FROM COUNSELLOR'S DESK

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Dear Parent

Greetings! Through the ups and downs of everyday parenting, parents sometimes struggle with sudden rise in some undesirable behaviors in children. These may include telling lies, arguing, low confidence, jealousy and even aggression. Sometimes no obvious reason could be identified for these.

For such situations, pattern of communication between parent and child holds the key. A parent 's love is boundless for the child but unfortunately many a times, this love is not expressed enough with right words in the right way. This leads to many behavior problems in children.

Following are some suggestions for parents which may be included in their day-to-day communication with children.

1. I made a mistake....sorry. As parents, we are not perfect and we can make mistakes. Accepting a genuine mistake then and there in front of the child sets a good example for the child to follow. It also teaches him/her that there is no shame in accepting one's mistake. Please don't forget to share your learning from that mistake as well.

2. I don't know this....let us figure this out together. As parents, you don't automatically know everything. Displaying your learning attitude is a great lesson for the child.

3. Can we talk about what happened? I want to know your side of the story. I really want to understand why you did what you did. Your feelings are valid and it is safe to express them with me. If you speak this to your child, your child will never feel frustrated, unheard or angry. Validating feelings is very important because after validation only, you can move the child to correction.

4. I respect you and expect you to be respectful to me. Let us treat them with respect so they learn self respect and respecting others.

5. I can see you are really trying and I am proud of you for that. This will teach them the value of effort and build on their motivation.

6. It is ok if you have a different opinion than mine. We need not to agree on everything. I like your honesty. Please help children develop their own opinions and give them opportunity to voice their opinions. This will build assertiveness and confidence in their personalities.

7. I forgive you for this mistake and I want to trust you again. Children will never lie if they have this trust verbalized from a parent. Reminding and judging them over past mistakes will restrict them from trying again.

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8. Let us pause this conversation. I need a break; we will talk about it in some time. This is a good way to teach them controlling impulsiveness, developing patience and calmness.

I will always be with you and love you no matter what. I believe in you. Children are growing learning small human beings. They deserve to hear this reassurance more often.
I am so grateful you are my child. I like spending time with you. No amount of love and compassion will make your child incapable or weak. It is rather opposite. Love and compassion communicated rightly will help your child feel safe, important and confident.

Let us help our children spread wings.



FUN WITH CURSOR

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New ways of learning always fascinate young learners to explore things around them. Letter identification activities enable kids to grasp and understand how things are associated with the phonics. To explore vocabulary of the new letter C, Nursery students visited the laptop lab and got awareness of c-computer and c- cursor. Drawing of c-curved lines and typing of letter c have spruced up their learning. They watched story of ccaterpillar. It was indeed a fruitful learning experience and the kids were excited and happy. This easy and unique way of learning developed students' vocabulary, and helped them to remember things strongly.



FUN WIH CLAY DOUGH

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Activity based Learning of phonemes and letter recognition works as a great impetus for amplifying children's interest in learning. Phonic awareness however infinitesimal is the foremost bit in learning the sounds of letters, that helps in building strong foundations.

In order to expand the vocabulary of letter d, the Nursery Maestros indulged themselves in making "d-duck" with play dough, and also cherished reciting the rhyme "Five Little Ducks".

The activity was immensely enjoyed by all.





FUN WITH PHONICS

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MVN Kindergarten believes that Reading develops the propensity for envisioning. Phonics provide a head start for reading English letters with their sounds to our young learners. The Young readers of Nursery were introduced to the letter-sound relationship of letter"a" by integrating it with healthy eating habits. The little munchkins started their day with a healthy fruit break of a-apples, a-almonds and a- apricots. They did the reinforcement of the sound "a" and were also told the benefits of eating healthy food through various videos. It was an enlightening experience for the students. The kid's Healthy Eating Plate is a visual guide to help educate and encourage kids to eat well. This fun-filled activity was enjoyed by all.

FUN WITH NUMBERS

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Sequencing is an important readiness skill ,which provides a strong foundation of number sense to young learners. The little mathematicians of Nursery class enjoyed the "Sequence Exploration" activity and they confidently read, counted and sequenced the numbers from 1 to 10. This activity helped them to recognise numbers thoroughly and made the number sequencing concept more understandable and predictable for them.

'Sequence Exploration' developed Number sense, comparing, sorting, arranging, logical ordering and provided kids with an unending numerical fluency.



AN "ADDITION" TO THE LEARNING VCURVE

The dynamic learners of Kindergarten were introduced to the concept of addition under the guidance of their mentors. Addition not only helps children gain confidence and create a life long interest in maths but also helps students excel at more challenging maths aspects.

To begin with the concept, Pictorial addition was introduced to the students using concrete materials available in the class. Then, children made "plus" + sign by joining two different ice cream sticks and "equal to" = sign by keeping two ice cream sticks together. The joyous hearts enjoyed learning adding the two numbers together. They were also introduced to the key vocabulary words like sum, both, total, plus, equal to, more and it was a great learning experience for all.



LEARNING IS FUN & FUN IN LEARNING

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Environmental Studies (EVS) at the primary stage envisages exposing children to the real situations in their surroundings to help them connect, be aware of, appreciate and be sensitized towards the prevailing environmental issues. EVS not only helps children to get acquainted with their own environment but it also strengthens their bond with it.

Creating learning situations in the context of children is very crucial to learning EVS. Efforts need to be made to avoid giving direct information, instead create situations for children to construct their own knowledge by interacting first hand with their surroundings.

The students of MVN Kindergarten learnt about materials i.e Wood, Glass, Metal and Plastic. They looked for these materials in the classroom and pasted them in the worksheet. Children thoroughly enjoyed the activity and learnt different properties of materials through experiential learning.





EXCLUSION TO INCLUSION!!

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Exclusion to inclusion leads to an accessible learning environment, encouraging participation and support. Inclusive Education values diversity and the unique contribution each student brings to the classroom. In a truly inclusive setting, every child feels safe and has a sense of belongingness. Inclusive systems provide a better-quality education for all children and are instrumental in changing discriminatory attitudes. Respect and understanding grow when the students of diverse abilities and backgrounds play, socialize and learn together.

At MVN, we follow the policy of Inclusion. To instill the art of inclusiveness and imbibe the feeling of appreciation and acceptance among them, 'Musical Chair' was played with kids but in a unique way. We brought nine chairs for ten children with the rule that they must make sure that no one remains without a chair else they will all lose. All the children tried to hug each other so that ten children could sit on nine chairs and then we reduced the number of chairs successively.

With this activity of exclusion to inclusion, children learnt the culture that they cannot succeed without the help of others.

Excellent communication skills go a long way in boosting self-confidence and ensuring great success in the life of children. To enhance the speaking skills, a Speak- On session was organized for the Kindergarteners.

DUSSEHRA


