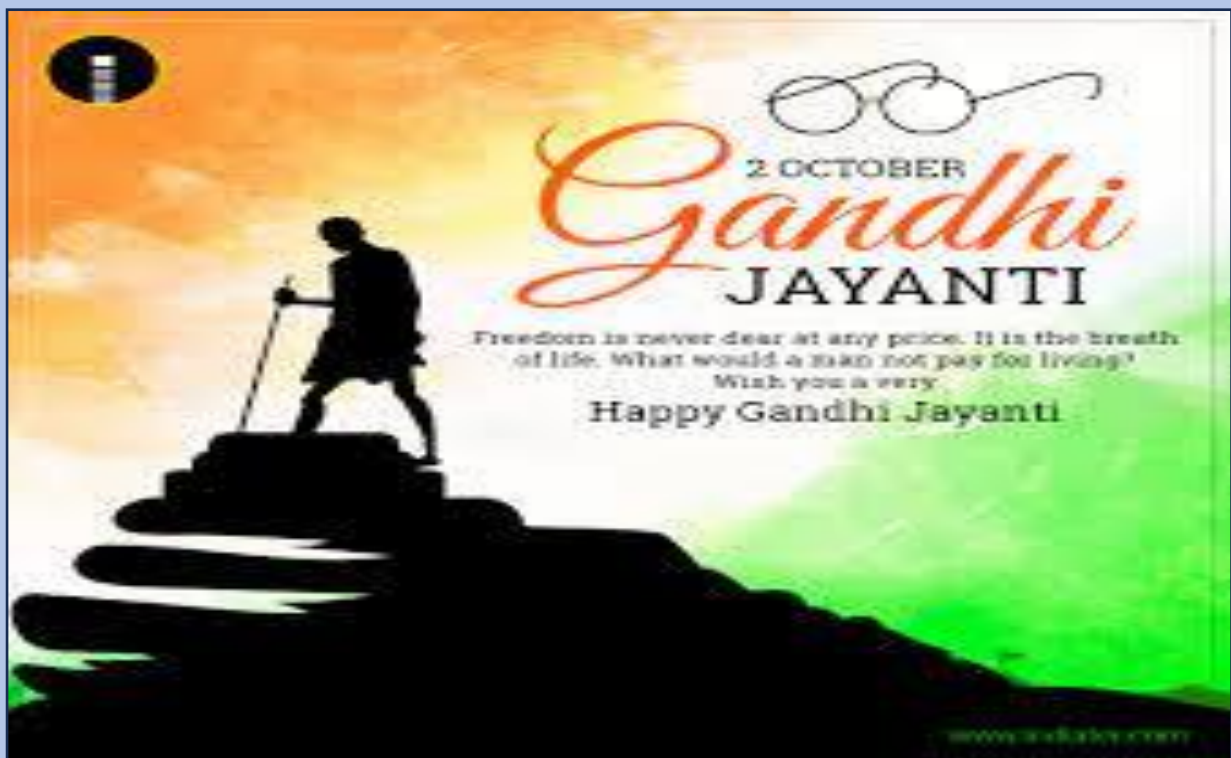

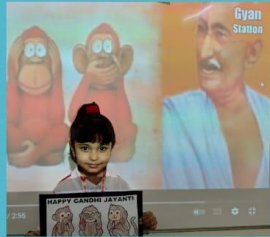


GANDHI JAYANTI CELEBRATION

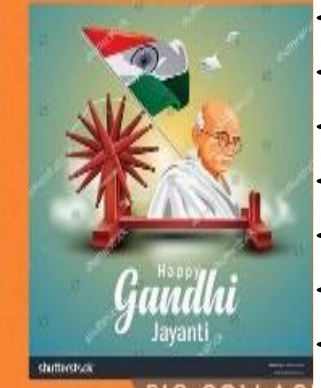
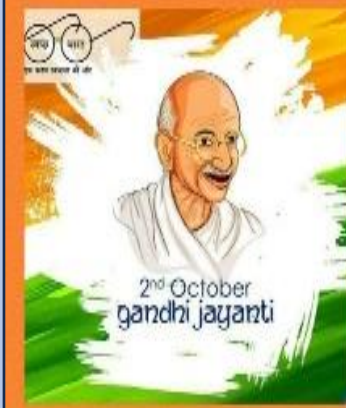

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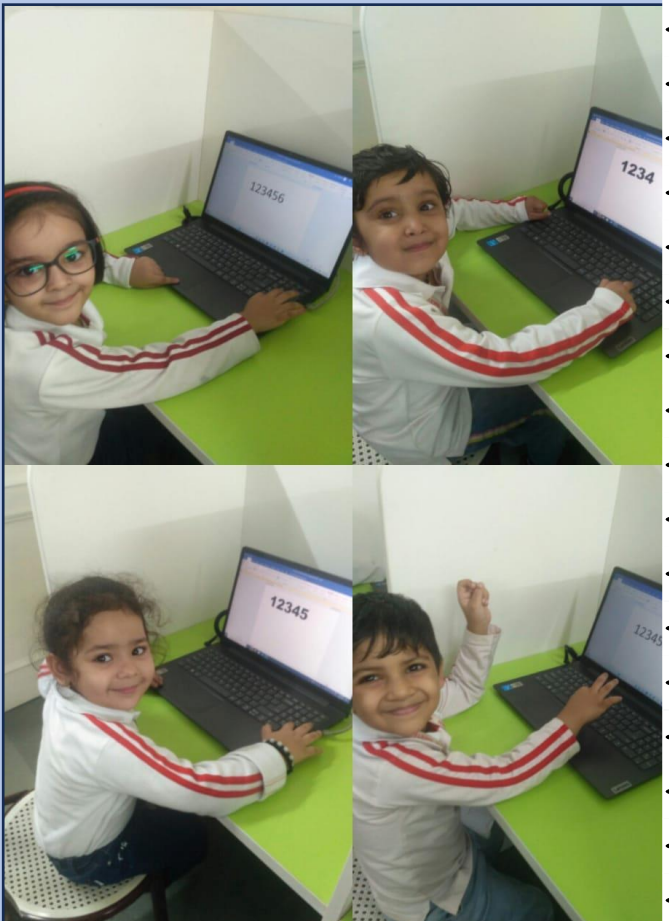
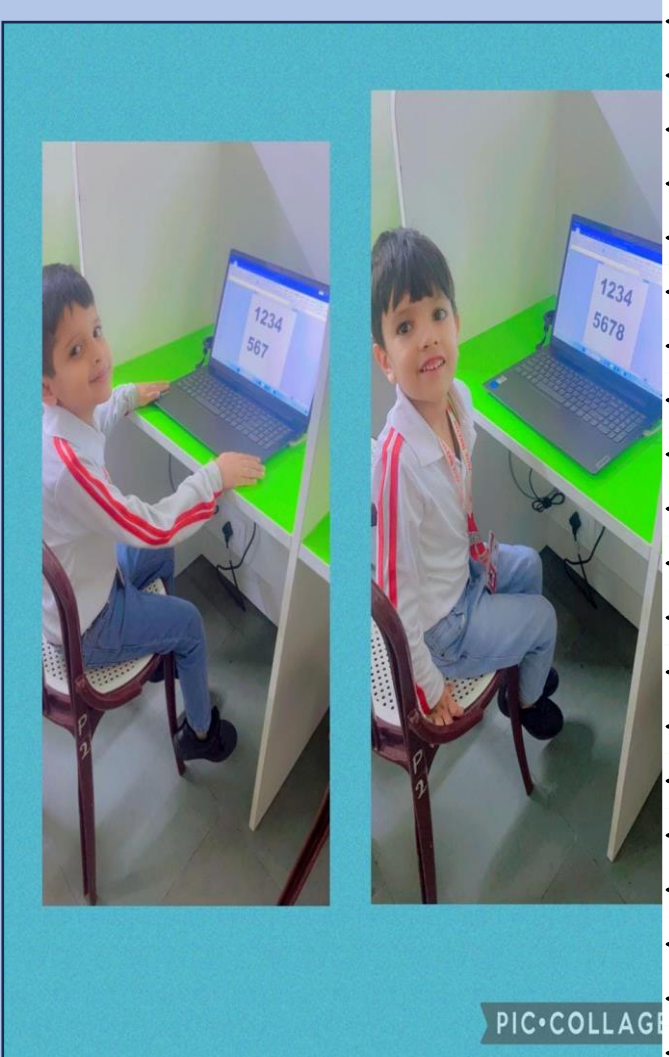
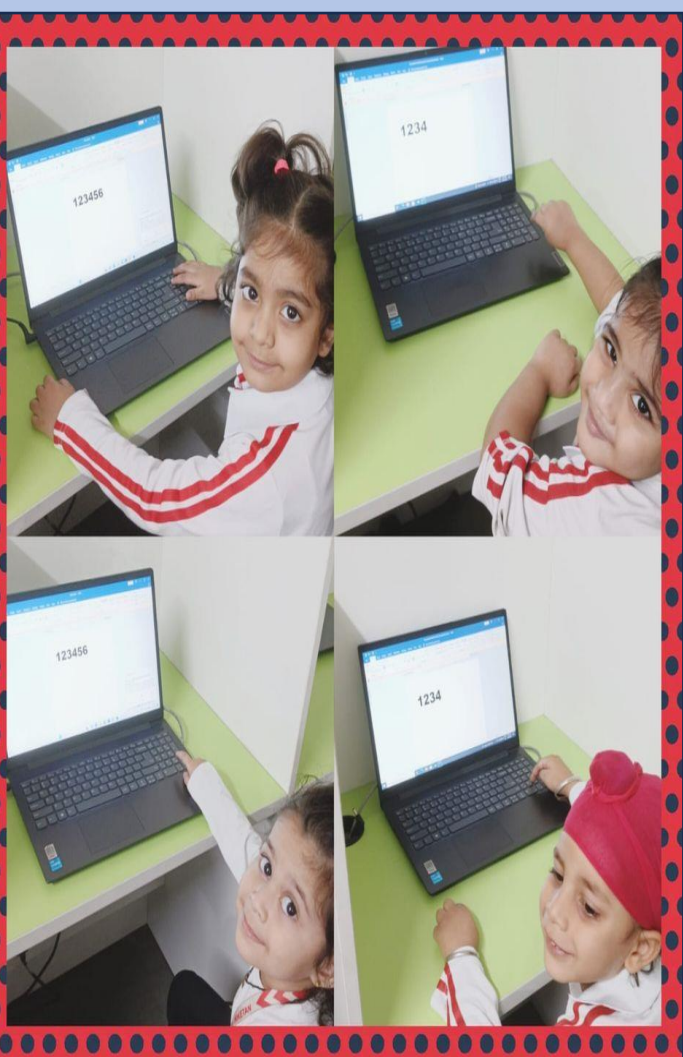


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TYPING OF LETTERS

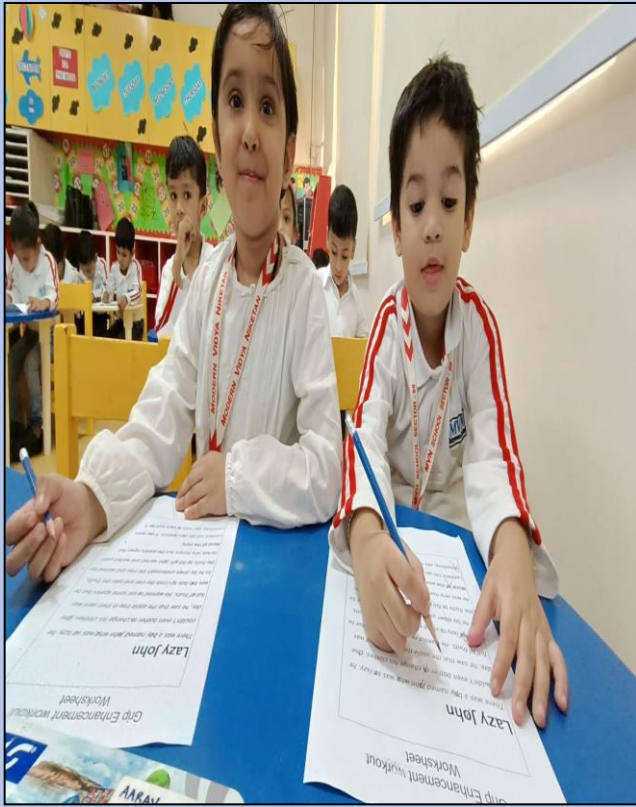




GRIPPING ENHANCEMENT

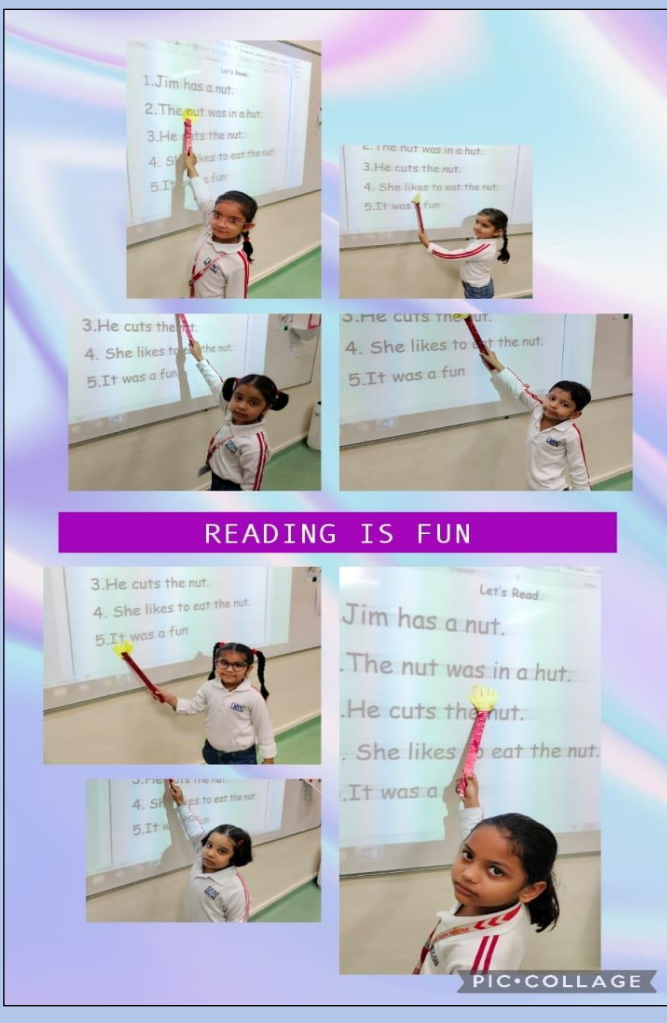
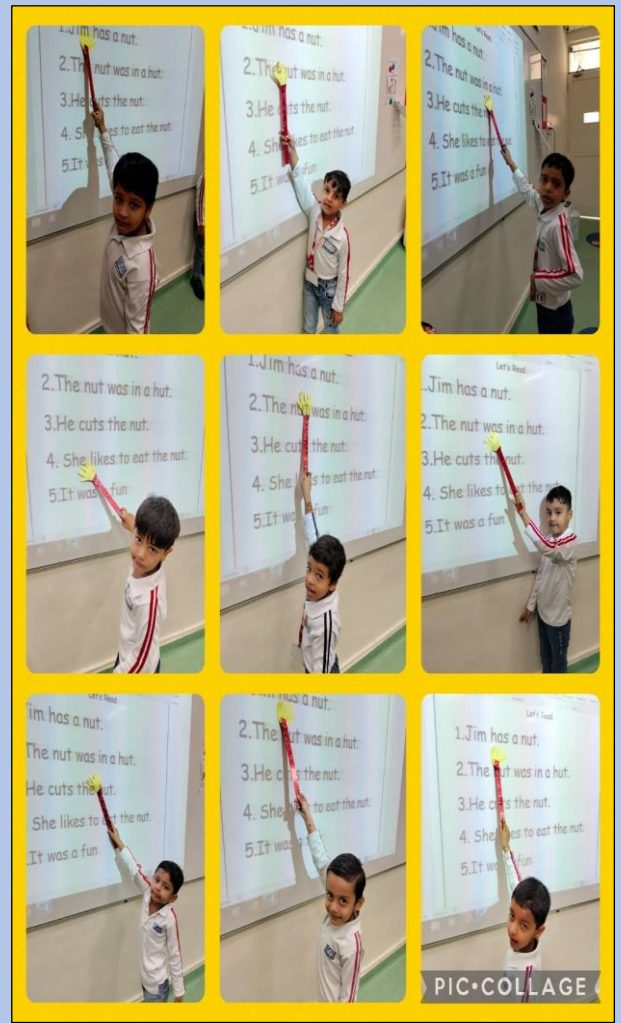
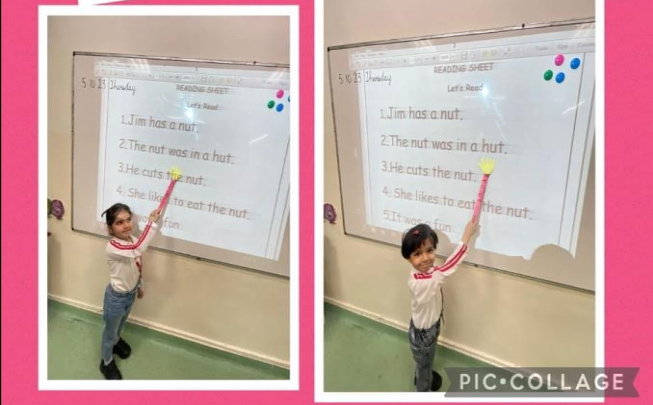
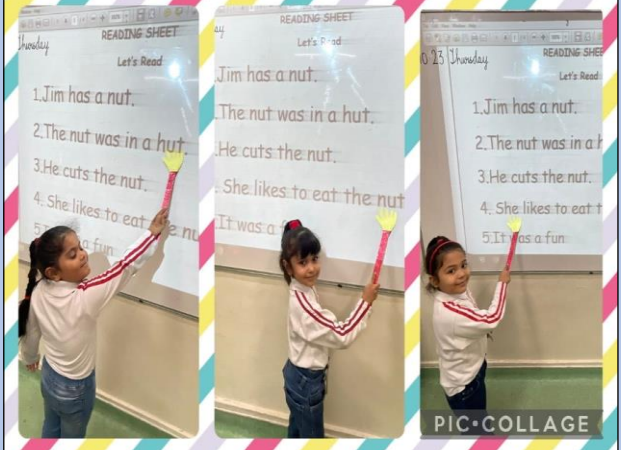
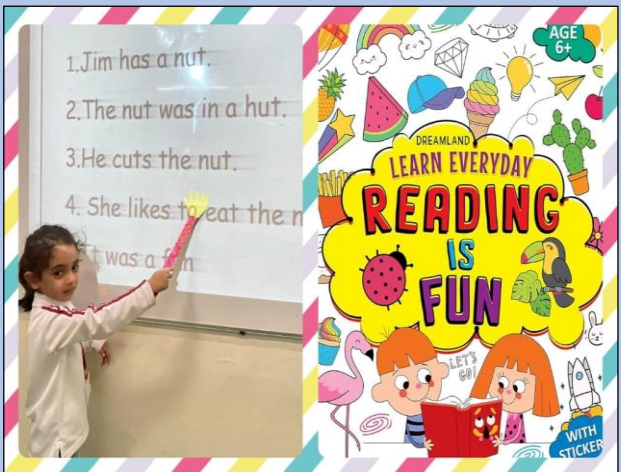


DROP EVERYTHING AND READ (DEAR SESSION)

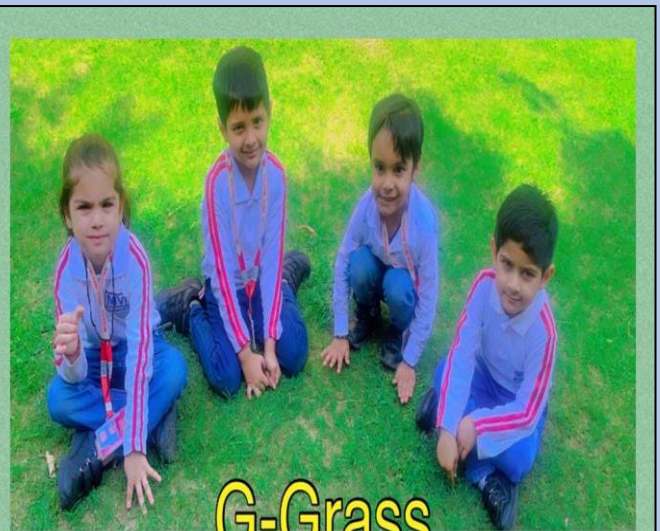




THE YOUNG GO- GETTERS OF NURSERY

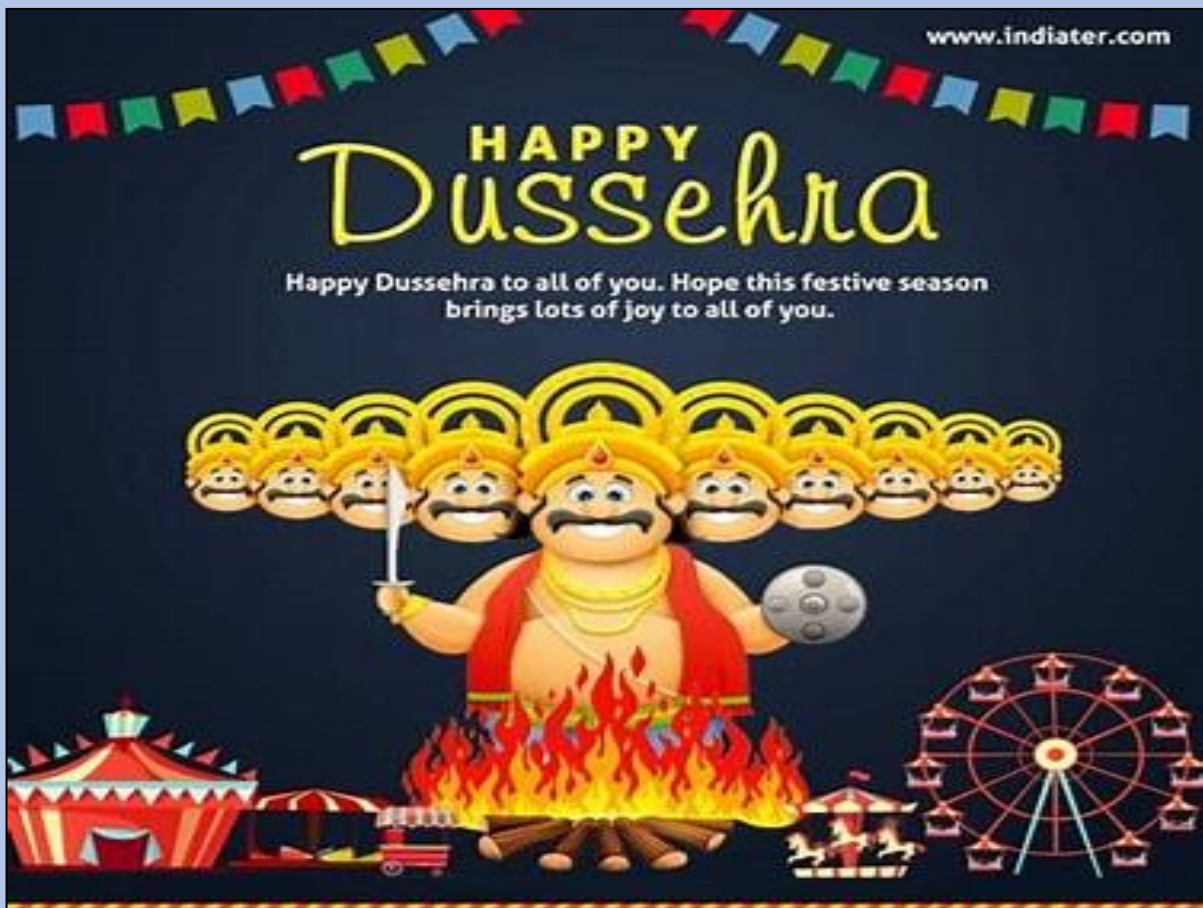

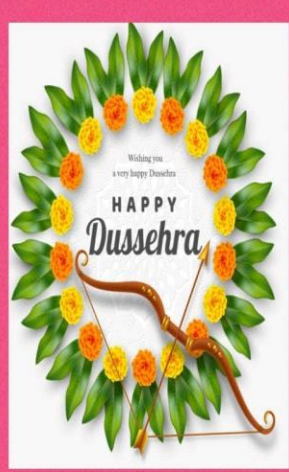
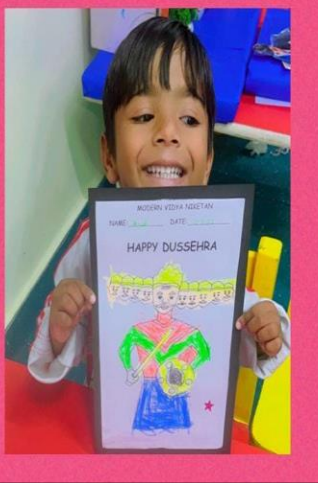
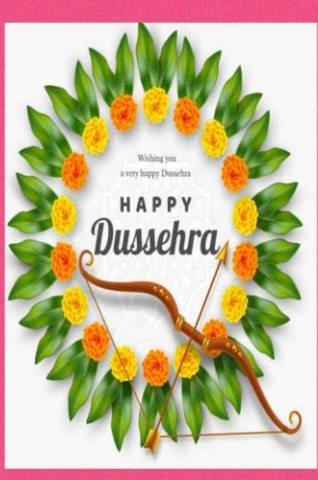




DUSSEHRA CELEBRATION

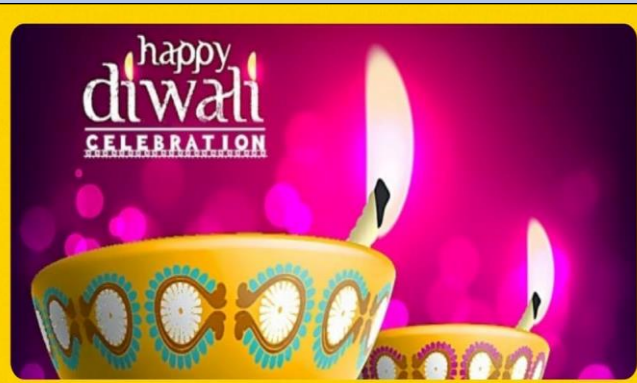

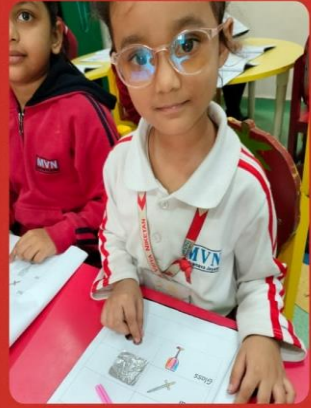

Each material was accompanied by a brief description, sparking curiosity about its origin, uses, and significance.

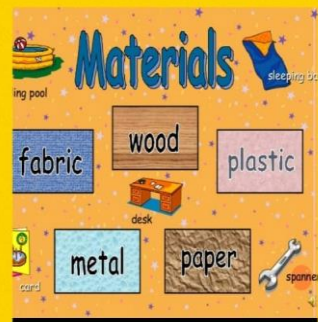

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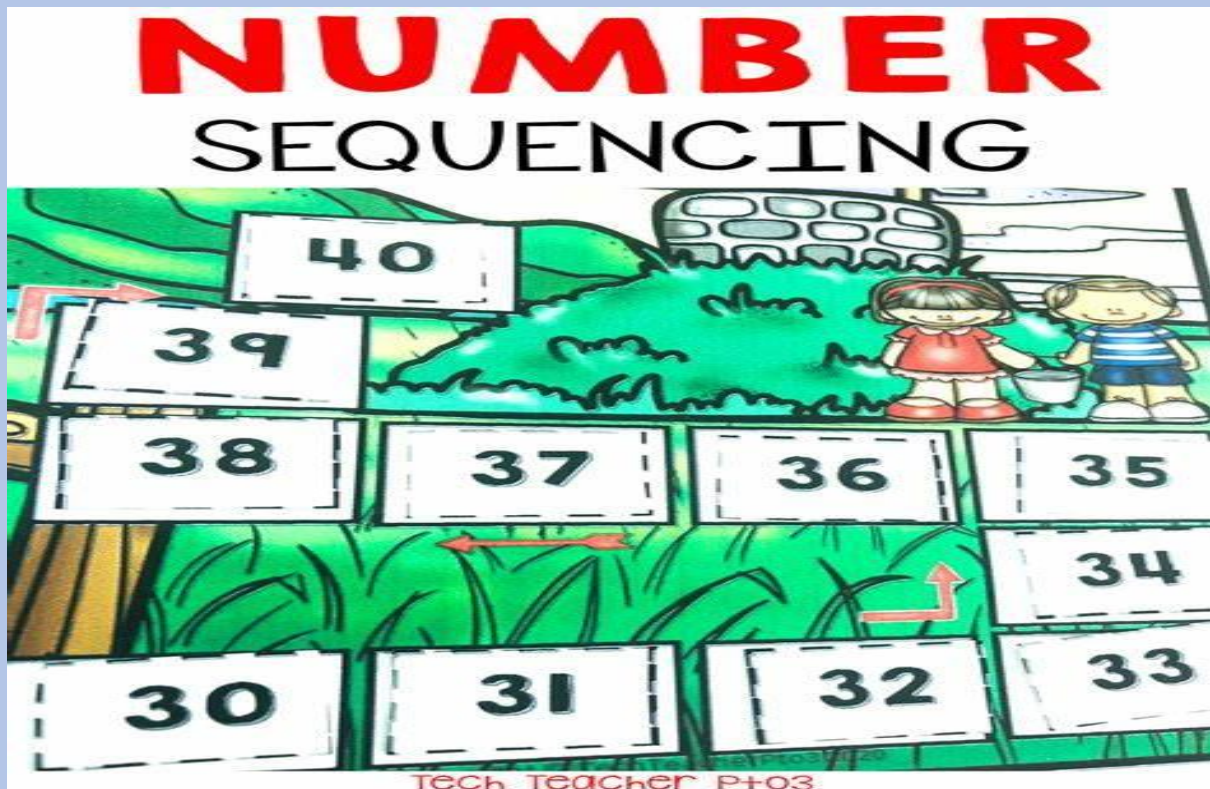
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NUMBER SEQUENCING

Overall, it was a commendable gesture by our children as they spread a message of being thankful in the society. 'The more you thank life, the more life gives you to be thankful for'.





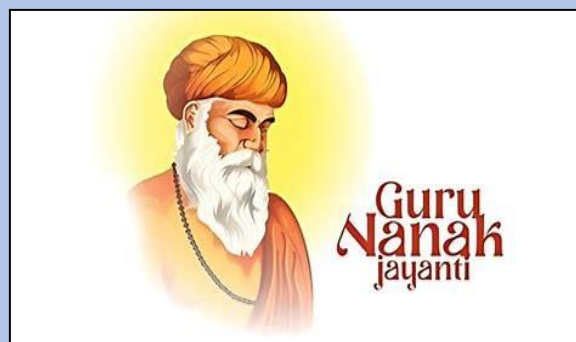
GURUPURAB CELEBRATION

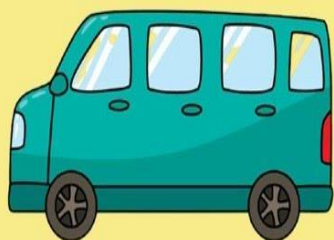
RHYMING TIME EXTRAVAGANZA

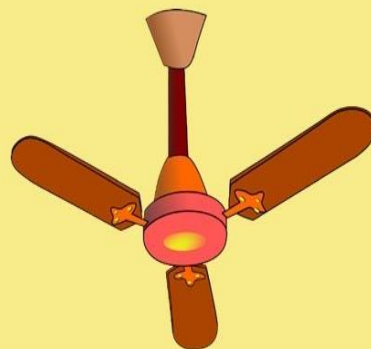

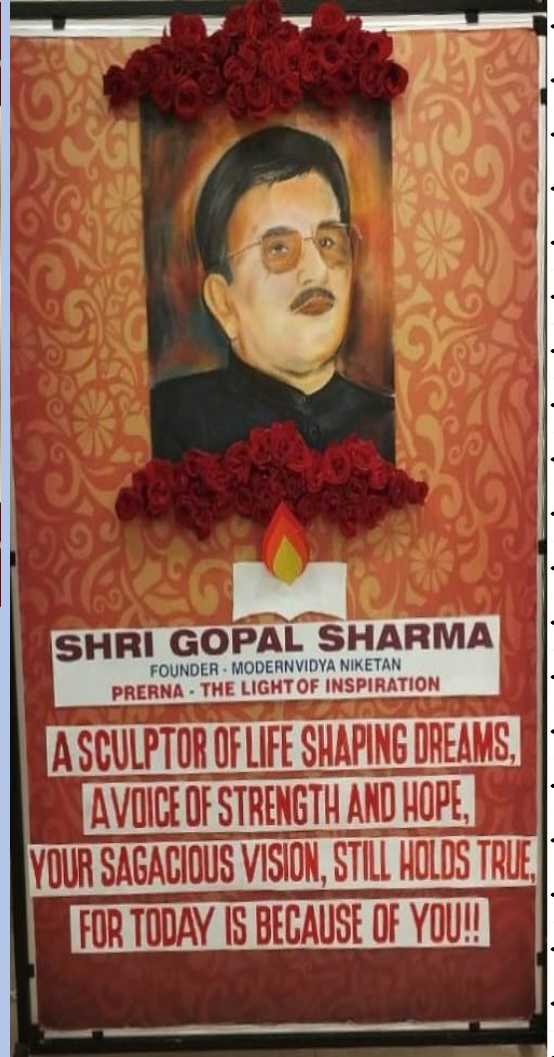

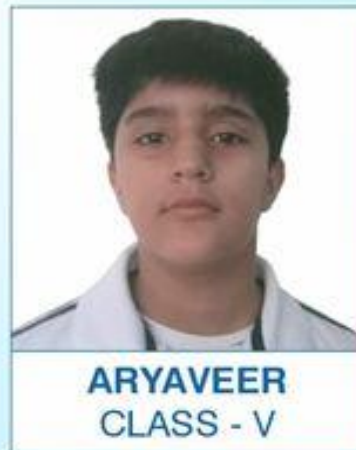
