FROM COUNSELLOR'S DESK

Dear parents,

A crucial part of parenting young children is teaching them appropriate behavior. All behavior depends on communication. Understand this with a small example:

Have you ever forced your child to say sorry for their mistake? And have you ever felt that even after saying sorry there is no change in behavior of the child. Rather the child is saying sorry just to satisfy you or to avoid conflict or shame.

A forced apology from a child never yields desired results. It is not genuine and is given with insincere words. It doesn't address the real problem. Many a times, children feel that saying "sorry" is just a ritual that they need to do after any misbehavior. This frustrates the parents further.

A forced apology is never effective in teaching empathy. It also causes the child to say things they don't mean. They learn to do things to please others in order to avoid shame and conflict. They do not understand their mistakes and get confused.

So instead of asking them for apology and force them to say sorry, provide them with an opportunity to open up and help them analyze the situation. Validate their emotions but never justify them. Help them weigh the available options of behavior. Discuss consequences of each option and gently move them towards the appropriate behavior option. Now coming back to present issue, ask them what they can do to fix it. You will be pleased to see that their empathy will lead to apology which will come from deep within. Ask if they would like to choose appropriate option next time.

With patience and right way of communication in parenting, the behavior can be managed successfully.

The art of communication is the language of Leadership".



The interactions and hands-on experiences promoted kindness and respect towards all living creatures amongst the learners. It also enriched their learning about nature, ecology and relationships.










CARDINAL TO ORDINAL


ORIGAMI

growing our children into happy, creative, skilful and global citizens.




















FOUNDERS DAY






40TH ARYABHATTA INTER SCHOOL MATHEMATICS COMPETITION

May the MVNites continue to shine bright and conquer even more milestones in the future!






INTERNATIONAL MATHEMATICS OLYMPIAD


