FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL


"Every child is a different kind of flower, and all together, they make this world a beautiful garden."





Exploring Symmetry with Smiles and Creativity!

It was a delight to watch them explore, experiment and understand symmetry while having so much fun!







EXPLORING LIVING AND NON-LIVING THINGS

By engaging in this playful yet educational activity, our young learners not only grasped fundamental scientific concepts but also developed essential life skills.




KINDERGARTEN DAY


A cheerful rhyme on Earth Day added joy to the programme, followed by the children proudly taking a pledge to keep the Earth clean and pollution-free.


A vibrant dance performance brought energy and excitement to the stage, with the children beautifully expressing their love and care for Mother Earth.




BOOK WEEK CELEBRATION - DAY 3

SPECIAL ASSEMBLY - GOLDEN WORDS




CONCEPT OF 'BETWEEN'


Exploring the World of "BETWEEN" with Our UKG Stars!






“Behind every little child who believes in themselves is a father who believed in them first.”



Our Kindergarten children from MVN Sector 17 celebrated Father's Day with immense love, joy, and gratitude for their first heroes - their dads!

INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY


International Yoga Day 2025 - Little Yogis in Action!

A Legacy Etched in Excellence


“Where perseverance meets purpose, brilliance follows.”

CBSE CLASS - XII BOARD EXAM RESULT 2024-25

May 13, 2025 saw MVNites add yet another glowing leaf to the merit scrolls of their alma mater. Our rising stars from Class XII - Non-Medical, Medical and Commerce streams - have done us real proud with the sheer display of their diligence, dedication and determination in the exemplary results achieved in AISSCE Class XII CBSE Board Examination, 2024-25.

Madhav Datt Sharma, Ekansh Gupta and Divya Bhardwaj bagged top honours in Non-Medical stream with a score of 96%, 95.4% and 95% respectively.

The first position in Medical stream went to Geetika Prajapati and Samridhi Singh with 96.2 % followed by Purva Garg with 96 % and Shubhankit Sharma with 95.2 % at the second and the third positions.

Bhavya Taneja, with a brilliant score of 99.2 % topped the Commerce stream while Unnati Gautam stood second with 98% and Bhavit Chopra secured third position with a score of 97.8 %.
