'Let us keep alive the child's inborn sense of wonder, let us arouse their curiosity to discover the mystery of the world we live in!'

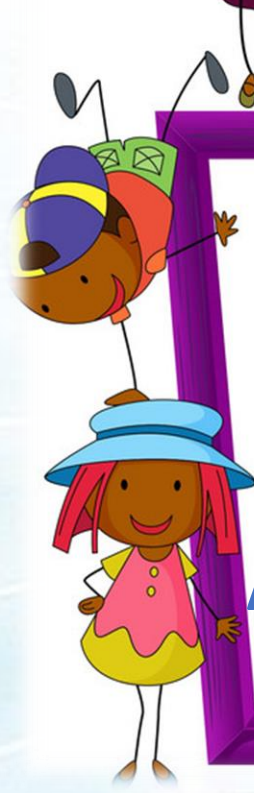

To brighten hope for a greener tomorrow, a special assembly on 'World Nature Conservation Day' was conducted by the students of KG ASTER.

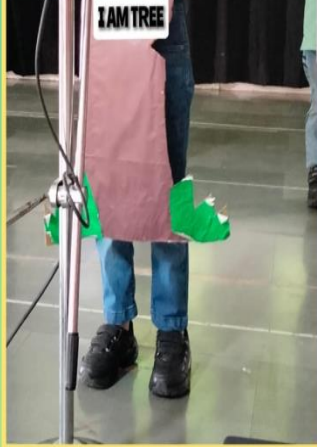

The assembly commenced with the Morning Prayer followed by speech on the importance of healthy environment, the foundation for a stable and productive society.

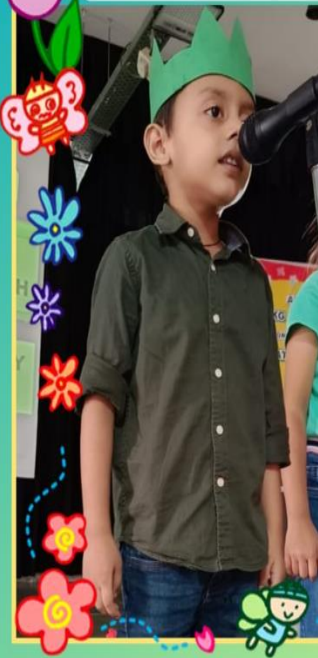

SHARING IS CARING

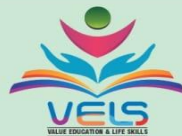
"Workshop on Sharing is Caring: Instilling the Value of Generosity in Kindergarten Kids"

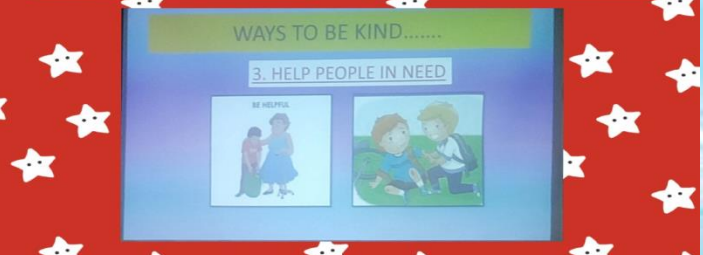



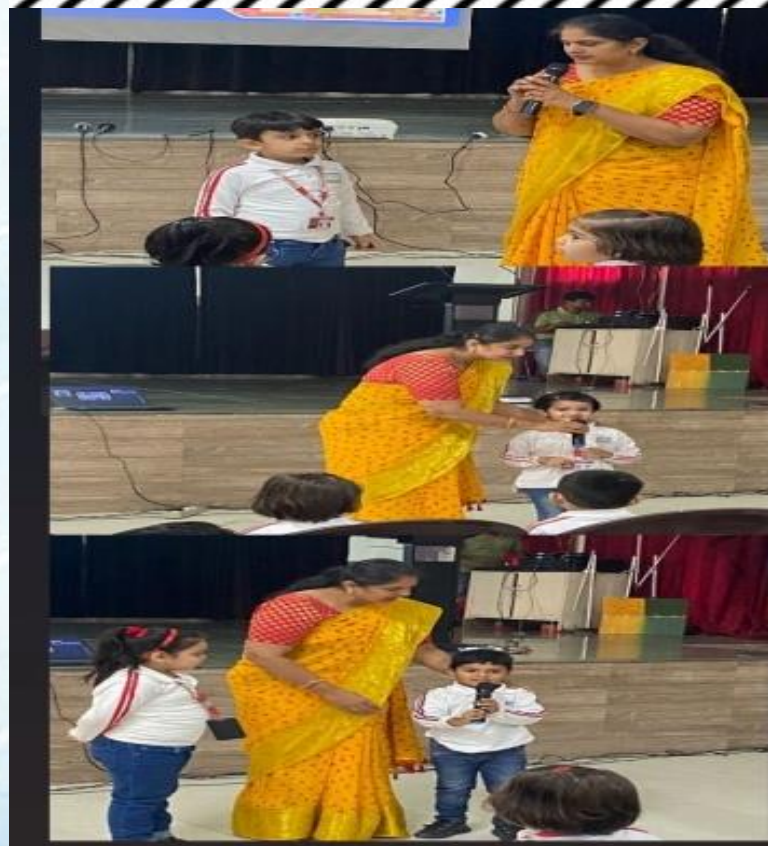

Twinkle twinkle little star,

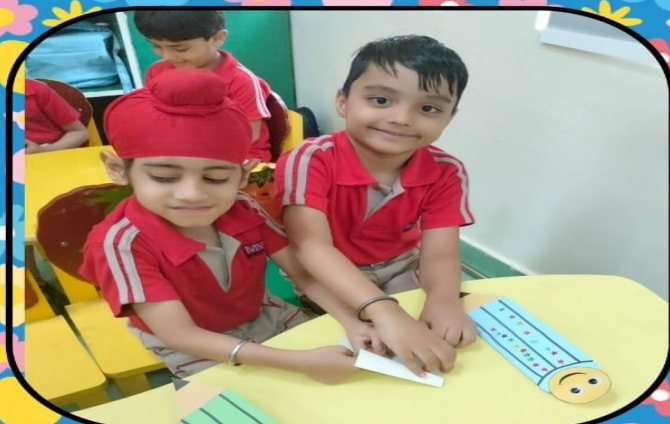
We wished for you and here you are!!

NUMBER REINFORCEMENT WITH THE HELP OF GOLDEN WORDS

"We must aim for a greener, cleaner and healthier environment for our planet NUMBER REINFORCEMENT WITH THE HELP OF GOLDEN WORDS

Number recognition plays a vital role in the mathematical and cognitive development of young children. It serves as a foundational skill that sets the stage for further mathematical concepts. To reinforce number recognition (1-5), a fun and an effective technique was organised involving 5 golden words, viz. Thank you, Welcome, Please, Sorry and Excuse me.

Through this approach, the Nursery children were engaged in counting the golden words, and further recited the numbers 1-5 in sequence.

Children actively enjoyed the number song which helped reinforce understanding of numerical sequencing.





SHOW 'N' TELL ACTIVITY

Show and Tell is an interactive and fun activity for kids that come with tons of learning benefits. It boosts self-esteem, helps develop confidence, and sharpens speaking skills for kids early in the school year.

Show and Tell activity was conducted for the students of Kindergarten as we, at MVN believe that kids who speak confidently perform better in class. Through public speaking, children learn various skills like presentation skills, communication skills, critical thinking skills, listening skills, etc. that enable them to present ideas with much clarity and conviction. 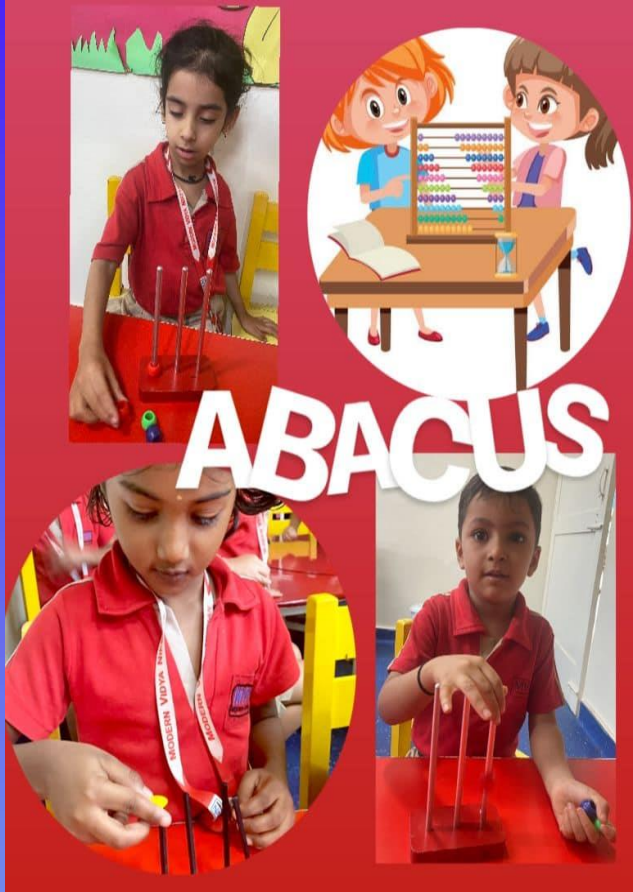

Reciting the rainbow rhyme further enhanced their learning which reinforced the order of colors in the rainbow.

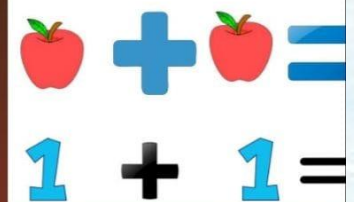

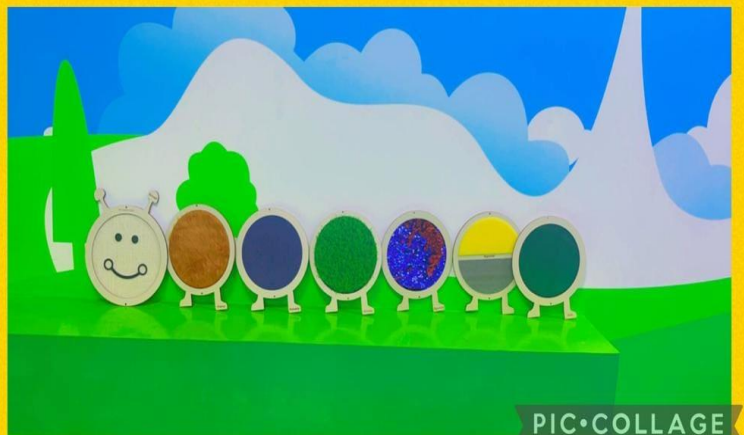

Unleash Your Sense of Touch!

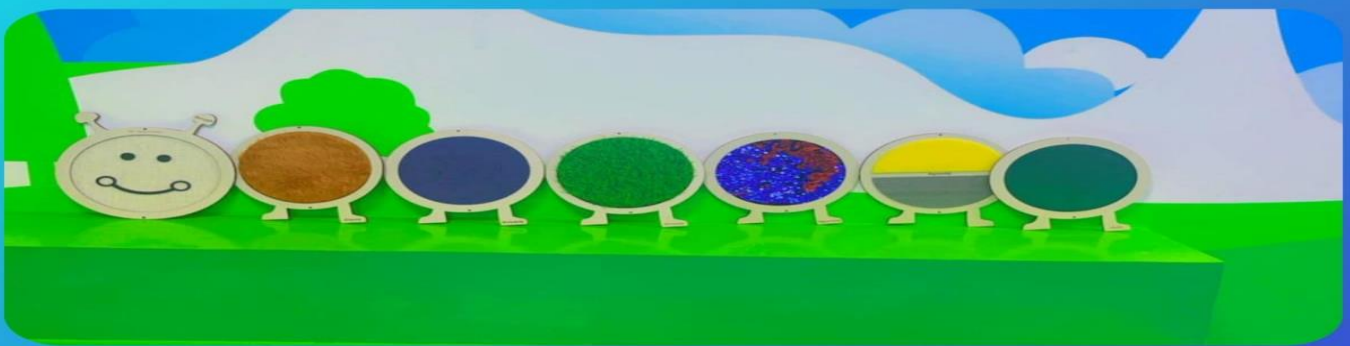

In kindergarten, learning vyanjans (consonant sounds) serves several objectives, such as developing phonemic awareness, enhancing vocabulary, improving speech and pronunciation, and laying the foundation for reading and writing skills. It helps children recognize and differentiate between different sounds, which is crucial for effective communication and literacy development.

As children grasp vyanjans, they gain confidence in their ability to decode and understand written language.

Making it fun and interactive, the Kindergarteners were involved in hands-on activity using Vyanjan cards, wherein children named the correct vyanjan, it's sound and 2 objects with its beginning sound. They were also involved in the statue game which they thoroughly enjoyed. As a result, children were seen learning through fun, exploration and discovery.

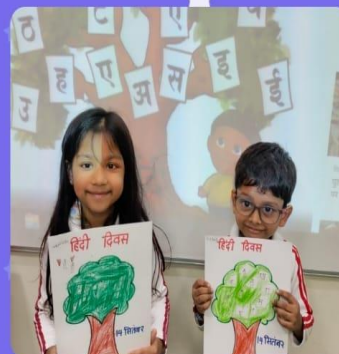


HINDI DIWAS

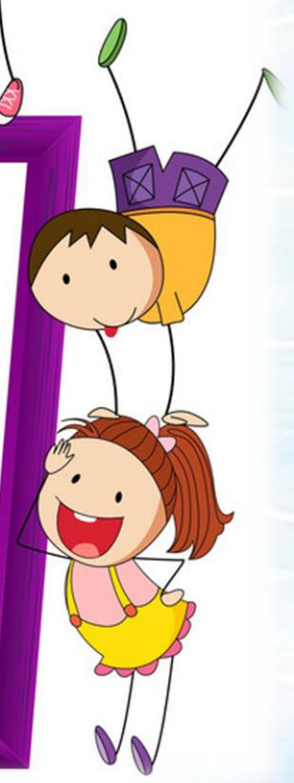
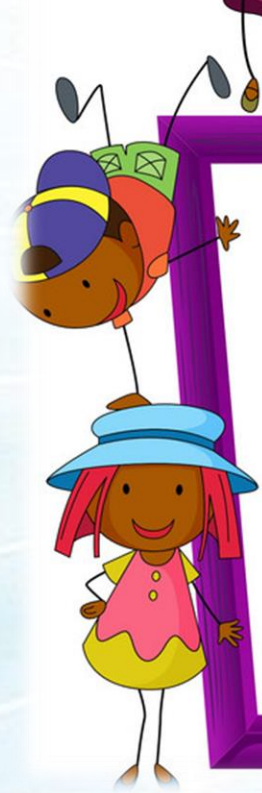

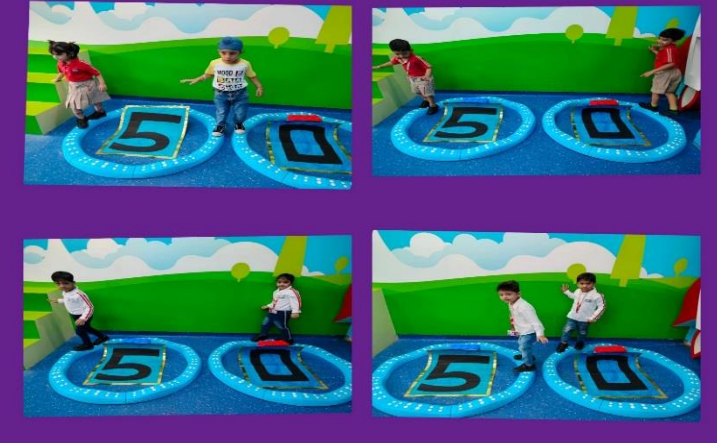

Instilling Patriotism in Young Hearts

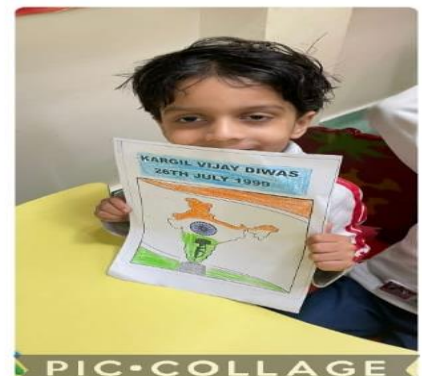

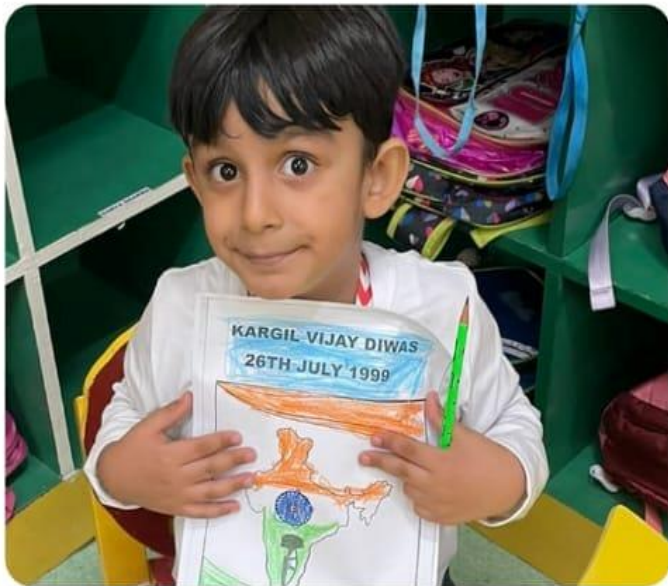

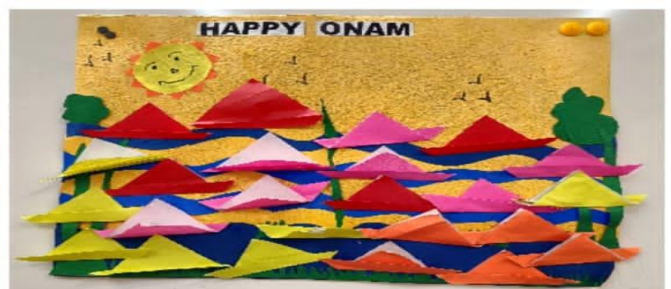


FESTIVAL OF ONAM

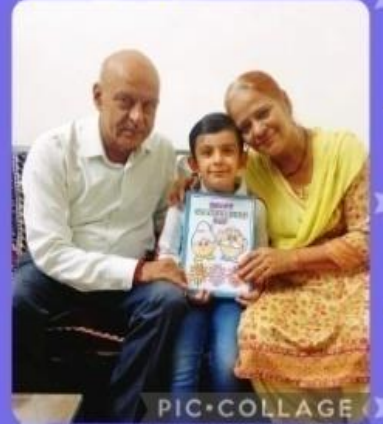
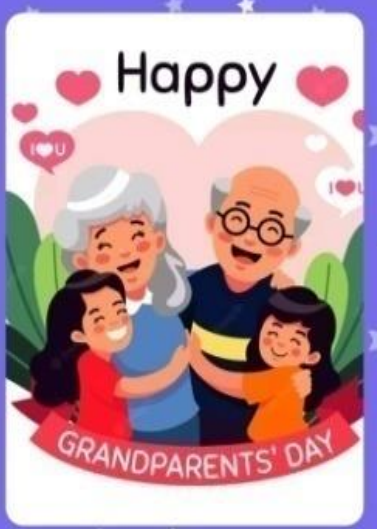

GANESH CHATURTHI

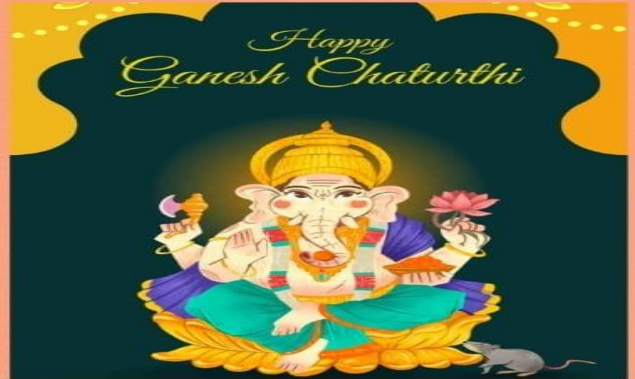

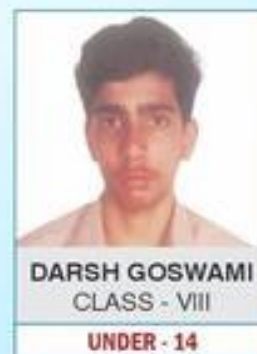

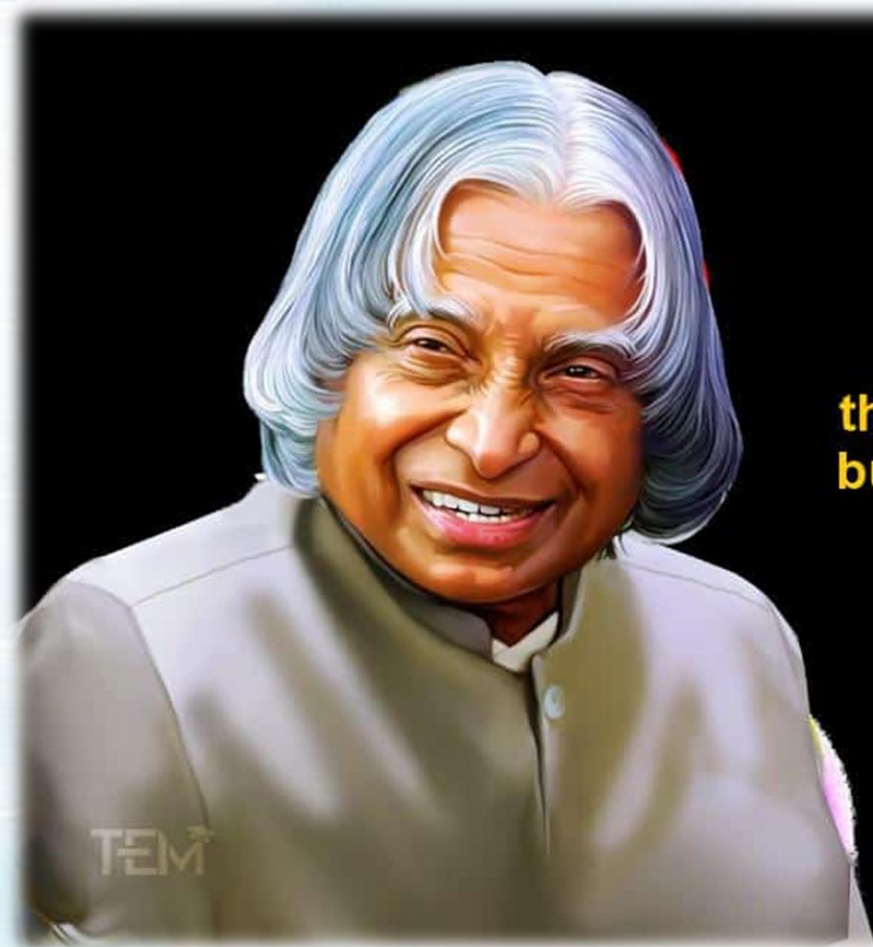
