

## \*Historical Places Voyage by Nursery Students\*

They shared whether they had visited these places or not. It was a fruitful way to help children understand and appreciate our rich history.




# SPEAK ON SESSION

**\*Tiny Champions: A Day of Role Play and Inspiration!\*-UKG**





May the spirit of Raksha Bandhan bring joy, love, and harmony to everyone!




# INTRODUCTION TO THE LETTER E


# PATTERN PLAY-LKG




